PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF JUMKA PATHIRIPOSI PAHAR IRON ORE BLOCK OF M/S RUNGTA MINES LTD. (GREEN FIELD PROJECT) FOR PRODUCTION OF IRON ORE CAPACITY 3.35 MTPA AND 0.63 MTPA WASTE (TOTAL EXCAVATION 3.98 MTPA) ALONG WITH 3 x 250 TPH MOBILE CRUSHING PLANT SETS & 6 x 300 TPH MOBILE SCREENING PLANTS IN MINE LEASE AREA OF 158.509 HA IN VILLAGE KADAKALA UNDER BANSPAL TAHASIL HELD ON 09.09.2022 AT 11.00 AM AT KADAKALA PLAYGROUND, KHATA NO. 42 (RAKHITA), PLOT NO.51/314/1, TOTAL AREA 6.8100 HA PROPOSED AREA-3.0 HA IN DISTRICT KEONJHAR.

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 09.09.2022 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in nearby villages of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Er P Kar, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Smt. Susama Bilung, OAS(S), Additional District Magistrate, Keonjhar presided over and supervised the public hearing. She briefed about the importance and objectives of such hearing and invited the project proponent to highlight on proposed project.

Sri Dillip Kumar Parida, Senior General Manager (Project) of the mine explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the mine.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Keonjhar.

1. Sri Adit Kumar Dehury, Sarpanch, Kadakala Village

Sri Dehuri supported the public hearing and on behalf of the villagers he extended his support for the proposed mining activities of M/s. Rungta Mines ltd. At the same time, he drew attention on preservation of the local natural water bodies like river, nallah and stressed on tree plantation. As a Sarpanch he demanded for the villagers of his Panchayat to provide the basic necessities like education, hospital, road, electric connection etc. and also requested for establishment of one vocational training centre by the company for skill development so that employability of the local unemployed youths would be increased. He again assured full cooperation to the company on behalf of Kadakala GP.

2. Sri Jadumani Thakur, PS Member, Kadakala GP

Sri Thakur expressed his satisfaction over the briefing by the company on Pollution control measures & hoped that company should provide all sorts of basic needs to the local people as they are supporting the public hearing,

3. Sri Karunakar Patra, Kadakala GP, Rakam village, Ward No.1

Sri Patra expressed his happiness that people from different villages have assembled in the public hearing, as they could come to know about the public hearing through public address system. He expressed his happiness and felt proud that this mine is going to open at their area because people from their area are compelled to migrate to other states like Gujarat, Bangalore etc. to earn their livelihood. As a result, they were unable to look after their families. So this is a

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proud moment for them that under their Panchayat at their neighbouring village one mine is going to open by a reputed company like M/s. Rungta mines Ltd. He requested to start the mining activities as soon as possible.

4. Sri Arjun Behera

Sri Arjun supported the public hearing and requested to start the mine.

5. Sri Arjun Thakur, Kadakala Village

Sri Thakur supported the project and requested the company to provide all facilities to the local people.

6. Sri Bharat Chandra Dehury, Narsinghpur, Kadakala GP, Member Ward No.12

Sri Dehury supported the public hearing and read out 15-point demands which was jointly prepared by Sarpanch, Ward Members & Learned persons so that residents of the different villages could come to know about the same.

- i) Appropriate steps to be taken to protect the affected areas from pollution.
- ii) All sorts of facilities to be provided to the affected villagers.
- iii) One vocational training centre to be opened at Kadakal GP.
- iv) Road construction from Begunadihi Munda Sahi to Kadakala mining site.
- v) Pension for helpless old persons.
- vi) Drinking water need to be provided and all other basic necessities to be provided to the villages which falls at the Northern side of the mines like Kadakala, Pechagala, Narsinghpur, Sansardih etc.
- vii) Direct employment to be provided to the local youths according to their qualifications.
- viii) Mining activities like raising, loading, transportation, labelling etc to be done through local committee.
- ix) A School bus to be provided for the school going children up to Suakathi High School.
- x) Drinking Water and lighting to be provided to all the villages under Kadakala GP.
- xi) One ambulance for emergency medical services and a hospital need to be provided.
- xii) Priorities to be given to the vehicles of Kadakala GP for Transportation of Iron ore.
- xiii) Teachers need to be provided to schools of Kadakala village.
- xiv) One mobile network tower to be arranged for better communication between the villages.
- xv) Support to be provided to maintain their cultural activities and development of the villages.

7. Sri Nigam Kumar Thakur, Kadakala

Sri Thakur supported the public hearing and hoped that opening of the mine will provide employment scope for the local educated youths.

8. Sri Kusha Pradhan, Lohakado

Sri Pradhan supported the public hearing. He requested to start the mine as soon as possible.

9. Sri Budhram Munda, Lohakado

Sri Munda supported the public hearing.

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10. Sri Bidyadhar Naik, Narsinghpur

Sri Maharana supported the public hearing and expressed his sorrow that due to absence of jobs at local level their people are compelled to migrate outside the states and they are harassed facing much difficulties financially. He is hopeful that once the mine starts by M/s. Rungta Mines Ltd the local youths will get employment at their doorstep and their problem will be solved. He also requested for providing support for their cultural and religious Puja.

19. Sri Magu Giri, Kadakala

Sri Giri supported the public hearing and requested for providing facilities like road, electricity and support for their cultural programme (Puja) by the Rungata Mines.

20. Sri Khendu Giri, Kadakala

Sri Giri supported the public hearing & demanded works should be done through a committee.

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21. Sri Bashu Giri, Kadakala

Sri Bashu supported the public hearing and requested to start the mine as soon as possible.

22. Smt. Nepur Dehury, Kadakala

Smt. Dehury supported the public hearing and requested the mine not to interfere/restrict the villagers during collecting firewood and other forest product in the nearby forest.

23. Ms Bharati Dehury, Narsinghpur Ward Member

Ms Dehury supported the public hearing and expressed her satisfaction that the mine is going to start and as a result the migration of the local youth to other state for employment and maintaining their livelihood can be stopped. They will also be able to get their livelihood at their village and maintain their family.

He informed that Kadakala areas have plenty of hidden treasure need to be explored as a continuous effort. He requested the company to follow strictly the various developmental work agenda furnished by the Kadakala GP. He stated that this village is situated at the extreme end of the Keonjhar District. Road condition of this area is very bad. He hoped that under the banner of M/s. Rungta Mines Ltd this village will become No.1 village by providing good road communication, school, drinking water, ambulance and School bus.
