

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING CONDUCTED ON 20.09.2022 AT 03.00 PM AT TAIN SAR VILLAGE UNDER ATHAMALLIK TAHASIL OF ANGUL DISTRICT IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR TAIN SAR SAND QUARRY HAVING KHATA NO. 72, PLOT NO. 741, 747 KISSAM NADI OVER ML AREA OF 19.595 HA. AT- VILLAGE TAIN SAR UNDER ATHAMALLIK TEHSIL OF ANGUL DISTRICT.

Public hearing in respect of Environmental Assessment for Tainsar sand quarry having Khata No. 72, Plot No. 741, 747, Kissam Nadi over ML area of 19.595 Ha. At Village Tainsar under Athamallik Tahasil of Angul District.

Sri Tarani Suna, Sub-Collector, Athamallik, Angul District, supervised and presided over the meeting, assisted by Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul and the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, SPC Board, Angul welcome the other panel member and the public, gave an introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notifications 2006 in respect of Environmental Assessment for Tainsar sand quarry having Khata No. 72, Plot No. 741, 747, Kissam Nadi over ML area of 19.595 Ha. At Village Tainsar under Athamallik Tahasil of Angul District.

Sri Suman Kumar Sahu, representative on behalf of P & M Solution Consultancy addressed the committee members and assembled public and gave a brief description about the proposed project. He also briefed about Tainsar sand quarry having Khata



No. 72, Plot No. 741, 747, Kissam Nadi over ML area of 19.595 Ha. At Village Tainsar under Athamallik Tahasil of Angul District with the peripheral development work that had been taken up in this area, and made a presentation about the environmental management, pollution control measures, solid waste-management of the related project. The copy of the statement of the industry read out at public hearing proceedings is enclosed.

Regarding public hearing for Tainsar Sand Quarry having Khata No. 72, Plot No. 741, 747, Kissam Nadi over ML area of 19.595 Ha. At Village Tainsar under Athamallik Tahasil of Angul District was publicized at one English Daily newspaper and one Odia daily newspaper before one month. It was also publicized at the office notice Board of Kudagaon Gram Panchayat office, Tahasil Office Athamallik, Jilla Parisad Office Angul & Athamallik Zone office, and local villages of Tainsar, Odrapada and Kudagaon village. Public hearing also publicized through loud speaker at the Tainsar village area.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board Odisha then invited the public to present their views about the proposed project on environmental consideration.

The views expressed by various speakers are as follows:

01	Sri Hrushikesh Bagarti, Tainsar village
	He expressed that government should approve the tender for sand quarry considering the wellbeing of the village. All vehicles will be transporting on their private land. According to him transportation of vehicles would create problems to their private land, 100 to 200 buckets spill off sand and soil would fill their land adjacent to the road. He expressed 50-60 acres of land would be damaged. Also he requested to the government to consider another existing 40ft. road for transportation of vehicles.
02	Sri Chandramani Behera, Tainsar village
	He said complain has already been done to the Tahasildar regarding the damage of road by transportation of sand loaded vehicles. The road condition would be degraded due to spilling of sand from vehicles. He expressed that

	there is no proper road for transportation to the sand quarry. So, he recommended that measurement and construction of road should be done in the village. He explained about the problems faced by the Tainsar villagers as roads and crop lands were damaged due to floods. According to him illegal sand mining has been practiced since many years. So, he agreed for proper and legal operation of the sand quarry only if proper roads would be properly constructed. He also expressed that the same road is used for the transportation of sand loaded vehicles which is also used by general public for transporting daily needs and schools and vending zones are also situated in the same road. So, he requested for construction of a separate road for transportation of sand.
03	Sri Santosh Behera, Tainsar village
	He expressed that farmers will face problems due to operation of sand quarry. According to him since 20 years river has been drifting towards the village. Government is not taking any steps about this. So, he, on behalf of villagers opposed the operation of sand quarry. Also he expressed that around 2-3 villages around Tainsar village will be facing at the same problem due to sand mining.
04	Sri Satrugan Mahakud, Tainsar village
	He expressed his disagreement for the operation of sand quarry in and around their village.
05	Sri Panu Behera, Tainsar village
	He supported the previous speakers and expressed his disagreement for the operation of sand quarry.

At the end villagers submitted their written representation before the panel members are enclosed separately.

Observation:

Repair and maintenance of village roads, separate road for sand transportation, adequate air and water pollution control, speed restriction during school timings, were the most important issues emerged during the discussion.





NOTICE

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that The Tahsildar, Athmallik has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for Tainsar Sand Quarry over an area of 19.695 ha in village Tainsar, under Athmallik Tehsil of Angul district to obtain Environmental Clearance from State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha. The proponent has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for a Public Hearing.

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India Notification No. S.O. 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006, the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site/sites of displacement/sites likely to be affected. For the above purpose, a person will only mean:

- A. Any person who is likely to be affected by the grant of Environmental Clearance.
- B. Any person who owns his control over the project with respect to which an application has been submitted for environmental clearance.
- C. Any association of persons whether incorporated or likely to be affected by the project and / or functioning in the field of environment.
- D. Any local authority within any part of whose local limits is within the neighborhood, wherein the project is proposed to be located.

Persons as above who desire to submit their views, comments, objections etc. relevant to the project may do so in writing within 30 days from the date of publication of this notice addressing the same to the Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha through Registered Post. Besides this, persons interested to submit their views relevant to the proposed mining project in writing or orally may also do so during the public hearing to be conducted on 20.09.2022 at 03.00 P.M. at village Tainsar under Athmallik Tehsil of Angul District.
