

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF M/S TURKANIGUDA SAND BED FOR EXPLOITATION OF RIVER SAND PRODUCTION OF 25,100 CUM / ANNUM OVER ML AREA OF 5.058 HA IN VILLAGE TURKANIGUDA, GUNUPUR TAHASIL IN THE DISTRICT OF RAYAGADA HELD ON 14.09.2022 AT 11.00 A.M. IN THE TOWN HALL, GUNUPUR UNDER GUNUPUR MUNICIPALITY IN RAYAGADA DISTRICT

The public hearing in respect of the above sand mining project was held on 14.09.2022 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in Turkaniguda village under Gunupur Block area of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Rayagada welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.



Shri Somanath Pradhan, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate, Rayagada highlighted on importance of such hearing & presided over the public hearing.

Sri Deba Prasad Choudhury, project consultant of Turkaniguda Sand Bed has explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the Project.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rayagada.

1. Sri Srinivas Sathpathy, Pradhaniguda

Sri Sathpathy welcomed the public gathered in the hearing and introduced himself as a Bidder. He placed his grievance before the Chairman of the public hearing meeting and told that they altogether comprising seven persons have participated in the sand mining sairat source auction proposal and he himself was the second party and Sri Sibasis Sahoo was the first party. He said to the public that 1st party Sri Sibasis Sahoo was given 15 days notice period to deposit the bidding amount for auction fixed up by Tahasildar and in the mean time the 1st Party was unable to pay the same within the stipulated time period. He questioned on how the Tahasil Authority has given priority to the 1st Party without giving opportunity to him (as 2nd Party) for selection of successful bidder. He expressed his sadness before the public and seeking clarification that in spite of a case filed in the Court of the Sub-Divisional Magistrate -cum-Sub Collector, Gunupur how this public hearing is being conducted in their area on which ground. He also opined that as a 2nd Party he will also able to pay the same rate for the sairat source fixed up by the Govt while giving opportunity to the 1st party by the Tahasil Authority. He concluded his remarks with thanks to the public and submitted his written representation to the Chairman of the public hearing meeting.



2. Sri Sudhakar Sathpathy, Turkaniguda

Sri Sathpathy introduced himself as a villager of Turkaniguda and he told that he has his own land adjacent to the sand mining sairat source. He said that due to sand extraction from the said source, river water came to his land. While giving his view to the public, he also seeks clarification of RI report regarding flow of river water to outside land. He expressed his sadness and told that they were not properly aware about this public hearing and opined that they should be informed at least three days before conducting of this public hearing. He also said that venue of public hearing should be selected in their Grampanchayat area for aware of their local villagers instead of selecting town area for the venue.

3. Sri Rabindranath Sathpathy, Turkaniguda


Before deliberating his views orally, Sri Sathpathy submitted a written representation to the Chairman of the Public Hearing meeting. He welcomed the dias and the public and told that how the Tahasildar, Gunupur has decided to select sairat source Bidder for the Turkaniguda Sand Bed without being enquiring the site & associated problems. He opined that how the villagers of Turkaniguda faced a lot of problems in the Bathing Ghat located at the river sand bed area as further extraction of sand will lead to more depth of bathing Ghat. He demanded for proper enquiry in the auction matter and also requested the authority for development of common road of Pradhaniguda and Turkaniguda.

4. Sri Chittaranjan Rath, Pradhaniguda

Sri Rath welcomed the public and the dias and introduced himself as a villager of Pradhaniguda. He questioned on the awareness of the public hearing for the Turkaniguda sand bed only through publishing advertisement in the newspaper as most of the people of Rayagada including Gunupur are un-educated and are the part of Un-Divided Koraput. He expressed his sadness on mike announcement by the authority on public hearing for not covering the entire Panchayat area. As most of the villagers are not aware about the public hearing for the Turkaniguda sand bed, he requested the ADM, Rayagada to conduct public hearing again in their village Turkaniguda.

