

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 05.08.2022 (AT 11.00 AM) AT JAGANNATH TEMPLE FIELD UNDER KHATA NO.1298, PLOT NO. 4228 OF VILLAGE BAYREE UNDER DARPAN TEHSIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE IN RESPECT OF M/S MY HOME INDUSTRIES PRIVATE LIMITED, FOR INSTALLATION OF CEMENT GRINDING UNIT OF 3.0 MTPA CAPACITY (1.5 MTPA IN PHASE-I & 1.5 MTPA IN PHASE-II) OVER AN AREA OF 25.59 HA. AT VILLAGE BYREE UNDER DARPAN TEHSIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT**


The public hearing in respect of the My Home Industries Private Limited for proposed installation of cement grinding unit of 3.0 MTPA Capacity (1.5 MTPA in phase-I & 1.5 MTPA in phase-II) over an area of 25.59 Ha at village Byree under Darpan Tehsil in Jajpur District was held on scheduled date & time at Jagannath temple field under khata no.1298, plot no. 4228 of village Byree under Darpan tehsil of Jajpur district with reference to EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006 and amendments thereof.

**The Panel consisted of the following members:**

2. Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Kalinganagar.

Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, Jajpur, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and assisted by Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of My Home Industries Private Limited, at Byree, Tehsil Darpan in Jajpur District.




Welcoming the public, Sri Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, Jajpur welcomed the public and explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He reminded public that the Public Hearing meeting is being conducted following the Social distancing and COVID-19 guideline. He requested the public to follow the Social distancing and COVID guidelines during the public hearing process. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public.

On behalf of the project proponent, Sri Sushant Kumar Padhi, Sr. Vice President (Finance) of M/s My Home Industries Private Limited briefed the expansion proposal and Environmental impact of the expansion project. He addressed the dais and assembled public and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed expansion project, environmental management, pollution control measures, afforestation programme and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed expansion project.

Then Sri Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar, Jajpur requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

- 1. Smt. Laxmipriya Das, Sarapanch, Byree GP**  
She greeted the dais & gathering and demanded that her village be adopted by the Company for development.
- 2. Smt. Bilasini Khuntia, PS Member, Byree**  
Smt. Khuntia welcomed the panel and gathering. She thanked the company for choosing her village for establishment of the plant and demanded local employment & adoption of her village for development activity etc.
- 3. Sri Akshaya Kumar Sahoo, Byree**  
Sri Sahoo welcomed the project and greeted the dais and public present in the public hearing meeting. He further requested for adoption of his village for development work, local employment and environment protection of his local area etc.
- 4. Sri Biranchi Narayan Swain, Byree**



Sri Swain told that he had discussed with the local people regarding establishment of the proposed project and the Company also had a discussion with local people. He informed that local public support the project and requested the District Administration to constitute a committee to look after the employment and development of local area. He further requested the company to take necessary step for pollution control in his area.

5. **Sri Ganeshwar Baral, Vice President, Zilla Parishad, Jajpur**

Sri G. Baral welcomed the panel and gathering and expressed his support for the proposed project. He requested the Company to take step for local employment, Environment protection, adoption of Byree village for development, plantation activity etc. Sri Baral finally requested the Company to install modern technology machineries for control of environmental pollution to be caused by plant.

6. **Sri Jatindra Prasad Nayak, Zilla Parishad Member, Zone 16, Jajpur**

Sri Nayak greeted the public gathering & dais and expressed his support for the proposed project. He requested the R&B dept. a proposal for construction of a bypass road and requested the company to take necessary step for environment pollution control, preference in local employment as per qualification, less use of ground water, portable drinking water, plantation and solid waste management in the local area etc.

7. **Sri Bijay Kumar Nayak, Byree**

Sri Nayak thanked the Government for bringing industry in his area. He supported the project and demanded preference in employment and training to local people.

8. **Sri Benudhar Biswal, Sarpanch, Paria GP**


Sri B. Biswal expressed his support for the expansion proposal of the Company. He raised the concern on environment pollution to be caused by the company and demanded adoption of his local village for development and CSR activity etc. Finally, Sri Biswal expressed his support for the proposed project of the Company.

9. **Sri Kshitish Nayak, Byree**

Sri greeted the gathering and expressed his support for the project. He requested the District administration to take necessary step for local development and demanded the Company to take step for environment protection & improvement of healthcare facility in the local area.

10. **Sri Bhagyadhar Mohanty, Byree**

Welcoming the panel & gathering, Sri Mohanty expressed his support for the project. He complained for not getting benefit by the earlier established

company as per their commitment. He requested the company to take necessary step on development of education, health & environment protection etc. He further requested the company to constitute a committee by taking the people of Byree and carry out the development work as per the recommendation of the Committee.

**11. Sri Nilamani Rout, Solar GP**

Sri Rout greeted the gathering and told that the local people are hopeful on local employment and development by the project and also informed that local people will go on strike if their demand is not fulfilled by the Company. He demanded a bypass road and engagement of local vehicles for transportation activity of the plant.

**12. Sri Sanjay Kumar Behera, PS Member, Solar GP**

Sri Behera supported the proposed project and he was hopeful on employment and development by the proposed project. He demanded local employment, plantation and adoption of solar GP by the Company.

**13. Sri Chittaranjan Samal, ZP Member, Uchhapada, Tangi**

Sri Samal greeted the panel & gathering and recommended that the affected area should be clearly mentioned in the advertisement. He expressed his support for the proposed project but demanded local employment, engagement of local vehicle for transportation activity of the industry, plantation, separate road for truck transportation etc. He further demanded his local panchayats (2 nos.) to be taken care for development work by the Company as his village and GP is coming under affected area.

