PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING CONDUCTED ON 20.09.2022 AT 11.00AM AT KHADARAPADA VILLAGE UNDER ATHAMALLIK TAHASIL OF ANGUL DISTRICT IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR KHADARAPADA RIVER SAND BED OVER ML AREA OF 12.140 HA. IN VILLAGE KHADARAPADA UNDER ATHAMALLIK TAHASIL OF ANGUL DISTRICT.

Public hearing in respect of Environmental Assessment for Khadarapada River Sand Bed over ML area of 12.140 Ha. in Village Khadarapada under Athamallik Tahasil of Angul District.

The panel consisted of following members:

Sri Tarani Suna, Sub-Collector, Athamallik, Angul District, supervised and presided over the meeting, assisted by Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul and the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, SPC Board, Angul welcome the other panel member and the public, gave an introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notifications 2006 in respect of Environmental Assessment for Khadarapada River Sand Bed over ML area of 12.140 Ha. in Village Khadarapada under Athamallik Tahasil of Angul District.

Sri Suman Kumar Sahoo, Consultant, P & M Solution and on behalf of Lessee of Khadrapada River Sand Bed of Angul District on behalf of the proponent addressed the committee members and assembled public and gave a brief description about the proposed project. He also briefed about Khadarapada River Sand Bed having Khata No. 33, Plot No. 410, Kissam Nadi over ML area of 12.140 Ha. At Village Khadarapada

under Athamallik Tahasil of Angul District with the peripheral development work that had been taken up in this area, and made a presentation about the environmental management, pollution control measures, solid waste-management of the related project. The copy of the statement of the industry read out at public hearing proceedings is enclosed.

Regarding public hearing for Khadarapada River Sand Bed over ML area of 12.140 Ha. in Village Khadarapada under Athamallik Tahasil of Angul District was publicized at one English Daily newspaper and one Odia daily newspaper before one month. It was also publicized at the office notice Board of Khadarapada Gram Panchayat Office, Tahasil Office Athamallik, Jilla Parisad Office Angul, Block Chairman Office, Athamallik and local villages of Khadrapada, Nilakanthapada etc. Public hearing also publicized through loud speaker at the Khadrapada village area.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board Odisha then invited the public to present their views about the proposed project on environmental consideration.

The views expressed by various speakers are as follows:

## 01 | Sri Sidhartha Shankar Kheti, Sarpanch, Khadarapada village

He expressed the village road will be damaged due to spillage of sand. There is a water tank located near to the village road which will be polluted by the transportation of vehicles. He expressed schools, houses and temple located on either side of the road, will be facing problems due to the transportation of sand loaded vehicles. He said that there is another sand quarry in the name of Nilakanthapada Sand Quarry exists within close proximity but why District Administration has divided into two separate quarries i. e. Khadrapada Sand Quarry and Nilakanthapada Sand Quarry. The total area of the two-sand quarry is about 34.74 Ha but as per Government norms it should be in B 1 category with cluster approach. It leads to more environmental impact.

## 02 Sri Ghasiram Mahakud, Khadarapada village

He greeted everyone. He expressed that quarry is at a distance of 500m from the village, which would not create any pollution to the village. Also he

expressed there is not much traffic in that road. So, sand quarry can be operated. 03 Sri Sudhira Mahakud, Khadarapada village He expressed that cremation ground has been filled with sand, which creates problem for cremation. Also the operation of sand quarry causes road blockages for public transport. So, he strongly opposed the operation of sand quarry. 04 Sri Narayana Mahakud, Khadarapada village He expressed that the villagers will be benefited by the operation of sand quarry. And he disagreed to the previous speaker that, the said land is not a cremation field, cremation has been occurring there unauthorizedly. So, he agreed for the operation of sand quarry. Sri Biswabhusan Pradhan, Khadarapada village 05 He greeted everyone. He expressed that River, Forest i.e. Jagannath Bana Prakalpa and ultimately the environment is getting polluted due to operation of sand quarry. He expressed that the river gets flooded and the flood water reaches the nearby lands, and no steps has been taken by the government. 30 to 40 students upto 5<sup>th</sup>standard of nearby village regularly goby the same road. Transportation of heavy vehicles in the same road would create problems for the students. There has already been a similar situation in which a student nearly escaped a serious accident but lost one of his fingers of his foot. He expressed that by spilling of sand, croplands situated on both sides of the road may get damaged. The usual road used by the villagers is now mostly used by the transportation of heavy vehicles, which causes problems for the transportation of villagers. All the aforesaid situations may create environmental pollution. So, he opposed the operation of sand quarry.

At the end 7 persons submitted written representation against the proposed sand quarry are annexed separately.

#### Observation:

Generation of air pollution during movement of vehicles, flood issues, damage of river bank, bad road condition, separation of sand quarry, crops are not yield properly, due to

sound and dust pollution at cremation ground etc. were the most important issues emerged during the discussion.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, prepared the summary of the public hearing proceedings accurately reflecting the views and concerns expressed by the speakers with the inclusion of comments of the applicant read over to the audience at the end of the meeting explaining the contents in the ODIA Language and the agreed minutes of public hearing meeting was prepared. The statement of issues and concerns of public with the comments of applicant, prepared in Odia and English language is annexed herewith separately.

The President of Public Hearing meeting Sri Tarani Suna, Sub-Collector, Athamallik, Angul District, ratified the minutes of meeting and with the views and demands of public. He then delivered vote of thanks to the public for extending co-operation in smooth conducting of the public hearing proceedings.

### ISSUES RAISED BY PUBLIC

The issues raised at the public hearing meeting are mainly two fold. These are issues concerning to pollution due to proposed sand mining activity and its mitigation and issues relating to development of the area i. e, peripheral development.

The issues are

- 1. Air and Water Pollution
- 2. Roads damage due to movement of sand loaded vehicles.
- 3. River bank is not safe.
- 4. School children and villagers are not walk properly on road when movement of vehicles.

## **COMMENT OF APPLICANT**

Sri Apollo Kumar Garnayak, on behalf of Lessee, Athamallik and on behalf of Khadrapada proposed Sand Quarry was present at the public hearing gave her comments to certain demands raised by public as follows.


- Dust suppression, water pollution control management and Noise pollution control practices will be complied as per norms of the State Government and as per the provision of Environment Protection Act. And OMMC Rules.
- 2. To keep the village road in good condition, infrastructure facilities will be provided by the District Administration.
- 3. During sand mining Government guideline will be followed properly and sand will be provided to the villagers with reasonable price.
- He ensured that speed restriction will be maintained during plying of vehicles during school timings and within village road area.