5. Sri Ashok Kumar Sathpathy, Pradhaniguda

Sri Sathpathy welcomed the public and the dias and introduced himself as a villager of Pradhaniguda. He expressed his sadness over the improper mike announcement of the public hearing and announcement only in limited town area of municipal coverage. He told that only few people of local villagers of Turkaniguda & Pradhaniguda have attended the public hearing, but most of the attendees are from Gunupur town area and municipality area. He requested the ADM to postponed the public hearing programme and re-conduct the public hearing in their Turkaniguda local panchayat office in presence of local villagers to offer their views on environmental impacts on sand mining. He concluded his remarks with thanks to the Chairman of the public hearing meeting and the public.



6. Sri Sudarshan Gouda, Turkaniguda

Sri Sudarshan introduced himself as Gouda by Profession as he has many cows and as a simple un-educated villager of Turkaniguda, he told that the Tahasildar Sir should properly inspect the Turkaniguda sand bed site before handover to any successful Bidder. Without taking any suggestion of the Panchayat, Tahsildar has no rights to auction the Turkaniguda sand bed sairat source. He concluded his remarks with thanks to the Chairman of the public hearing meeting and the public.

7. Sri Debendranath Mishra, Turkaniguda

Sri Mishra welcomed the dias and the public and introduced himself as a poor farmer of Turkaniguda village. He told that agriculture is his only livelihood to survive. He appealed for cancellation of the Turkaniguda sand bed public hearing programme arranged by the Tahasildar. He further told that, local people are now getting benefitted due to the existing sand bed at Turkaniguda. He concluded his remarks with thanks to the Chairman of the public hearing meeting and the public.

8. Sri Bhairab Prasad Dash, Turkaniguda


Sri Dash welcomed the dias and the public and introduced himself as a villager of Turkaniguda. He questioned on no action of Tahasildar regarding illegal sand extraction & transportation from Turkaniguda sand bed. He told that their agricultural land will be affected due to sand transportation and there will be water scarcity problem due to sand bed mining. He concluded his remarks with thanks to the Chairman of the public hearing meeting and the public.

9. Sri Biswanath Sathpathy, Turkaniguda

Sri Sathpathy welcomed the dias and the public and introduced himself as a villager of Turkaniguda. He told that they are facing a lot of problems due to such sand mining from the Turkaniguda sand bed. He said that river water level will be affected due to operationalization of the sand bed and there will be adverse impact to their village which is located nearby. He requested the Tahasildar not to handover the sand bed lease to anybody without consultation of Gram Panchayat. He concluded his remarks with thanks to the Chairman of the public hearing meeting and the public.

10. Sri K Someswar Rao, Gadiakhal

Sri Rao welcomed the dias and the public and introduced himself as a resident of Gadiakhal. He expressed his sadness and told that they were not properly aware about this public hearing and opined that they should be informed at least three days before conducting of this public hearing. He also expressed his sadness over the improper mike announcement of the public hearing and announcement only in limited town area of municipal coverage. He told that only few people of local villagers of Turkaniguda & Pradhaniguda have attended the public hearing, but most of the attendees are from Gunupur town area and municipality area. He also said that venue of public hearing should be selected in their Grampanchayat area for aware of their local villagers instead of selecting town area for the venue. He also added that, their Grazing fields near to the



sand bed lease will be adversely affected due to sand transportation. He appealed for cancellation of the Turkaniguda sand bed public hearing programme arranged by the Tahasildar.

11. Sri Gobinda Pantia, Turkaniguda

Sri Pantia welcomed the dias and the public and introduced himself as a villager of Turkaniguda. He requested the public to listen his few words with silence. He told that, since last 60yrs, the Banshadhara River hits their village so many time and villagers facing a lot of problems. He also said that the nearby agricultural fields are also adversely affected due to river water flow to outside. He requested the Tahasildar to stop the tender of Turkaniguda sand bed. He concluded his remarks with thanks to the Chairman of the public hearing meeting and the public.

