**PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF UPPALADA STONE QUARRY-I, IV, VIII & IX UNDER CLUSTER APPROACH FOR PRODUCTION OF 15,354 CUM / ANNUM OF STONE OVER AN AREA OF 20.478 HA (TOTAL CLUSTER AREA OF 39.811 HA) AT UPPALADA VILLAGE UNDER PARALAKHEMUNDI TAHASIL IN THE DISTRICT OF GAJAPATI HELD ON 16.12.2022 AT 11.00 A.M. IN THE GRAM PANCHAYAT OFFICE, UPPALADA IN GAJAPATI DISTRICT**

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on **16.12.2022** as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in Uppalada village, Paralakhemundi Tehsil area of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Er Ripu Kumar Sahu, Deputy Environmental Engineer, State Pollution Control Board, Rayagada welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Shri Pradeep Kumar Nayak, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Gajapati highlighted on importance of such hearing & presided over the public hearing.

Sri Deba Prasad Choudhury, Project consultant of Uppalada Stone Quarry-I, IV, VIII & IX has explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the Project.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rayagada.

**1. Sri V Laxmi Narayan, Uppalada, Gajapati**

Sri Narayan introduced himself as a villager of Uppalada and told about the various consequences due to operationalization of stone quarries near to their village. He told that if stone quarries will be operationalized then they will face a lot of problem like vibrational impact in the surrounding nearby village area due to blasting in the quarries, windborne dust problem created in the agricultural fields as well as in the village area due to quarry activities and also effect on the nearby cashew plantations which is the livelihood for tribal. He expressed his fearness regarding life risk in their village due to blasting like bomb blasts in the stone quarries. He also highlighted on the problems facing on getting land patta. He seeks appropriate remedial measures on the above issues to be taken from the Authority.

**2. Sri M Sanmukh Rao, Uppalada, Gajapati**

Sri Rao introduced himself as a farmer of Uppalada village and told that they are completely depends on agriculture for their livelihood. He repeated the same issues of the previous speaker and told that if the stone quarries will be operated then they will face a lot of problem like vibrational impact in the surrounding nearby village area due to

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blasting in the quarries and windborne dust problem created in the agricultural fields as well as in the village area due to quarry activities. He expressed his fearness regarding life risk in their village due to consequential impacts of blasting in the stone quarries. He also highlighted on one example about recently happened on broken of window glass of one of their villager's house due to vibrations results from stone quarry blasting. He also told that there should be thick plantation and guard wall to be provided in the quarry area for safety of villagers and protection of environment. He expressed his displeasure on the Revenue Authorities for giving the stone quarry leases to the different parties without considering their views. He demands appropriate remedial measures on the above issues to be taken from the Authority. He also told that if the Authority will not listen their words officially, they will go for road bandh strike.

### **3. Sri Meslem Bhuyan, Uppalada, Sabar Nagar, Gajapati**

Sri Bhuyan introduced himself as a resident of Sabar Nagar of Uppalada village and repeated the same blasting issue in the stone quarries as said by the previous speakers and told that if the stone quarries will be operated then they will face a lot of problem like vibrational impact in the surrounding nearby village area due to blasting in the quarries. He expressed his fearness regarding life risk in their village due to blasting like bomb blasts in the stone quarries. He demands for appropriate remedial measures on the above issues to be taken from the Authority.

### **4. Sri Chandra Sekhar Pradhan, Baghsala, Gajapati**

Sri Pradhan introduced himself as a resident of Baghsala of Gajapati district and said that no guidelines are being followed up in the stone quarry mining. He also told that there exists a temple in their village located at a few distance from the stone quarry sites which has not been reflected in the draft EIA report as read by the project consultant in the public hearing. He also repeated the same blasting issue in the stone quarries as said by the previous speakers and told that if the stone quarries will be operated then they will face a lot of problem like vibrational impact in the surrounding nearby village area due to blasting in the quarries. He expressed his fearness regarding life risk in their village due to blasting in the stone quarries. He told that due to operationalization of stone quarries there will be adverse impact on their agriculture fields, both human lifes & on animal lifes (i.e. cattles, buffaloes etc during grazing in the nearby field) and also affect the fish farming by local villagers in the nearby ponds. He demands for appropriate remedial measures on the above issues to be taken from the Authority.

