

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING CONDUCTED ON 22.11.2022 AT 11:00AM ATTUMUSINGA PLAYGROUND, VILLAGE – TUMUSINGA, TAHASIL - KAMAKHYANAGAR IN THE DISTRICT OF DHENKANAL, IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF PROJECT PROPOSED BY SHRI MANORANJAN PATRO, LESSEE FOR TUMUSINGASAND QUARRY OVER AN AREA OF 5.06HA AT/MOUZA – TUMUSINGA, TAHASIL- KAMAKHYANAGAR OF DHENKANAL DISTRICT

Public hearing of project proposed by Shri Manoranjan Patro, Lessee for Tumusinga Sand Quarry over Plot No.10154, Khata No.886 over an Area of 12.50 Acres or 5.06 Ha At/Mouza – Tumusinga, Tahasil – Kamakhyanagar of Dhenkanal District was conducted on dtd. 22nd November 2022 at 11:00 AM at the scheduled location at Tumusinga Playground of Tumusinga Village in the District of Dhenkanal as per EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14-09-2006.

The panel consisted of following members:

- i. Shri Udaya Kumar Mohapatra OAS(S), Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Dhenkanal- Representative of the District Magistrate & Collector, Dhenkanal District
- ii. Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, SPC Board, Angul- Representative of State pollution Control Board, Odisha.

Shri Udaya Kumar Mohapatra OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Dhenkanal District, supervised and presided over the meeting and was assisted by Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul and the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, SPC Board, Angul welcome the other panel member, representative of the proponent and the public, gave an introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notifications 2006 in respect of Environmental impact assessment of project proposed by Shri Manoranjan Patro, Lessee for Tumusinga Sand Quarry, over Plot No.10154, Khata No.886 over an Area of 5.06ha At/Mouza – Tumusinga, Tahasil – Kamakhyanagar of Dhenkanal District.

Shri Santosh Kumar Sahoo, Consultant, M/s. Parivesh Environmental Engineering Services on behalf of the proponent addressed the committee members and assembled public and gave a brief description about the proposed project. He also briefed about for Tumusinga Sand Quarry over an Area of 5.06ha At/Mouza – Tumusinga, Tahasil –

Kamakhyanager in the District of Dhenkanal. He also briefed about the peripheral development work that had been taken up in this area, and made a presentation about the environmental management, pollution control measures, solid waste-management of the related project. The copy of the statement of the industry read out at public hearing proceedings is enclosed.

As per EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14-09-2006, notice for public hearing of Tumusinga Sand Quarry over an Area of 5.06ha At/Mouza – Tumusinga, Tahasil – Kamakhyanager in the District of Dhenkanal was publicized at Tumusinga Gram Panchayat office notice Board, BDO Office at Kamakhyanager, Zilla Parisad Office (Zone-8), Srimula, Tahasil office notice board, Kamakhyanager, Sub Collector, Kamakhyanager Office and Tumusinga village. The notice for public hearing was also was published in Odia Daily and English daily and displayed in the portal of SPCB website www.ospcboard.org for public information and comments.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board Odisha then invited the public to present to present their views about the proposed project on environmental consideration.

The views expressed by various speakers are as follows:

1	Sri Salil Kumar Naik, President, Tumusinga village
	He welcomed the gathering and deliberated that there will be many problems due to sand quarry because there is no separate road to the quarry except road through village. However, a separate road by passing village is there which may be used for sand transportation after its repairment. He said whatever the consultant said about pollution control measures and other rules should actually be followed. Government should take care of local people and not only see the quarry as revenue generating source. If quarry operates it will cause many issues including pollution as village road is very narrow through which heavy vehicles couldn't move. We will not allow sand transportation through village road.
2	Shri Pramod Prasad Nanda, Tumusinga village
	He said whatever the village president said about problems is very true. Road through village is 1.5km long out of which 750m is well maintained but rest 750m is in bad condition which cannot be used for sand transportation even after concreting. He

