Sri Udaya Kumar Mohapatra, Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Dhenkanal District, supervised and presided over the meeting, assisted by Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul and the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, SPC Board, Angul welcome the other panel member and the public, gave an introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of ElA Notifications 2006 in respect of Environmental Assessment of Brahmani River sand quarry, Kantapal over an area of 5.06 Ha in village Kantapal under Kamakhyanagar Tahasil of Dhenkanal District.

Sri Debaprasad Choudhury, Consultant of M/s Right Source Industrial Solutions and on behalf of Lessee of Brahmani River sand quarry, Kantapal under Kamakhyanagar Tahasil of Dhenkanal District and on behalf of the proponent addressed the committee members and assembled public and gave a brief description about the proposed project. He also briefed about Environmental Assessment of Brahmani River Sand

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Quarry, Kantapal over an area of 5.06 Ha in village Kantapal under Kamakhyanagar Tahasil of Dhenkanal District with the peripheral development work that had been taken up in this area, and made a presentation about the environmental management, pollution control measures, solid waste-management of the related project. The copy of the statement of the industry read out at public hearing proceedings is enclosed.

Regarding public hearing of Brahmani River Sand Quarry, Kantapal over an area of 5.06 Ha in village Kantapal under Kamakhyanagar Tahasil of Dhenkanal District was publicized at one English Daily newspaper and one Odia daily newspaper before one month. It was also publicized at the office notice Board of Kamakhyanagar Gram Panchayat Office, Tahasil Office Kamakhyanagar, Zilla Parisad Member, Kamakhyanagar, Block Chairman Office, Kamakhyanagar and local villages of Kantapal. Public hearing also publicized through loud speaker at the Kantapal village area.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board Odisha then invited the public to present their views about the proposed project on environmental consideration.

The views expressed by various speakers are as follows:

01	Sri Bhramarbar Sasamal, Kantapal village		
	He welcomed the public hearing and expressed that the villagers are mostly poor and depends on cultivation. Due to shortage of sand in that area villagers are purchasing sand @Rs. 4000/- per cft. He expressed that sand is highly necessary. He expressed his views in support of the proposed sand mining		
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	project.		
02	Sri Bijay Kumar Dehury, Sabhapati, Kantapal village		
	He welcomed the gathering of the public hearing and also welcomed the		
	proposed sand mining project. He expressed that villager only informed		
	yesterday about the public hearing. He said that 90% of villager's poor category		

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and depends on cultivation. Sand mining project is highly necessary. He expressed that the proposed sand mining project will lead to development in the area and also for locals. He urged to the District Administration that with the proposed sand mining project the lessee shall provide sand to the villagers either minimum reasonable price or free of cost. He urged to the panel members that before starting sand mining activity the district shall demarcate the approach road from Kantapal village to sand mining area of Brahmani River and it shall be properly developed with both side plantation. As per his knowledge earlier sand loaded trucks were plying through private plots. He also requested to maintain the approach road by the concerned lessee so that sand loaded trucks could able to ply smoothly.

03 | Sri Fanibhusan Mahakud, Kantapal village

He expressed that due to very high price of sand the villagers are not able to do their in-house civil works. Due to scarcity of sand local contractors are facing problems in respect to Government construction projects. He expressed that the proposed sand mining project will lead to development in the area and also for locals. He expressed that the lessee should start its mining activity as soon as possible. He mentioned that with the sand mining project operates, the local villagers should supply sand with a reasonable price. He requested to the lessee to contribute some funds to the village committee for different CSR activity. He also requested to maintain the approach road by the concerned lessee so that sand loaded trucks could able to ply smoothly and this process shall complete before tendering process. He urged to the District Administration that during sand mining activity the mine proponent should follow the guideline in all respect, local employment, covering of trucks and to ensure that sand mining is done in environmentally sustainable and socially responsible manner. He expressed his views in support of the proposed sand mining project.

04 | Sri Sanjay Kumar Behera, Kantapal village

He expressed that demarcation of road is highly necessary. They do not know which plot is government land and which land is private. He expressed that villager only informed yesterday about the public hearing. With the very small

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gathering the public hearing is happening. He told that during movement of sand loaded heavy vehicle through the village road may damage and pot holes will create. District administration may not solve or hear the problems or sometimes the concerned officer related to district administration may be present. With this type of problem, he requested that before going to any type of tendering process with the lessee the district administration shall demarcate the road properly from Brahmani river to Kantapal village and there must have provision for repair and maintenance of road by the lessee. He expressed that the lessee should start its mining activity. He urged to the District Administration that during sand mining activity the mine proponent should follow the guideline in all respect and to ensure that sand mining is done in environmentally sustainable and socially responsible manner. He expressed his views in support of the proposed sand mining project.

05 | Sri Narayan Mohapatra, Naib Sarpanch, Kantapal village

He welcomed the gathering of the public hearing and also welcomed the proposed sand mining project. He urged to the panel members that before starting sand mining activity the district shall demarcate the approach road from Kantapal village to sand mining area of Brahmani River and it shall be properly developed with both side plantation. He requested that lessee should always in touch with the village committee for providing any type of assistance or problems. He urged to the District Administration that during sand mining activity the mine proponent should follow the guideline, dust suppression, plantation in all respect and to ensure that sand mining is done in environmentally sustainable and socially responsible manner. If they will observe any type of violation, they will definitely complain to the concerned government authority.

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Observation:

Generation of local employment opportunity, demarcation, repair and maintenance of village road, supply of sand to the locals with reasonable price and adequate air and water pollution control, , tarpaulin coverage on trucks, river bank protection, not to disturb original flow patter of river water and aforestation etc. were the most important issues emerged during the discussion.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, prepared the summary of the public hearing proceedings accurately reflecting the views and concerns expressed by the speakers with the inclusion of comments of the applicant read over to the audience at the end of the meeting explaining the contents in the ODIA Language and the agreed minutes of public hearing meeting was prepared. The statement of issues and concerns of public with the comments of applicant, prepared in Odia and English language is annexed herewith separately.

The President of Public Hearing meeting Sri Udaya Kumar Mohapatra, Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Dhenkanal District, ratified the minutes of meeting and with the views and demands of public. He then delivered vote of thanks to the public for extending co-operation in smooth conducting of the public hearing proceedings.

ISSUES RAISED BY PUBLIC

The issues raised at the public hearing meeting are mainly two fold. These are issues concerning to pollution due to proposed sand mining activity and its mitigation and issues relating to development of the area i. e, peripheral development.

- 5. Strict adherence of sand mining guideline.
- 6. Supply of sand to the locals with reasonable price/free of cost.
- 7. Assistance of funds for CSR activity

COMMENT OF APPLICANT

Sri Saroj Kumar Samal, on behalf of Lessee of Kantapal Sand Quarry of Dhenkanal District was present at the public hearing gave his comments to certain demands raised by public as follows.

- Dust suppression and water pollution control management practices will be complied as per norms of the State Government and as per the provision of Environment Protection Act.
- 2. Plantation programme on both side of village road will be carried out in due course of time.
- 3. Regarding employment issue he expressed that the locals will be given priority in employment.
- 4. To keep the village road in good condition, demarcation along with infrastructure facilities will be provided by the District Administration.
- 5. During sand mining Government guideline will be followed properly.
- 6. He ensured to supply sand to the villagers with reasonable price.
- 7. He ensured that necessary assistance will be provided to the villagers after proper discussion with village committee and district administration.


