

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING FOR BAITARANI SAND BED, BUDHIKUD OF SRI JOGENDRA BEHERA OVER AN AREA OF 5.058 Ha AT VILLAGE BUDHIKUD UNDER ANANDPUR TAHASIL OF KEONJHAR DISTRICT HELD ON 29.10.2022 AT 11.00 AM AT VILLAGE BUDHIKUD KHATA NO. 112 (AJA), PLOT NO. 183, KISAM- PATITA, TOTAL AREA 2.20, PROPOSED AREA- AC. 0.10 IN THE KEONJHAR DISTRICT.

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 29.10.2022 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in nearby villages of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate

Er P Kar, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Sri Jadumani Mahala, OAS (SAG), Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Keonjhar presided over and supervised the public hearing. He briefed about the importance and objectives of such hearing and invited the project proponent to highlight on proposed project.

Sri Rakesh Roshan Gantayat (Consultant), Representative of the Project Proponent explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the Project.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Keonjhar.

1. Sri Paramananda Mahanta, Tanaipal

Sri Naik supported the proposed sand bed mining. He requested to take care of regular repair & maintenance of the road of their village, which is likely to be damaged during movement of heavy vehicle for transportation of sand. At the same time, he also requested the lessee to extend his support to the villagers as and when required.

2. Sri Sahadeba Naik, Budhikuda

Sri Naik informed that among the persons assembled in the public hearing nobody was from their Panchayat or their village Budhikuda. He wanted to know how this meeting is being conducted.

3. Sri Birabara Patra, Goudadiha

Sri Patra stated that Vehicles for sand transportation will pass through their village. So, he requested the lessee to take care of repair & maintaining of the road & stressed on safety of the public using that road.

4. Sri Alok Kumar Patra, Goudadiha

Sri Patra while supporting the public hearing informed that the announcement for the public Hearing was done in their Panchayat consecutively for two days for proposed sand bed mining, hence everybody was aware about the public hearing. He told that they have every right to express their views, as the transport vehicle will pass through their village. He urged that lessee should extend support for development of education, cultural activities etc for their village.

5. Sri Harish Chandra Patra, Goudadiha

Sri Harish expressed that sand Transportation vehicles will pass through their village as other vehicles are. He informed that announcement was done through Public address system for the public hearing to the residents of their Panchayat and to the Sarpanch well in advance to attend the public hearing but they did not attend. He drew attention regarding shortage of sand, for which many poor people are deprived of a house or the houses are left incomplete. As a result, illegal sand business is rampant and sand is sold in high rate. Government is also suffering huge revenue loss due to illegal sand business. Once this sand mining starts then illegal sand business can be stopped and people can get sand at reasonable price. Secondly, he stated that owing to sand mining operation some people could be engaged to earn their livelihood. He felt that it would be beneficial for the common people if this mines starts as per the Government guidelines but they are unable to understand the benefits of this proposed mining. So he requested the administration to start this river bed mining as soon as possible as per Government guidelines so that the national property can be properly utilized.

6. Sri Baikuntha Nath Naik, Budhikud

Sri Naik while supporting the public hearing requested lessee to support the villagers in cultural activities, any function and maintenance of road and overall development of their area.

7. Sri Hiralal Mahanta, Tanaipal

Sri Mahanta informed that his village is the first village through which the transportation of sand will take place. So he requested for regular Repair & maintenance of the road specifically for convenience of the school and college-going students.


8. Sri Madhusudan Naik, Budhikud


Sri Madhusudan stated that people assembled here in the public hearing from Goudadiha, Tanaipal & Anandapur but no one from Budhikud present here. So he strongly opposed the proposed riverbed sand mining because due to movement of transport vehicles their roads will be damaged and the school going children will face difficulties. He questioned on conducting of this Hearing in absence of Budhikuda Villagers & warned that if his views are not taken into consideration they will take future course of action.

The Regional Officer, SPCB, Keonjhar read over the issues raised by the public in the hearing. Sri Rakesh Roshan Gantayat (Consultant), Representative of the Project Proponent responded to the issues raised. Sri Jadumani Mahala, OAS (SAG), Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Keonjhar gave concluding remarks of the Hearing.

The issues raised by the public and corresponding comments of the applicant were prepared in Odia and English and it is annexed with the proceedings as Annexure I & II respectively, list of the oral deliberators and participants in the hearing is annexed as Annexure III & IV respectively. The videography of proceedings are recorded and submitted as DVD (I).

Sl No.	Issues raised	Response of Project Proponent
Peripheral Issues:		
1.	Provisions of livelihood for local villagers in sand mining.	This project will enhance the opportunities of employment for the local villagers due to which their economic status will become better. Around 29 direct employments will be generated and several other indirect employments will be developed. The opening of the proposed project will increase the exchequer of the government leading to improvement in economic condition of the area including the transport structure, medical infrastructure, educational infrastructure and improvement of other civic amenities and will get a gradual boost in future.
2.	Repair & maintenance of village road during transportation of sand.	Haul road repair will be done at regular interval. Water sprinkling arrangement will be done at the transportation route of sand to control pollution. Plantation programme will also carried out in both side of the Haul road to minimize the pollution.
3.	Support to villagers for development of education & contributions for functions and cultural activities.	Along with the contribution in employment generation and economic growth of the country project will also be helpful in the development of basic needs of the local area like education, Health & family welfare, women empowerment, Natural resource management, infrastructure development etc. All CER and CSR activities including education & functions for cultural activities will be as per the demand of local villagers. For health awareness programmes and distribution of masks, gloves, sanitizers an amount of Rs. 30,000/- will be provided to the local villagers.

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that Sri Jagadindra Behera has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for Panarin Sand and Buddhikud over an area of 5.058 Ha in Buddhikud village under Anandapur Tahsil of Keonjhar District to obtain Environmental Clearance from the State Environmental Impact Assessment Authority (SEAAA), Odisha. The project has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for EIA clearance.

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change Government of India Notification No. S.O. 1533/15 Dtd. 22.06.2016, the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and at such invites suggestions, views, comments, objections or matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including local residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed sites or display content sites likely to be affected.

For the above purpose, a person will only qualify:

- A. Any person who is likely to be affected by the grant of Environmental Clearance.
- B. Any person who owns his control over the project with respect to which an application has been submitted for environmental clearance.