### **5. Sri Krushna Swain, Uppalada, Gajapati**

Sri Swain introduced himself as a resident of Uppalada of Gajapati district and said that No Authority being comé forward to resolve the issues of their village. He told that due to operationalization of stone quarries there will be adverse impact on their agriculture fields, village road as well as on building structures. He told that due to vibration created from blasting in the mines, there has been development of crack in the roof of the houses in their



village. He also said that stone dust of the quarry being deposited over the roofs of houses in their village, along the village road as well as in the agricultural fields for which they are suffering a lot. He demands for appropriate remedial measures on the above issues to be taken from the Authority.

#### 6. Sri Janatan Sabar, Uppalada, Sabarnagar, Gajapati


Sri Sabar introduced himself as a poor tribal of Uppalada of Gajapati district and told that they earned only as daily labourer basis for their livelihood. He further questioned about the survivability of their local tribal if the stone quarries near to their village will operationalize. He requests the Authority to think about them in the matter.

Er Ripu Kumar Sahu, Deputy Environmental Engineer, State Pollution Control Board, Rayagada read over the issues raised by the public in the hearing and Sri Venkata Ramana on behalf of Project Proponent responded to the issues raised for Uppalada Stone Quarry-I, IV, VIII & IX.

Shri Pradeep Kumar Nayak, OAS (S), ADM (Revenue), Gajapati has given concluding remarks on the hearing and elaborated the process to be followed for submission of the proceeding to the SEIAA, Bhubaneswar for further action. He extended thanks to the public participated in the hearing and for offering their views, suggestions and objections.



**STATEMENT OF ISSUES RAISED BY THE PUBLIC AND COMMENTS OF THE PROPONENT OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF UPPALADA STONE QUARRY-I, IV, VIII & IX UNDER CLUSTER APPROACH FOR PRODUCTION OF 15,354 CUM / ANNUM OF STONE OVER AN AREA OF 20.478 HA (TOTAL CLUSTER AREA OF 39.811 HA) AT UPPALADA VILLAGE UNDER PARALAKHEMUNDI TAHASIL IN THE DISTRICT OF GAJAPATI HELD ON 16.12.2022 AT 11.00 A.M. Sl. No.	Issues raised by the public in Hearing Meeting	Response of the Project Proponent
01	Regarding Vibrational impact due to drilling and blasting	Controlled blasting as per Govt Guideline will be practiced in the mine to control vibrations and flying fragments. To avoid the dust generation from the drilling operations, wet drilling method will be adopted.
02	Regarding Impacts on agriculture	Mitigative measures such as regular water sprinkling on active areas i.e. haul roads; dump sites shall be strictly followed so that impact will be minimized.
03	Regarding Noise Impact	All precaution will be taken to reduce generation of noise. Ear protectors or earplugs will be given to persons working in higher noise level area or on machines & steps will be taken to improve the maintenance of all equipment's so that the noise level will remain within permissible limits. Plantation of trees will also be carried out on internal roads and barriers to reduce impact of noise.
04	Regarding Impact of dust on the environment	Proper water sprinkling shall be carried out at the mine site as well as on transportation road for dust suppression. The mineral will be transported by road through covered trucks/tippers to reduce the fugitive emission caused by the wind. Speed of the vehicles will be maintained within the prescribed limits. Development of Green belt/plantation within mining lease along haul roads to arrest dust.
05	Provision of Guard wall in the ML area	Retaining wall with Garland drain will be provided in the ML area to prevent flow of sediments in runoff to outside during rain.
06	Protection of Environment	Stone mining will be done in such a way that it will not affect the environment.
07	Peripheral development of the village	Peripheral development of the village will be done as per Government Guideline in consultation with Local Sarapanch.
08	Road maintenance & development	Any rut & porthole in the road will be repaired on priority basis and road development will be done in consultation with the District Administration.
09	Regarding Plantation	Plantation will be done as per the scheme of mining plan.
10	Regarding Employment	Local villagers will be given preference for engagement in the mining project.