**14. Smt. Jayanti Swain, Sarpanch, Nelia GP**

Smt. Swain welcomed the gathering and demanded adoption of Nelia GP, education and health facility, local area development, plantation, local employment etc.

**15. Sri Deepak Sahoo, PS Member, Chhatia GP**

Sri Sahoo expressed his support for the project but demanded local employment, environment protection, less consumption of ground water, adoption of his village for periphery development, no entry system for truck transportation during morning hours etc.

**16. Sri Bijay Swain, Sarpanch, Solar GP**

Sri Swain greeted the gathering and demanded local employment, periphery development to the Company. He was hopeful that the local area will be benefitted by the project.

**17. Sri Trilochan Nayak, Byree**



He welcomed the panel & gathering and demanded the Company to construct the main gate of the industry towards Byree in Jajpur district and requested to give preference to Byree for development work.

18. **Sri Raj Kishore Swain, Byree**

Sri Swain informed the public that about 60 Acres of land from Byree GP has been taken by the Company. He demanded adoption of his village and GP by the Company for development and local employment.

19. **Sri Bipin Bihari Nayak, Byree**

Sri Nayak informed that they are facing issue of environment pollution due to road transportation and vehicular movement by the existing industries. He requested the administration to take necessary step to address the issue.

20. **Sri Binod Kumar Das, Byree**

Sri Das greeted the dais and expressed his concern on dust issue to be faced during road transportation, vehicular movement etc. and was also hopeful of getting benefitted by establishment of the industry. He demanded local preference in employment (demanded 50% to 70% employment to Byree GP), adoption of Byree GP, development of healthcare facility, free distribution of medicine, periphery development etc. Finally, Sri Das expressed his support for the proposed project.

21. **Sri Basudev Swain, Champapur GP**

He welcomed the gathering and demanded periphery development, plantation, local employment, construction of separate transport corridor, less use of ground water, completion of label crossing work etc.

22. **Sri Bhainaba Prasad Behera, Upula**

Sri Behera told that they are not against industrialization but questioned if the proposed area is sufficient for the project and also if the proposed requirement of water is sufficient for the proposed industry. He raised concern on ground water use by the proposed industry, land accusation policy of the industries and pollution of Ganda nala by the industries in Kalinganagar area. He urged the Company to take step for local employment and development or they will be opposed by the people of the area.

23. **Sri Madhabananda Mohapatra, Solar**

Sri Mohapatra greeted the dais & gathering and welcomed the proposed project in his area. He complained on non-employment from the Solar GP in the already established plant of M/s OCL even if commitment was given earlier during the public hearing meeting of the Company. He further complained on vehicle traffic issue in the area due to transportation vehicle of

the existing industry. He demanded solar by pass road, control of vehicle traffic, local employment and local area development etc.

24. **Sri Sudhanshu Rout, Solar**

Sri Rout greeted the gathering and welcomed the proposed project in his area. He complained on unemployment and non-development in Solar GP by the established industries in the area and demanded the Company to take step for employment and development in Solar GP.

25. **Sri Manoj Khillar, Mania**

Sri Khillar welcomed the gathering and told that he is not against industrialization. He intimated that development is associated with industrialization but complained on non-cooperation from the established industries in the area. He demanded the Company to include mania village for peripheral development and local employment etc.

26. **Sri Prahallad Nanda, Badachana**

Sri Nanda greeted the gathering and hoped for employment of local people in the proposed industry. He raised the concern of facing dust pollution but supporting the industry to get local employment, however earlier commitment given by M/s OCL cement Limited on local employment has not been fulfilled. He demanded local employment, less ground water use, railway over bridge, engagement of local truck in the industry, adoption of local village for peripheral development etc.

27. **Sri Biswa Ranjan Swain, Byree**

Sri Swain complaint that commitment is given but not fulfilled by the Company. He requested the District Administration to make assessment on fulfillment of demand raised by the public during the public hearing.

28. **Sri Ashok Kumar Swain, Amiyajhari**

He informed that local area people are not getting employment as per commitment. He told that they are not against industrialization and asked for Company cooperation. Finally, he expressed his support for the proposed project of the Company.

29. **Sri Tanmay Kumar Swain, Byree**

He informed that his house is situated near to the proposed site and asked the company for support. He requested non movement of truck during school time, an overbridge at Byree label crossing, step environment protection, noise pollution control, education & hospital facility etc.

30. **Sri Pradipta Jena, Chandikhol**




He informed that commitment of earlier established Company has not been fulfilled and requested the proposed proponent to fulfill all the commitment or they will face the consequences by the public in the local area.


31. **Sri Padmanav Samal, Byree**

He informed the public that less pollution is seen in such type of industry. He requested the Company to give preference in local employment and engagement. He expressed his support for the proposed project of the Company.

Local Employment</li> </ol>	<p>Sri Sushant Kumar Padhi, Sr. Vice President (Finance) of M/s My Home Industries Private Limited, made commitment to certain issues raised by the public are as follows:</p> <p>Sri Padhi assured that new and latest technology plant and machinery will be installed in the proposed project wherein pollution will be minimal.</p> <p>He further informed that the proposal is for a grinding unit, so very less water will be used (50 KLD) which will be treated for further use. The treated water shall be recycled &amp; reused for gardening and plantation purpose. Company will ensure pollution control in the industry.</p> <p>He informed that, as per the company policy, local people are given preference for employment. He committed that local people will get preference in employment and employment will be given as per their educational qualification. Local development has been carried out by the Company on all the established plant area and assured that local development will also be carried out in the proposed project area.</p> <p>Finally, Sri Padhi thanked the public for coming and expressing their views on the proposed project of the Company.</p>
