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PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING FOR GRANT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE FOR THE PROPOSED DUMANGDIRI STONE QUARRY-IV OVER AN AREA OF 13.456 HA, BEARING KHATA NO. 72, PLOT NO 663 IN VILLAGE DUMANGDIRI UNDER PANPOSH TAHSIL OF SUNDERGARH DISTRICT HELD ON DTD.07.11.2022 AT 3PM AT DUMANGDIRI PLAYGROUND, DUMANGDIRI VILLAGE UNDER PANPOSH TAHASIL OF SUNDARGARH DISTRICT

The Public Hearing for grant of Environmental Clearance for the proposed proposed Dumangdiri Stone Quarry-IV over an area of 13.456 Ha, bearing Khata no. 72, plot no 663 in village Dumangdiri under Panposh Tahsil of Sundergarh district District was held on dtd.07.11.2022 at 3 pm at Dumangdiri Playground, Dumangdiri village under Panposh Tahasil of Sundargarh District.. Sri Abhimanyu Majhi ,Sub Collector, Panposh supervised and presided over the public hearing Process. Dr. Binod Bihari Dash, Senior Environmental Scientist and Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rourkela delivered welcome address, organized and conducted the public hearing meeting in association with District Administration.

The Public Hearing in respect of the above proposed Dumangdiri Stone Quarry-IV was held as per the schedule and the venue decided by the District Administration in accordance with the EIA Notification S.O.1533 (E) dated 14.09.2006 and subsequent amendment therein. The State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar had advertised in newspaper in Odia daily- Sambad on dtd. 29.09.2022 and in English daily- The Times of India on dtd.29.09.2022 regarding announcement of public hearing venue, date and timing. The Public Hearing meeting with regards to date, place and time was announced in public address system apart from its publication in local dailies. The Attendance sheet of the public attended the public hearing is annexed as Annexure – I. Around 95 persons had attended the public hearing meeting whereas 18 persons had delivered their views whose list is annexed as Annexure II.

At the outset, Dr. Binod Bihari Dash, Senior Environmental Scientist and Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rourkela welcomed the officials and the public presented in the meeting. He briefly described the objectives and procedure followed for conducting the Public Hearing as per the EIA Notification S.O.1533 (E) dated 14.09.2006 of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate CHange (MoEF & CC), Govt. of India. He also explained about the importance of such hearing for the proposed proposed Dumangdiri Stone Quarry-IV over an area of 13.456 Ha for grant of Environmental Clearance and also invited views, comments, objections & opinions of the public which are necessary while considering


the environmental clearance of the project and he also told that those who want to give their written statement about the proposed projects, they can do so during the public hearing process. He requested Sub Divisional Magistrate, Panposh to preside over the meeting.

Welcoming the public, the officials, Press Media, Police Officers and the assembled public in the meeting, Sri Abhimanyu Majhi, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Panposh, briefly explained the about the purpose of the public hearing about the proposed Dumangdiri Stone Quarry-IV over an area of 13.456 Ha, bearing Khata no. 72, Plot No 663 in village Dumangdiri under Panposh Tahsil of Sundergarh District. He also described the importance of Environmental Impact Studies carried out for the proposed Stone quarry and the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the Environmental Clearance of the project. He told that the project proponent will present the summary of Environmental impact studies for the proposed project for the knowledge of the Public. He invited the villagers to present their views, opinions & objections about the proposed project on environmental consideration. He also told that the public can also submit written representations. The proceeding along with video recording of the meeting will be forwarded to the SEIAA for further decision-making process for grant of Environmental Clearance. He requested the Regional Officer, SPCB, Odisha, Rourkela to carry out further proceeding of the meeting.

Regional Officer, SPCB, Odisha, Rourkela requested the representative of Project Proponent of proposed Dumangdiri Stone Quarry-IV to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the details of Environmental Impact Assessment report of the proposed project in a simple summarized manner for better understanding of the Public.

On behalf of the Project Proponent, Tahasildar, Panposh welcomed the officials, public and all other participants and gave a brief description about Dumangdiri Stone Quarry-IV. He expressed the details of proposed project which are given as follows:

- The Dumangdiri Stone Quarry-IV located at Villages-Dumangdiri Tehsil- Panposh. State Environment Impact Assessment Authority, (SEIAA) Odisha, has issued a Letter No. 4561/SEIAA dated 19.05.2022 for proposal for ToR of Dumangdiri Stone Quarry-IV over an area of 33.25 Acres or 13.456 Hectares bearing Khata No. 72, Plot No. 663 in village-Dumangdiri, Tahsil- Panposh, District- Sundargarh. The proposed stone quarry measuring 13.456 hectares will be leased for a period of 5 years from the date of execution of the lease. The new proposed quarry located in Dumangdiri Village of Panposh Tahasil, District- Sundargarh has proposed total production of 10070 cubic meter rock mass per year.




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


- As there is no forest land involved in the proposed lease area, so forest clearance is not required.
- Various programs for environmental management and development will be adopted if the proposed quarry becomes operational. Mining of rock mass will be worked out by Open cast method of mining. Handling of rock mass will be done both manually and by excavator. Loosening of rock mass will be done by drilling and blasting. Haulage and Transport for road metal & mineral and waste/overburden will be transported through tipper and tractor.
- Only small dia holes drilled only by jack hammer using light charges will be followed. No heavy blasting is required. The nearest habitation is beyond 1.0 Km away from the lease area. Vehicles are to be covered with tarpaulin during transportation from source to destination to avoid air pollution. The boundary marks and pillars are to be maintained to keep in good condition. No mining operations will be carried out within the safety zone area, which has been considered 7.5 m wide all along the lease boundary. Mining activities will be carried out with appropriate environment safeguard and shall take such steps for reclamation whenever necessary. The mining operation will be stopped when it touches the Ground water table and same will be informed to the appropriate authorities. If hill slopes are encountered, proper maintenance and safeguards must be ensured so as to prevent erosion or landslides.

