

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING HELD ON 30.08.2022 (AT 11.00 AM) AT SRI SRI BAYABABA COLLEGE, MAHAKALAPADA WITH RESPECT TO ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR PETROLEUM, CHEMICALS AND PETROCHEMICAL INVESTMENT REGION (PCPIR) AT PARADIP ENCOMPASSING PARTS OF JAGATSINGHPUR AND KENDRAPARA DISTRICTS (FOR KENDRAPARA DISTRICT) FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE.

The public hearing in respect of the project proposed by M/s Odisha Industrial Infrastructure Development Corporation for Petroleum, Chemicals and Petrochemical Investment Region (PCPIR) at Paradeep encompassing parts of Jagatsinghpur and Kendrapara Districts (for Kendrapara District) was held on scheduled date & time with reference to:

- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006 and Amendments thereafter.

The Panel consisted of the following members:

2. Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Paradeep, Odisha

Sri Durga Prasad Maharana, Additional District Magistrate, Kendrapara supervised & presided over the public hearing process which was assisted by Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Paradeep, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting, the Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Paradeep, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of the project proposed by IDCO.

Shri Behera explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public, gathered in the meeting

about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Shri Ashok Kumar Mishra, CGM (Environment), IDCO addressed the committee members and assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management and various other CSR activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Paradeep requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. Shri Alay Samantaray, Masakani, Mahakalapara:

He gave his conditional support to the project stating that inhabitants of Kendrapada become hopeful and happy if there is proposal of any industrial setup in the district. Though he supported the project he opposed the proposals where forest and agricultural land shall be hampered. He told that no educational institution should be affected and no family shall be homeless and there shall be job opportunity for two-five members to each affected family. He also demanded for provision of free health care/mobile health care and vocational training to the youth of district. He also mentioned that people of Kendrapara have already been affected due to Paradeep Port Authority and other industries for which minimum five hundred crores investment should be utilized in Kendrapara before the project. He urged that study should be conducted to check the impact of the project on Bhitarkanika. Water of the river like Mahanadi, Chitrotpala, Paika and Ashrukhalajora is utilized for agriculture in the area, which should not be affected due to the proposed project. Excess water of the river if used in the project then they have no problem. He also opposed truck terminal project for parking of trucks and heavy vehicles in Kendrapara rather, requested to shift the proposal to Jagatsinghpur and Jajpur district. He mentioned that if these demand will not be fulfilled the project will be opposed in all respect.

2. Shri Rajani Kanta Nayak, Badapaldiha, Marashaghai:

He said that proposed project area of Kendrapada is a delta area which is quite fertile. Water requirement for the project and source of water should be made clear by the proponent. There shall be clarity whether ground water will be used or not. In the EIA report he questioned about any assessment study has been done or not regarding future

water demand and water scarcity. He questioned about is there any study regarding obstruction of storm water course due to the project as the area being a flood plain zone. He also said that in the draft EIA report the quantity and nature of hazardous and non-hazardous solid waste, liquid waste should be clearly mentioned and quantity of water utilization wastewater generation and treated wastewater utilization shall be made clear. He also demanded that during the implementation and exestuation of the project forest, agricultural land, human health and habitations should be taken care off.

3. Shri Khitish Kumar Singh, Khadinga, Kendrapada:

Welcoming the proposed PCPIR project of Industrial Infrastructure Development Corporation at Kendrapara he said that socio economic condition and life style of Kendrapada people will change. He focused on some significant points which have been mentioned very limited in the draft EIA report such as impact on mangrove eco system, proportion of mixing of fresh water and saline water substance of mangrove species etc. As 620 MLD of water of Mahanadi will be used for the project he demanded to know some facts such as inflow of fresh water to bay of Bengal during monsoon and non-monsoon period after construction of dams over river Mahanadi in Chhatisgarh and how all these will affect mangrove eco-system. He mentioned that environmental protection is a prime importance and urged that a committee by MoEF and CC, Govt. of India should be formed to study impact of the project on Mahanadi and its bio-diversity reach mangrove eco system aqua organisms(Crocodile, Olive Ridley, Pomfret, Hilsa), saline water fresh water replenishment study. He also requested that during consideration of Environmental Clearance of the project, priority should be given on environment protection and sustainable development.

