PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 14.09.2022 (11.00 AM) AT MOUZA KANCHICHUA (OVER PLOT NO 290 UNDER KHATA NO 61) TEHSIL SUKINDA IN THE DISTRICT OF JAJPUR FOR EXPANSION OF CHROME ORE BENEFICIATION UNIT CAPACITY FROM 18,500 TPA TO 1.15 LTPA AND CHROME MONOLITHIC UNIT CAPACITY FROM 24,000 TPA TO 72,000 TPA OF M/S CHROME SAGAR AT VILLAGE PUBALA IN JAJPUR DISTRICT

The public hearing in respect of the project proposed by M/s. Chrome Sagar for expansion of chrome ore beneficiation unit capacity from 18,500 TPA to 1.15 LTPA and chrome monolithic unit capacity from 24,000 TPA to 72,000 TPA was held on scheduled date & time at Mouza Kanchichua(over Plot No 290 under Khata No 61) in the district of Jajpur with reference to:

- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006.
- II. Interim Operational Guidelines till 13th September 2007 in respect of applications made under EIA-1994.

The Panel consisted of the following members:

1. Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, Jajpur
2. Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Kalinganagar.

Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and assisted by Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by M/s. Chrome Sagar.

Welcoming the public, Sri S.K. Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Jagabandhu Bisoi, Nabbate Associate, Kalyani Laboratory addressed the committee members and assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution



control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Sri Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar, requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. **Smt. Sipra Rani Baral, Sarapanch, Dudujhari**
She welcomed the panel and expressed her support for the expansion project and requested to provide drinking water facility in their village, medical facility, transportation facility and employment of the local youth.
2. **Smt. Gouri Tiria, Samiti Sabhya, Mangalpur**
She welcomed to the local gathering. She told that all the villagers should work together in the plant and support the project. She also told that they are facing difficulties for drinking water.
3. **Sri Akshaya Nayak, Ex-Sarapanch**
He welcomed the panel, gathering & media and told that they should happily support the public hearing proposed by M/s Chrome Sagar. He told that in the past five years M/s Chrome Sagar is with him in the difficulties. The plant has provided school bags to children, repaired old houses. Local people from the village Haridabahali, Pubala and Bhaluki are employed in the plant. If expansion will occur then more numbers will get opportunity for employment. People will find employment and earned more money. He told that all villagers should support the expansion & he personally support the expansion project.
4. **Sri Dhushasn Tiria, Mangalpur**
Welcoming to the Panel & gathering, they hope that in coming days M/s Chrome Sagar will solve the unemployment issues in their locality, Local development will be more. Chrome Sagar will solve the problem of Local village roads, Drinking water problem in their locality. He told that local people will get opportunity for earning in nearby and they will not have to go anywhere for job. He suggested Chrome Sagar to maintain good relationship with the local villagers. Lastly he supports and welcomes the project.
5. **Sri Dhruba Charan Mahanta, Mangalpur**
He fully supports the proposed expansion of the plant.
6. **Sri Bipin Mallick, Bhutumunda**
He welcomed the panel and gathering expressed that Chrome Sagar will bring golden opportunity in their locality. Local People will find employment if the plant expands. He hopes that villagers of Kanchichua & Pubala will fully



support the project. He supports for the proposed expansion project of M/s Chrome Sagar & gave thanks to owner of Chrome Sagar.

7. **Sri Keshab Ch. Nayak, Kanchichua**

They support the project and suggested for development of school and education facility in their locality.

8. **Sri Ganeswar Nayak, Pubala**

He was happy for the proposed expansion of chrome sagar but he expressed that plant is situated at revenue village of pubala but there is no name of the village pubala in the public hearing. Local villagers are going to Chennai, Hyderabad, Sukinda, Bhuban for employment but they are not finding employment opportunity in Chrome Sagar. They are suffering from skin disease. They are finding difficulties for drinking water in the local villages. Everybody should find opportunity to give their views in the public hearing. He suggested for solving the drinking water problem at first. He told that higher education and medical facility should be provided to the local villagers. He will happy and proud for the expansion of the plant but he told that they are not entitled to entry into the plant. He told that if expansion will be done more polluted water will come from plant to the nearby paddy field. He suggested for complete treatment of waste water.

