**PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF M/S BUDURA RIVER SAND BED OF SMT JANAKI DEVI MISHRA FOR PRODUCTION OF 50,000 CUM / ANNUM OF SAND OVER AN AREA OF 6.0 HA (PLOT NO. 696(P), KHATA NO.188 & 189) IN VILLAGE BUDURA, KASHINAGAR TAHASIL IN THE DISTRICT OF GAJAPATI HELD ON 20.07.2022 AT 11.00 A.M. IN THE GRAM PANCHAYAT OFFICE OF BUDURA VILLAGE UNDER KASHINAGAR PANCHAYAT SAMITI IN GAJAPATI DISTRICT**

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 20.07.2022 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in Budura village under Kashinagar Panchayat Samiti area of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Rayagada welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Shri Pradeep Kumar Nayak, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Gajapati highlighted on importance of such hearing & presided over the public hearing.

Project Consultant Sri Rabi Kumar of M/s Budura River Sand Bed has explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the Project.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rayagada.

**1. Sri Hrusikesh Gauda, Kashinagar**

Sri Gauda questioned on the type of pollution control measures to be adopted in this sand mining project.

**2. Sri Sanjay Kumar Mishra, Sarapanch, Budura**

Sri Mishra opined about his no objection in this sand mining project. He told that water level of the river will be reduced due to sand mining and so it is essential to extract sand from river for the sake of local people.

**3. Sri T, Savarayya Budura**

Sri Savarayya told that sand should be extracted from the river to avoid flow of flood water to their village area. He welcomed the sand mining project.

**4. Sri I Manmadha Rao, Budura**

Sri Rao expressed his views in Telugu and told that they have no objection if sand will be extracted from the river by the project proponent. Further, he repeated that sand should be extracted from the river to prevent enter of flood water into their village.

**5. Sri B Bhaskar Rao, Budura**

Sri Rao said that they have no objection on excavation of sand from the river by the project proponent. Further, he told that due to heap of sand stacked in the river bed, there is possibility of entering of river water into their village.

6. **Sri Sandaka Chiranjebi, Budura**

Sri Chiranjebi told that if sand mining will be started then there will be development of their village.

7. **Sri I Rama Krishna, Budura**

Sri Krishna said that they have no objection in this sand mining project. If sand will not be extracted from the river bed, then their crop fields will be damaged due to sand deposition. Further he stressed upon constructing of stone guard wall along their village to prevent flow of river water.

8. **Sri P Tavitiayya, Budura**

Sri Tavitiayya told that more the excavation of sand from the river, it will be good for their village Budura.

9. **Sri B Baburao, Samiti Member, Budura**

Sri Baburao expressed his happiness in this sand mining project and told that private land should not be affected due to such sand mining project.

10. **Sri Braja Sundar Dash, Budura**


Sri Dash told that they have no problem with this sand mining project. He also added that sand should be extracted from the river for the benefit of local people and also for safety of river bank. He requested the District administration to keep attention if pollution issues arises.

The Regional Officer, SPCB, Rayagada read over the issues raised by the public in the hearing and On behalf of Project Proponent Sri Mishra responded to the issues raised for M/s Budura River Sand Bed.



It is brought to the notice of all concerned that Smt. Janaki Devi Mishra has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for Buddha River Sand Bed over an area of 6.0 Ha (Plot No. 696(P), Khata No. 188 & 189) in village Buddha under Kashinagar tehsil of Gajapati district to obtain Environmental Clearance from State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha. The proposal has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for a Public Hearing.

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India, Notification No. S.O. 1538 (E) Dtd: 14.09.2006 the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site/sites of displacement/sites likely to be affected.

- For the above purpose, a person will only mean:
- A. Any person who is likely to be affected by the grant of Environmental Clearance.
  - B. Any person who owns his control over the project with respect to which an application has been submitted for environmental clearance.
  - C. Any association of persons, whether incorporated or likely to be affected by the project and/or functioning in the field of environment.
  - D. Any local authority within any part of whose local limits is within the neighborhood wherein the project is proposed to be located.

Persons as above who desire to submit their views, comments, objections or (where applicable) to the project may do so in writing within 30 days from the date of publication of this notice, addressing the same to the Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha through Registered Post. Besides this, persons interested to submit their views relevant to the proposed mining project in writing or orally may also do so during the public hearing to be conducted on 20.07.2022 at 11.00 A.M. in the Gram Panchayat Office of Buddha village under Kashinagar Panchayat Samiti in Gajapati District.