12. Sri V Vaikuntha Rao, Bikrampur

Sri Rao welcomed the dias and the public and introduced himself as a resident of Bikrampur. He appreciated the existing operationalised sand beds which have already tendered and auctioned by the Tahsildar. But, he criticised the activity of District Administration for tendering of new non-operationalised sand source at Turkaniguda and Bikrampur. He told that the local villagers are so simple and poor and due to such tendering of Sand Bed, they will be adversely affected a lot which cannot be tolerable. He appealed the Authority to avoid disputes between village to village and also requested to cancel the hearing of Turkaniguda sand bed. He concluded his remarks with thanks to the Chairman of the public hearing meeting and the public.

13. Sri Y Ganapati, Gunupur

Sri Ganapati welcomed the dias and the public and introduced himself as a resident of Gunupur. He first highlighted on definition of environment. He told that since last 3yrs there has been illegal extraction of sand from Turkaniguda sand bed due to non-allotment and non-auction of lease resulting in revenue loss of the revenue of the Govt. He said that local people should get river sand comparatively in cheap rate for their construction work and environment should not be get polluted. He also added that those people who have tractors they will have a option to get benefit from sand transportation. He also clarified that if sand mining will be done as per mining plan prepared by expert members, then there will be no risk of flood situation arise and environment will not get affected. He urged for following due procedure for grant of minor mineral lease. He concluded his remarks with thanks to the Chairman of the public hearing meeting and the public.

14. Sri Surya Prasad Satapathy, Pradhaniguda

Sri Satapathy welcomed the dias and the public and introduced himself as a resident of Pradhaniguda. By repeating & countering the words of Previous Speaker, Sri Satapathy told that previous speaker has only mentioned about the benefit of tractor owners, tractor drivers, helpers and labourers, but not highlighted on farmers those who are depend on agriculture only. He further told that, During the past, when flood has

damaged to their agriculture land, the local farmers got severely affected by losing their income source. He urged for cooperation of the Government to help the local farmers. He said that their written representation should be taken into account by the authority while granting environmental clearance for the Turkaniguda Sand Bed. He concluded his remarks with thanks to the public.

15. Sri Kirti Kumar Panda, Gunupur


Sri Panda welcomed the dias and the public and introduced himself as a resident of Gunupur. He said that if the sand bed will be operationalised then local people will get river sand comparatively in cheap rate for their construction work. He also added that those people who have tractors they will have a option to get benefit from sand transportation. He urged and demanded the Govt for supply of sand free of cost to poor people to construct their house under Prime Minister Gramina Abasa Yozana. He concluded his remarks with thanks to the public.

The Regional Officer, SPCB, Rayagada read over the issues raised by the public in the hearing and Sri Sarat Chandra Nayak (OAS) Tahasildar, Gunupur as project proponent responded to the issues raised for Turkaniguda Sand Bed.



It is brought to the notice of all concerned that The Tahsildar, Gunupur has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for Turkanigunda Sand Bed over ML area of 5.058 ha. in village Turkanigunda under Gunupur Tehsil of Rayagada District to obtain Environmental Clearance from the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha. The proponent has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for a Public Hearing.

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India Notification No. S.O. 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006, the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site/sites of displacement/sites likely to be affected.

For the above purpose, a person will only mean:

- A. Any person who is likely to be affected by the grant of Environmental Clearance.
- B. Any person who owns his control over the project with respect to which an application has been submitted for environmental clearance.
- C. Any association of persons whether incorporated or likely to be affected by the project and/or functioning in the field of environment.
- D. Any local authority within any part of whose local limits is within the neighborhood, wherein the project is proposed to be located.

Persons as above who desire to submit their views, comments, objections etc. relevant to the project, may do so in writing within 30 days from the date of publication of this notice addressing the same to the Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha through Registered Post.