9. **Sri Sibasingh Naik, Kanchichua**

He fully supports the expansion of M/s Chrome Sagar. He told his personal view that local people from the village of Pubala, Kanchichua and Mangalpur will find direct and indirect employment opportunity. Due to transportation through their village, it is getting congested due to traffic movement so that school students are facing problem. He suggested for repairing and widening of road. He also suggested for development of school and education facility in their locality. From pollution point of view, if separate drainage will be provided for water coming from the plant then farmers will not find any problem. If they will cooperate among themselves and support the expansion project of chrome sagar in coming days they will be developed and chrome sagar will be developed. Lastly he gave his support for the proposed expansion.

10. **Sri Manash Tiria, Kanchichua**

He welcomed the gathering and told that if drinking water facility, education, school and road communication facility will be provided in the village Pubala, Kanchicua, Mangalpur then he will support the expansion project.

11. **Sri Gopal Munda, Kanchichua**

He welcomed the panel and told that people are finding difficulties in drinking water in the local villages of Pubala, Kanchichua, Mangalpur and Haridabahali. People are suffering from kidney diseases due to drinking water. Metals are coming in the drinking water. He requested Chrome Sagar

to facilitate two or three numbers of bore well in every village. He also requested to provide better education facility in the school. He told that there are five classes in the school and two teachers are teaching and he requested for enhancement of classes as well as teacher in the school. He also requested for better medical facility in their locality.

12. **Sri Nabaghana Mohanta, Bhaluki**

He gave thanks to all and told that plant is situated in their village and their village name is not displayed which is not right.

13. **Sri Mayadhara Mohanta, Bhaluki**

He told that plant is coming under Bhaluki village and public hearing is conducted at Kanchichua. They are not aware about the public hearing. He told that they are suffering due to red water discharging from the plant and why villagers of kanchichua will get benefitted.

14. **Sri Dinabandhu Nayak, Pubala**

He welcomed the panel and gathering and told that everybody is telling about development but there is no development. He told that development should be made for road construction, lighting facility and employment opportunity for local villagers. He told that development should be made in reality not in the spoken words.

15. **Sri Gouranga Mohanta, Mangalpur**

He welcomed Chrome Sagar. He told that some people are giving support and some people are complaining. He suggested for development of road communication facility, drinking water and medical facility. He supports the proposed project subjected to fulfillment of the above issues.

16. **Sri Kusha Mohanta, Mangalpur**

He welcomed the panel and gathering. He gave his full support to M/s chrome Sagar. He requested to the owner of Chrome Sagar for giving first and more importance to the village Pubala, Haridabahali and Bhaluki. He gave his full support to Chrome sagar.

17. **Manoranjan Behera, Mangalpur**

He welcomed the panel and gathering. He gave his full support to M/s Chrome Sagar. He told that first and more importance should be given to the village Pubala, Haridabahali and Bhaluki.

18. **Sri Amarendra Nayak, Pubala**

He welcomed the panel and gathering and he supported M/s Chrome Sagar as it is coming in their revenue village Pubala. He also supported the expansion project of M/s Chrome Sagar. He told that the plant should give more importance to the village Pubala, Haridabahali and Kanchichua. He



suggested for expansion of narrow road as students from different Schools and Anganwadi are using the narrow road on daily basis. He told that expansion of narrow road should be made on priority basis.

19. **Sri Rohit Khuntia, Damadarpur**

He told that their village Dudujhari has separate name in the past. There is village neither coming under the plant jurisdiction nor in the mines jurisdiction, but at present they can tell that one plant is situated in their village. In the past they are not finding employment opportunity in the mines and plant. He told that their village finding separate entity as the plant is coming and if expansion will occur then more developmental work will be done in their village. He supports the proposed expansion of the plant.

