OF **PUBLIC PROCEEDINGS HEARING MEETING** IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESMENT FOR THE PROJECT OF M/S. PURNAPANI SAND QUARRY OF SRI RAJ KUMAR AGASTY OVER AN AREA OF 5.059 HA. IN VILLAGE PURNAPANI UNDER KUCHINDA TAHASIL HELD ON 01.11.2022 AT 11.00 A.M. AT PURNAPANI PROJECT UPPER PRIMARY SCHOOL (PUPS) PLAYGROUND, MOUZA-PURNAPANI, GP-KULEIGARH, R.I CIRCLE-KUTURACHUAN IN SAMBALPUR DISTRICT.

Sri Bibhuti Bhusan Nayak, IAS, Sub-Collector, Kuchinda presided over the public hearing meeting along with Er. Ramesh Kumar Ekka, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Sambalpur.

At the outset, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Sambalpur welcomed all the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing conducted as per the provisions of EIA Notification No. S.O. 1533(E) of Dt.14th September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change (MOEF & CC), Government of India. He also informed that the date, time and venue for conducting the public hearing meeting in respect of environmental impact assessment for M/s. Purnapani Sand Quarry of Sri Raj Kumar Agasty over an area of 5.059 ha. in village Purnapani under Kuchinda tahasil held on 01.11.2022 at 11.00 A.M. at Purnapani Project Upper Primary School (PUPS) playground, mouza-Purnapani, GP-Kuleigarh, R.I. circle-Kuturachuan in Sambalpur district was duly advertised in Odia daily "The Samaj" dtd.29.09.2022 and English daily "The Times of India" dtd.29.09.2022. (Paper clipping are enclosed as **Annexure-I**).

The Sub-Collector has also briefed about the proposed sand mining project and necessary of the conducting of the public hearing meeting and requested the public who were present during the public hearing meeting to express their opinions and views on the proposed project.

Regional officer, requested the representative of the proposed project to highlight about their proposed project before the public.

On behalf of the project proponent, Sri. Shaltiel Nag, Touzi Clerk, Kuchinda Tahasil addressed the public during the public hearing meeting. He briefly explained about the proposed sand mining project. He stated that; mining will be done by open cast manual method without adoption of drilling & blasting. Since, the depth of sand deposit is 1 meter, excavator, handpicks, hand shovel will be used by labour for extraction & loading of sand. The proposed mined out areas will gradually get filled up by river sand transportation with water from upstream direction. Quarry floor level at the end of the lease period will be 210 m RL. He also stated that, during study various factors have been considered such as ambient air quality, noise level,

water quality, soil quality and Ecology Biodiversity etc. He stated that the proposed mining activities loading and movement of other transport vehicles used in mining will generate dust. Proper water sprinkling shall be carried out at mine site. The sand will be transported by road through covered tarpaulin trucks/tippers to reduce the fugitive emission caused by the wind. He stated that based on the EIA study it is observed that there will be an increase in the dust pollution, which will be controlled by sprinkling of water and plantation. There will be an insignificant impact on ambient environment and ecology due to the mining activities, moreover, the mining operation led to direct and indirect employment generation in the area. Green belt development around the area will be also taken up an effective pollution mitigation technique, as well as to control the pollutants released from the premises of the Mine. Monitoring program will be followed till mining operation continue. Finally, he has summarized that the development of the mine will have a positive impact on the socioeconomic environment of the area and lead to sustainable development of the region.

The Regional officer invited the public to offer their views on environmental related issues of the proposed project.

About 30-40 participants have attended the public hearing meeting and out of them 24 participants have put their signature in the attendance sheet whose list is annexed as **Annexure-II**. 09 persons have registered their name to deliver their views during public hearing and list is annexed as **Annexure-III**.

Statements of the public participated in the deliberation during public hearing meeting is as follow;

1.	<u>Sri Bhabani Shankar Dharua:</u> He supported and expressed his no objection for the proposed sand mining project. He also raised the road condition issue and requested to maintain and repair by the project proponent.
2.	Sri Chinmaya Kumar Mishra: He supported the proposed sand mining project. He informed that due to operation of the project, sand will be available in the localities and every person will get it.
3.	Sri Pratap Sharma: He supported and expressed his no objection for the proposed sand mining project. He informed that due to operation of the sand mining project, sand will be available for the individuals and local people.

4. **Sri Dharmendra Patel:**

He supported the proposed sand mining project. He informed that due to operation of the project, sand will be available in the localities and every person will get it.

5. **Sri Durga Prasad Kalo:**

He supported and expressed his no objection for the proposed sand mining project. He also raised the road condition issue and requested to maintain and repair by the project proponent.

6. **Smt Nalini Kisan:**

She supported and expressed his no objection for the proposed sand mining project. she also pointed out the road condition issue and requested to maintain and repair by the project proponent.

7. Sri Kuni Kisan:

He supported and expressed his no objection for the proposed sand mining project. He also raised the road condition issue which will be damaged due to movement of vehicles used in the sand mining project. Further, he suggested to maintain and repair by the project proponent.

8. **Sri Dukhabandhu Sahoo:**

He informed that there is a mega water project of about 35 Crore, which may get affected due to the proposed sand mining project. Also, he said that, project proponent will only get benefit out of proposed sand mining project. Finally, he urged before the district administration to take suitable decision for the benefit of the local people.

9. **Sri Motilal Patel:**

He supported the proposed project and informed that Government will get tax benefit from this project. He concerned about the water crises due to this project as well as impact on the Mega Water project. Further, he put a question before the authority that the status of land of 9.0Ac. at Kuthimunda mouza.

Summary of the points raised by the participants in the public hearing are being read out by Dr. Satya Narayan Nanda, Dy. Environmental Scientist, Regional Office, SPC Board, Sambalpur and same in English and Odiya (vernacular language) is enclosed as **Annexure-IV (A & B).**

After the completion of the deliberation process Sri. Prasan Tete, OAS, Tahasildar, Kuchinda on behalf of the project proponent, gave a brief note on the issues related to the demand and grievances raised by the participants which are given in English and Odiya (vernacular language) in **Annexure-V**

(A& B). The video recording of the entire proceeding of the public hearing is enclosed as Compact Disc (CD).

After the above-mentioned deliberation, the Sub-Collector has announced the completion of public hearing meeting and Regional Officer has proposed the vote of thanks to the Chair as well as to the Participants present in meeting.
