PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF JAKARA DECORATIVE STONE QUARRY OF M/S TEJASWINI GRANITE FOR PRODUCTION OF 7,000 CUM / ANNUM OF DECORATIVE STONE OVER AN AREA OF 22.67HA IN VILLAGE JAKARA, RAYAGADA TAHASIL IN THE DISTRICT OF GAJAPATI HELD ON 12.09.2022 AT 11.00 A.M. IN THE GRAM PANCHAYAT OFFICE OF KERANDI VILLAGE UNDER RAYAGADA PANCHAYAT SAMITI IN GAJAPATI DISTRICT

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 12.09.2022 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in Jakara village, Kerandi Grampanchayat under Rayagada Panchayat Samiti area of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Rayagada welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Shri Pradeep Kumar Nayak, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Gajapati highlighted on importance of such hearing & presided over the public hearing.

Sri Somorendra Mohanty, project consultant of Jakara Decorative Stone Quarry of M/s Tejaswini Granite has explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the Project.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rayagada.

#### 1. Sri Raghunath Sabar, Ex-Sarapanch, Kerandi GP

Sri Sabar welcomed the Decorative stone mining project and told that 15 to 20 years before, one of the Contractor has placed this Granite mining proposal at their Jakara village committee, but that time due to some discrepancies and disputes, the project could not pass in their village committee. But now after order of Hon'ble Supreme Court, Government has decided to give permission to the said Decorative stone mining project in their village Jakara. He strongly supported the Decorative stone mining project and expressed that if the project come in their village and 30 to 50 people will be engaged and benefitted. He opined that due to no factory available in their locality, people go to outside Odisha in search of job for their livelihood. He further said that if the Granite project will come, there will be development work in their village and local people will be benefitted.

#### 2. Sri Biswanath Sabar, Kerandi GP

Sri Sabar welcomed the project and told that their area is geographically hilly area and agricultural land are very less and so people of their area are poor. There is no provision of Dam & Drainage system for utilising water in agriculture. He said that their area has not yet developed due to lack of such agricultural land. He opined that people of their area mainly depend upon forest goods and cashew plantations for the livelihood. He said that some people go outside like Andhra, Berhampur and Bhubaneswar for income of money for their livelihood. He told that the education level of the people of their area is also not up to the mark as a result they could not get job. He said that, in 2007,

when he was a samiti sabhya of GP, such type of project proposal was placed before the gramsabha. But due to discrepancies proposal could not passed. But again, after 3 years of COVID, State Govt & Central Govt desires to expedite the approval process of decorative mining project proposal. He opined that the decorative stone lease is located in Andhra-Odisha Border and if the project will come in their locality, then minimum 30 people will be engaged in the mining project and local will get benefitted. He expressed that there is no out income of their panchayat. He requested for year wise CSR contribution towards development of their village and for local benefit. He strongly recommended in favour of the project.

## 3. Sri Jara Sabar, Jakara

Sri Sabar welcomed the Granite stone mining project. He introduced himself as a villager of Jakara. He thanks to the public and the Chairman of the meeting for conducting of the public hearing in their village. He told that earlier in the past the same project was discussed in their village committee meeting. But due to some discrepancies and disturbance, the same was not passed in the committee. But now when the Granite stone mining project again come in their village, he opined about his no objection in the project. He urged about the road development and village development through this project.

# 4. Sri Mirting Bhuyan, Lakhada

Sri Bhuyan welcomed the public and introduced himself as a villager of Lakhada and as a Ex-Naib Sarapanch (2002-2007) of the Grampanchayat. He told that Govt should think about the livelihood of 1200 habitants of the GP in addition to the 30 people of Jakara village to be engaged in the proposed Granite stone mining project. He requested the ADM, Gajapati and highlighted on scope of engagement of local villagers in NRGS work, CC Road work, Check Dam construction and flood protection related work to get their livelihood.

#### 5. Smt Jyoshnarani Bhuyan, Kerandi

Smt Bhuyan welcomed the public and introduced himself as a villager of Kerandi and as an AasaKarmi of the Grampanchayat. She urged upon development of road as well as requested the panel for provision of ambulance facility for attending medical delivery cases in the Panchayat.

#### 6. Sri Nagendra Sabar, Kerandi

Sri Sabar welcomed the public and quired on about the term & tenure of the Granite stone mining project proposal. He also questioned on the scope of benefit from the project regrading development of the village, employment & peripheral development. He also quired on whether the proponent has earlier consulted the villagers of Grampanhayat regarding the project proposal.

# 7. Sri Indramani Sabar, Kerandi

Sri Sabar welcomed the dias and the public. He told about the merit and demerit of the Granite stone mining project proposal. He urged upon the employment of other villagers in addition to the 30nos in the said mining project. He stressed upon to take permission of the panchayat in writing for their mining project. He expressed that, as the decorative stone lease is located in the Andhra-Odisha Border, then for any dispute the proponent has to resolve the issues. He requested the local public to cooperate the Granite stone mining project for expediting the approval process.

## 8. Sri Gorachand Bhuyan, Kerandi

Sri Bhuyan welcomed the public and the dias and introduced himself as a youth of Grampanchayat. He quired about the tenure of the granite stone mining project. He urged upon the employment of other local people in addition to the 30nos in the said mining project. He demanded for providing skill development training to the local youths for getting scope in the self-employment.

#### 9. Sri Laxman Sabar, Kerandi

Sri Sabar stressed upon the employment of 30nos of local villagers in the mining project and also urged on providing the insurance benefit as well as survival benefit to the workers to be engaged in the proposed project.

The Regional Officer, SPCB, Rayagada read over the issues raised by the public in the hearing and Sri Jagadeswar Rao, Project Proponent responded to the issues raised for Jakara Decorative Stone Quarry of M/s Tejaswini Granite.

Shri Pradeep Kumar Nayak, OAS (S), ADM (Revenue), Gajapati has given concluding remarks on the hearing and elaborated the process to be followed for submission of the proceeding to the SEIAA, Bhubaneswar for further action. He extended thanks to the public participated in the hearing and for offering their views, suggestions and objections.

The issues raised by the public and corresponding comments of the applicant were prepared in Odia and English and it is annexed with the proceedings as Annexure-I & II respectively, list of the oral deliberators and participants in the hearing is annexed as Annexure-III & IV respectively. The videography of proceedings are recorded and submitted as DVD (One number).

Hearing ended with thanks to the chair.