20. **Sri Arun Nayak, Mangalpur**

He welcomed the panel and gathering. He told that all the villages of Pubala, Haridabahali, Kanchichua and Bhaluki are coming under pubala. He requested the owner of Chrome Sagar to giving importance to Dudujhari G.P. He also suggested for medical facility, drinking water facility and expansion of narrow road. He told that all the villages are coming under Dudujhari G.P so there will be no argument about separate villages. If the plant will expand then more developmental work will be done in Dudujhari G.P. He supports the proposed expansion.

21. **Sri Paban Munda, Bhaluki**

He welcomed the gathering and told that more numbers of poor people are residing in their village. He told that they support the expansion if the local people will find some opportunity for earning and employment. In future if they will not find any help from the plant they will oppose the plant.

22. **Sri Narayan Chandra Nayak, Pubala**

He told that if the plant comes then all the villages will be developed not only a single village. He requested to the authority to solve the issues & difficulties among the villagers of different villages.

23. **Smt. Sarathi Mohanta, Mangalpur**

She told that they are facing problem due to narrow road and waste water from the plant to their paddy field. She suggested for expansion of narrow road and water treatment facility.

24. **Sri Abhaya Kumar Nayak, kanchichua**

He told that many people from their villages Pubala, Kanchichua are getting benefitted due to plant operation. He told that the school students are facing problem due to transportation of heavy vehicles in the narrow road during day time. He also told that local people should get employment opportunity

according to their educational qualification. He requested to the owner of chrome sagar to restrict the transportation of heavy vehicles during only night time from 8 p.m onwards to morning 6 a.m and provide employment opportunity to local villagers according to their qualification.

25. **Sri Sunil Mallick, Anantapur**

He supported M/s Chrome Sagar.

26. **Sri Sunakar Munda, Word Member**

He told that villagers of pubala should be developed. Development of poor people should be done.

27. **Sri Banamali Nayak, Mayadharpur**

He welcomed the panel & gathering. 150 Trips of murom has been provided by M/s Chrome Sagar for repairing of road in rainy season. 30 number of lights has been provided by Chrome Sagar from Kanchichua to Haridabahali. He supports the expansion project and requested for road expansion.

28. **Smt. Bharati Haibru, Harida Bahali**

She welcomed the gathering and told that the transporting vehicles are running in high speed so that students from different School and Anganwadi are facing problems. Speed of transporting vehicles should be restricted. They are not finding drinking water facility and in summer season drinking water scarcity was there. Drinking water facility should be provided by the plant. Medical facility should be provided in Pubala, Haridabahali, Bhaluki villages. There are two teacher in the Haridabahali School which should be solved.

29. **Smt. Subhadra Mohanta, Mangalpur**

She is happy with other villagers.

30. **Sri Basudev Naik, Kanchichua**

He told that they have right to speak in the public hearing. There is no development in their area and unemployment issue was also in their area. Earlier similar public hearing was conducted for Ramkay plant which is situated in Kanchichua. Similar development & employment issues were also there but till date they are not getting benefitted. He told that people should be educated and become independent. He told about development of all people not in individual.

31. **Sri Kulamani Mohanta, Kanchichua**

He welcomed the panel and told that they are in favor of development and expansion of the project but with certain conditions. Transportation road should be separated from the public road as children and public are using the road. They are giving temporary permission for transportation. Special road



for transportation should be constructed from the plant to highway away from the public habitant within a time bound. Now heavy vehicles are running in the public road and they are facing problem and school students are also facing problem. He questioned that if any accident occurred who will be responsible. He supported the project but if special road will not be provided for transportation then they will oppose in future shortly. They are giving permission on temporary basis for transportation in the public road. He also proposed that canal road connecting from Rengali to Sukinda should be developed so that transporting vehicles will move in that road.

32. **Smt. Kuni Mohanta, Bhaluki**

She told that the plant is situated nearer to paddy field. Red and muddy water coming from the plant enters into their paddy field which damaged the paddy. In summer season their cows drinks the muddy water and suffered. She told that who will be responsible for the above issues. She told that there is no village road in their village Pubala and Bhaluki and the transporting heavy vehicles are moving in that road, so people and children are suffering. The road was not repaired by the plant. The plant authority has committed to provide two numbers of lights in their village but till date they have not provided. Local people from their villages were not finding employment opportunity in the plant according to their educational qualification so that they are going to outside for employment. He told that the plant should not discharge the muddy water to outside.