4. Pratap Chandra Mohanty, Marsaghai:

He told that draft EIA report of the proposed project is false and manipulated one without proper data. He addressed the problem of Ramnagar area of Mahakalapada block for odor problem due to operation of IFFCO. He also alleged that people of Kendrapara have already been affected due to Paradeep Port Authority and other industries. Frequent road accidents, Zero CSR fund to Kendrapada District in contrary to Jagatsinghpur District are some of the examples. He demanded that project should be focused in Kendrapada and Kendrapada district should be declared as local engagement of at least 70% as manpower.

5. Shri Narayan Chandra Haldar, Kharinasi:

Though he welcomed the project he became skeptical about the execution of the project. He said that dredging done by IFFCO and ESSAR in Mahanadi for filling of their low laying land caused land erosion and sub merge of land of Kendrapada. He wanted to know whether similar activity will be done for this project or not. He also said that rules

and restrictions regarding national park and marine sanctuary should be less stringent so as to have industrial infrastructure setup at nearby areas. He also questioned about public announcement done for the public hearing and requested to conduct public hearing once again to taking villagers of proposed project area of Marshaghai and Mahakalpara.

6. Shri Subash Swain, Mahakalpara:

He alleged that details of forest species, foreign migratory birds, marine animal species, Olive Ridley are not mentioned in the draft EIA report. He alleged that due to industrial pollution agricultural harvest has been affected. He also mentioned odor problem from IFFCO during monsoon and flow of south breeze.

7. Shri Sashikanta Mohanty, Purusottampur:

He said that though people of Mahakalpara are directly affected due to fertilizer industry of IFFCO and PPL of Paradeep, utilization of CSR fund of industry is not done for welfare projects in Kendrapada. There should be sensitization programme in every village level regarding this.

8. Shri Satyananda Mohanty, Kodakana:

Though he signed in the speaker list did not speak.

9. Shri Biranchi Narayan Das, Mahakalpara:

He expressed his ignorance about public announcement regarding schedule of public hearing. He wanted to know about the location from which dredging will be done for filling of the low laying area of the propose project. He conditionally supported the project and showed his concern about water, land and soil.

10. Shri Samir Kumar Behera, Ashrambalikuda:

Though he signed in the speaker list did not speak.

11. Shri Chinmaya Das, Sonasahi:

He alleged that since establishment of Paradeep Port in 1962, Kendrapada area is being used for transportation path only. Even though losing thousand acres of land for industrial purpose, no developmental activity has been done in Kendrapada. CSR funding is not utilized for development of Kendrapada. He apprehended mangrove forest will be hampered due to industrial development and hence demanded for pollution free industrial unit.

12. Shri Satyananda Mohanty, Patalipanka:

Though he signed in the speaker list did not speak.

13. Shri Ashok Kumar Swain, Mahakalpara:

He said that majority of the proposed area is surrounded by river and water bodies. The area is mainly sallow and livelihood of the people is agriculture and fishery. He said that people and fisherman of Mahakalpara area is affected due to industrial pollution and apprehended that the proposed project will affect Bhitarkanika, Gahiramatha region and mangrove forest and will also negative impact on livelihood of farmers and fisherman. He requested for ambulance service to Mahakalpara and financial aid to CHC Mahakalpara.

14. Shri Debi Prasad Mishra, Patalipanka:

Welcoming the project, he appreciated the process of public hearing where views of the public regarding environmental implication of the project is collected. He said that 90 % people of the area are under below poverty line. Being a flood plain area Mahakalapada people depend on river for their livelihood. He told that Paradeep is a growing industrial hub and effect of pollution from industries like PPL, IFFCO, IOCL is there in the form of water discharge and air emission to atmosphere. He mentioned that plantation is affected due to industrial emission and fishery is affected due to water discharge. He demanded that a team should be formed to address the issues related the project to sensitize people in Panchayat level. He also said that due to industrial project financial and standard of leaving and financial condition of the people will improve.

The Panel received five (05) nos. of written representations of the local people demanding different facilities in the locality during the hearing which are enclosed herewith in original.

Observation:


The overall opinion of the public about the proposed project was mixed type. However, the local people have some aspirations as laid down in their deliberations.