Then the Regional Officer, SPCB, Rourkela there after invited the public to enter their names to put forth their views, suggestion, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the project. Then the public deliberated on various issues one by one which are given as follows

1. Sri Somra Ekka, Ward member- Ward No 3, Village- Dumangdiri
Sri Ekka demanded Anganwadi & School bus from the project authority. He stated that the complaint about threatening to kill by the authority was false.
2. Sri Sukra Oram, Village- Dumangdiri
Sri Oram demanded to complete the construction work of play ground. He stated that if company resumes its work youth from near by areas will get employment opportunity there.
3. Smt Basanti Ekka, Village- Dumangdiri
Smt Ekka stated that everyone will be benefited if project resumes. She supported the project.


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4. Smt Bhudni Ekka, Village- Dumangdiri

Smt. Ekka greeted & welcomed the officials, gathered public and all other participants to the meeting. She stated that the local people will work there if the quarry operates. She supported the project.

5. Smt Karmi Ekka, Village- Dumangdiri

Smt. Ekka stated that if the quarry begins to operate, they can do work there by leaving their children at home. Everyone can get income source and can educate their children properly. She supported the project.

6. Sri Gandura Oram, Ex- P.S. Member, Village- Dumangdiri

Sri Oram Stated that due to the mineral resources, they are getting bus facility, model schools, health centre. Still few hesitate for their consent to carry out the quarry activities. They should support the project.

7. Sri Uday Toppo, Village- Dumangdiri

Sri Toppo said that a few people are not willing to giving land for Govt projects. Although his land is falling within the quarry, he is not complaining about the project. Those who have no land within, they are complaining about the project. He supported the project.

8. Smt Laudhi Toppo, Village- Dumangdiri

Smt Toppo stated that her lands are lies below the quarry. The disposed water of quarry drains in to her land. Still, she is not complaining about the project. She supported the project.

9. Smt Dhanika Ekka, Village- Dumangdiri

Smt Ekka greeted & welcomed the officials, gathered public and all other participants to the meeting. She stated that those who oppose the project, themselves smuggle the forest produces. They have been protecting the forest since last 5years. She supported the project.

10. Sri Dugia Ekka , Village- Dumangdiri

Sri Ekka stated that when they are going to work far away, their children are facing problem. So he supported the project.

11. Sri Fagu Ekka, Village- Dumangdiri

Shri Ekka greeted & welcomed the officials, gathered public and all other participants to the meeting. Those who are complaining about the air pollution and crack in walls , they didn't complain about the same during the previous mining operations. This is a govt project, so people will get their wages in due time. He supported the project.

12. Sri Temba Ekka, Village- Dumangdiri

Sri Ekka demanded the project authority to follow the guideline properly and to address the public issues.

13. Sri Sunit Ekka, Village- Dumangdiri

Sri Ekka stated that people working far away cannot manage to resolve the domestic problems. If they can get employment near by then they can take care of their family. He promised to work in this govt project together.

14. Smt Champa Oram, Village- Dumangdiri

Smt Oram stated that they need development in their region. This can only happens if the quarry operates. Their youth will get job opportunity here and can educate their children. She supported the project.

15. Sri Ignace Baa, Village- Dumangdiri


Sri Baa greeted & welcomed officials, gathered public and all other participants to the meeting. He opposed the project.


16. Sri Suresh Baa, Village- Dumangdiri

Sri Baa has nothing to say.

17. Sri Dullu Oram, Village- Dumangdiri

Sri Oram greeted & welcomed the officials, gathered public and all other participants to the meeting. He demanded fast delivery of services. Instead of going outside, they wish to work here.


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18. Sri Kishor Oram, Village- Dumangdiri

Sri Oram stated that people are going outside for work. If they can get income source there, they can educate their children.

During the public hearing, all have been given an opportunity to express their views freely on the proposed project. The video recording of the entire proceedings of the public hearing was done and is annexed herewith. 18 nos. of persons had delivered their views. After the deliberations were made by the public, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rourkela summarized on the issues raised by the public and invited the project proponent to submit their response & commitments on the issues raised by the public. The summary of the views and opinions of the public and the commitments made by the project proponent are annexed in Odia language and English language as Annexure A & B respectively which were read before the audience in Odia language in public hearing meeting. Finally, the meeting was ended with vote of thanks, by Er. Ramani Ranjan Das, Deputy Environmental Engineer, SPCB, Odisha, Regional Office, Rourkela, to the chair, public and other participants.





Issues related to Ground Vibration & Noise	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Controlled blasting will be practiced for less noise and ground vibration as well as minimum fly rocks. • Noise level survey will be done at regular intervals. • Ear protectors or earplugs will be given to persons working in higher noise level area or on machines. • Steps will be taken to improve the maintenance of all equipment so that the noise level will remain within permissible limits. • Plantation of trees on internal roads and barriers.
4.	Issues related to Land use pattern.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Since, the dump will be active during the plan period, so no reclamation has been suggested. During the plan period the area will be rehabilitated by afforestation of native species viz. Neem, Pipal, Mahua, Mango, Karanja, Gulmohar etc.

1	Employment	Quarry will be providing employment to local population employing only local people whenever there is requirement for man power.

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