33. **Sri Kulamani Nayak, Pubala**


He supports the expansion of the plant.

34. **Sri Manguli Ch. Nayak, Mangalpur**

He welcomed the panel and gathering and told that in last thirty years there was no light and road to their village but Chrome Sagar have opened their eyes. He told that it's just the beginning and more development will be made in future. He supports the proposed expansion of M/s Chrome Sagar.

35. **Sri Brundaban Mohanta, Bhaluki**

The plant owner should consult with the local villagers and nearby surrounding people. The plant boundary was situated in their plot and muddy water coming to their paddy field. Heavy transporting vehicles are plying in the village road. He gave thanks that they are finding some help due to transportation. He told that plant should provide an ETP. He told that people are engaged on temporary basis. He suggested for permanent employment in the plant. Transporting movement should be carried out after 9 p.m. Local people of Bhaluki village are affected but they are not engaged in the plant. He requested for engagement local affected people in the plant.




36. **Smt Jabani Soiy, Kanchichua**

She welcomed the gathering and told that if people were supporting the project then she also supporting. She told that local people will be employed and earn money from the plant for their livelihood.

37. **Smt. Rita Mohanta, Kanchichua**

She told that transporting vehicles should be restricted during day time and movement of vehicles should be from 9 p.m to 4 a.m. Their children's are facing lot of problem due to movement of transporting vehicles. She told that they supported the project and requested to provide drinking water facility in Haridabahali and Pubala village.

The Panel has received 111 nos. of written representations during the hearing which are enclosed herewith in original those have been annexed. Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar asked the project proponent to present their comments to the people with respect to the demands raised by the public in the public hearing meeting. Sri Rajendra Thatoi, Proprietor of M/s. Chrome Sagar made the commitment on issued raised by the public. The statement of issues and concern of the public with comments of the applicant prepared in English and Odia language and annexed separately. The meeting was ended with thanks to the chair.

Drinking water 5.Land Acquisition 6.Zero liquid discharge 	<p>Sri Rajendra Thatoi, Proprietor on behalf of M/s. Chrome Sagar, Who was present at the public hearing meeting committed to certain issues raised by the public are as follows:</p> <p>Sri Thatoi welcomed all to the gathering. He told that there is a proposal of road from the plant to highway which will be completed within two to three months of time. The road will go separately from the village area of Haridabahali & Kanakhai which is under processing at Govt Level.</p> <p>He told that according to plant requirement and qualification of local people, he has provided employment to the local people. In future if the capacity of plant enhanced, employment will be given to the local villagers. He told that approximately 30 to 35 local people have been engaged in the plant both directly and indirectly.</p> <p>Two staffs from the plant have been engaged for safe and smooth transportation of vehicles in the village road. In next two months direct road will be connected from the plant to highway.</p> <p>He told that separate tap in front of the plant has been provided for drinking water purpose of local villagers. He also told that water tankers are always provided at Haridabahali G.P when required. He agreed to provide bore well in each village in consultation with village committee.</p>

	<p>He told that their staffs are engaged during transportation of vehicles in the village area for safe movement and transportation activity was only during night time from 9 p.m to morning.</p> <p>Rain water harvesting has been provided by the plant and no waste water coming from the plant to outside as the plant has boundary wall all the side. Cows and other animals could not enter into the plant, so that they will not be affected.</p> <p>He told that they have not acquired other land. When the plant was started during 2018, in presence of all people plant boundary demarcation has been done. He told that if any land acquisition would found illegal against him then he agreed to leave the land.</p> <p>Zero liquid discharge has been maintained by the plant. Tailing pond has been provided separately. Water is completely recycled in the washing process and water loss is due to evaporation. No wash water is coming to outside from the plant.</p>