	requested to submit signed copy of terms & conditions stated by the consultant w.r.t. mining methods, pollution control measures, CSR activities, etc. to the village president so that they can register their grievance if any conditions not fulfilled and protect their rights. If alternate route is used and sand transported after proper tarpaulin covering then they have no objection.
3	Shri Gopabandu Nayak, Tumusinga village
	He said that vehicles couldn't move through their village. He supported the previous speakers. Alternate road, by-passing village, shall be used for sand transportation after its development so that environment of village couldn't be damaged. Village road shall not be used for sand transportation at any cost. He asked to develop the existing village road from river bank to their village for welfare of the local villagers. This road is used for various purposes such as agriculture. He asked to increase CSR fund from 2% to 10% for development of the village, 2% is negligible for development work.
4	Shri Minaketan Nayak, Ex-Sarpanch, Tumusinga village
	He expressed that proposed quarry is not suitable for sand extraction as there is no approach road to the quarry. Existing road to quarry passes through village crematory therefore it couldn't be used. Heavy vehicles cannot pass through narrow village road as it is meant for only light vehicles and we will not allow such vehicles to pass through it. If alternate road is used for sand transportation after its development for use of heavy vehicle then we could think about allowing the project. CSR fund should be increase to 10% per year and it shall be deposited to village fund directly at the onset of financial year in the month of April. At the end he opposed the proposed project.
5	Shri Pradyumna Kumar Behera, Srimula village
	He welcomed the panel members & villagers and asked that how the local people will be benefitted from the project? On what rate one poor person will get the sand for its house construction or for contrition of Indira Awas house?
6	Shri Dikshit Priyaranjan, Srimula village
	He said they will be benefitted from the proposed project, they will get the sand at subsidized rate therefore he welcomed the proposal. In any problem arises there is

	rule for that. Water sprinkling can be done over road during sand transportation.
7	Shri Sujeet Kumar Nayak, Tumusinga village
	He opposed the project because due to it peace of their village will be disturbed. Without taking any name he informed about the fighting incidents in nearby stone quarry and threatening to them, therefore, he opposed the proposal.
8	Shri Prabin Kumar Nayak, Tumusinga village
	He opposed the project because place at which sand loaded vehicles will exit there is an Anganbadi School and an U.P. School.
9	Shri Dipu Chandra Mahakud, Tumusinga village
	He opposed the project saying that there is an Anganbadi School at the exit point and it will damage the village beauty.
10	Shri Bidyadhar Behera, Tumusinga village
	He said if alternate road is used for sand transportation after its development then they have no objection. But alternate road couldn't be developed because it involves private land. Without taking any name he also informed about the illegal stone quarry which has been developed over 20 acres of land instead of 2 acres for which permission was given by villagers, likewise no set of rules will be followed in propose project.
11	Shri Sisir Kumar Nayak, Tumusinga village
	Without explaining much, he opposed the project saying that there is a School.

Observation:


Development and use of alternate road other than village road for transportation of sand, development & repair of village road, movement of vehicles during school hour, enhancement of CSR fund from 2% to 10%, proper tarpaulin covering of sand loaded vehicles, water sprinkling on road, supply of sand at subsidized rate to the villagers, etc. were the most important issues/concerns emerged during the discussion.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, prepared the summary of the public hearing proceedings accurately reflecting the views and concerns expressed by the



Supply of sand at subsidized rate to the villagers 	<p>Shri Susanta Sahoo, on behalf of Lessee of Tumusinga Sand Quarry of Dhenkanal District was present at the public hearing gave his comments to certain demands raised by public as follows.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Alternate road other than village road will be used for transportation of sand after its development. 2. Existing village road will be developed in consultation with District Administration. 3. CSR activities and fund allocation issues will be taken up in consultation with District Administration and village committee. 4. All environmental management measures proposed in the EIA report will be implemented including covering of sand loaded vehicles with tarpaulin. 5. Sand will be given to the local villagers at low cost.
