PROCEEDING OF THE PUBLIC HEARING IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT FOR KUDUBADI DECORATIVE STONE MINES OF M/S. SGS MINES AND INDUSTRIES PVT. LTD. OVER THE MINING LEASE AREA OF 38.077 HA FOR PRODUCTION OF DECORATIVE STONE: 18,750 CUM/ANNUM AT KUDUBADI VILLAGE, DASAPALLA TAHASIL OF DISTRICT NAYAGARH, HELD ON 28.12.2022 AT 11.00 AM IN DASAPALLA BLOCK OFFICE PREMISES UNDER DASAPALLA TAHASIL OF NAYAGARH DISTRICT

At the outset, Er. Deepak Kumar Sahoo, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Berhampur welcomed all the persons assembled in the hearing. He briefed about the EIA Notification, 2006 and the objectives of the public hearing. He stated that M/s. SGS Mines and Industries Pvt. Ltd. has proposed to have Environmental Impact Assessment for Kudubadi Decorative Stone Mines over mining lease area of 38.077 ha. for production of Decorative Stone @ 18,750 cum/Annum in Kudubadi village, Dasapalla Tahasil of District Nayagarh and has applied to obtain Environmental Clearance and carried out Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Study.

Publicity regarding public hearing was made in the following manner –

- Advertisements through an Odia Daily "The Sambada" dated 26.11.2022 and an English Daily "The Times of India" dated 26.11.2022 regarding the venue, date and time of the public hearing along with the places of availability of Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) report and Executive Summaries (Odia & English) in the office of the Collector & Dist. Magistrate, Nayagarh, District Industries Centre(DIC), Nayagarh, Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad, Nayagarh, Head Office of the State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar, Regional Office of the State Pollution Control Board, Berhampur and Department of Forest, Environment & Climate Change, Govt. of Odisha and also in the website of State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar (www.ospcboard.org).
- Executive summaries along with paper clippings regarding date, time, and venue of public hearing were made available to the Chadeyapalli Gram Panchayat, Duda Gram Panchayat and the Block Development Office, Dasapalla, in the Dist. of Nayagarh.

The Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Berhampur requested the audience to give their opinions orally, written or in both, based on the Environmental aspects. Then he requested the Additional District Magistrate, Nayagarh to kindly preside and supervise in the public hearing.

The Additional District Magistrate, Nayagarh welcomed the people for attending the hearing with a message to the audience that they should give their comments based on the Environment related aspects. He briefed about the project and elaborated the objective of conducting public hearing in respect of any project seeking Environmental Clearance. Then he asked Project Proponent to brief about the project.

The Representative of M/s. SGS Mines and Industries Pvt. Ltd. presented the salient features of the proposed Kudubadi Decorative Stone Mines, the present status of the environmental conditions, possible impact on the environment due to such activities and the remedial measures to be undertaken by the lessee to reduce the impact while executing the project in Odia language.

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The Additional District Magistrate, Nayagarh invited the public to offer their views, objections, opinions, comments and suggestions regarding the proposed project. specifically relating to environmental issues. About 50 persons were present in the public hearing meeting, only 36 nos. of persons signed in the attendance sheet, out of which 10 persons participated in the oral deliberation and signed in the oral deliberator's sheet. No written representations were received in the hearing. The attendance sheets and the Deliberator sheets are enclosed as **Annexure-I** and **Annexure-II** respectively.

#### The statements recorded are as follows:

## 1) Sri Nakula Kumar Patra, Chadeyapalli, Nayagarh

He supports this mining project for local employment, development of local tribal & farmers and overall development of locality. He further added that mining will stop migration of labourers to outside. All inhabitants of Chadeyapalli G.P. support this mining project.

### 2) Sri Sureshana Nayak, Chadeyapalli, Nayagarh

He has stated that this mining activity will create employment opportunities for local youth and this will stop migration of labourers.

### 3) Sri Tarakanta Nayak, Chadeyapalli, Nayagarh

He feels mining activity will bring many opportunities for the local people of that area. He further demands for employment to youths in the mining activity so that the issue of migration of labourers can be addressed.

# 4) Sri Ganeshwar Nayak, Ex Sarpanch, Madhyakhanda GP, Nayagarh

He has highlighted/ demanded the followings:

- a) Dasapalla being a tribal dominating area supporting this mining project for local development.
- b) The present lessee shall take responsibility for protection of environment, maintenance of road and supply water.
- c) Conditions of roads at Chadeyapalli has been deteriorated. The District Administration and PWD shall undertake maintenance of these roads leading to Chadeyapalli and other roads of that panchayat.

# 5. Sri Himanshu Mahakud, Gochha, Nayagarh.

He has highlighted/ demanded the followings:

- a) Maintenance of roads and water supply
- b) Local employment to stop outside migration of labourers.

# 6. Sri Suratha Nayak, Pankua, Nayagarh

He has highlighted/ demanded the followings:

- a) Issue of landless farmers those cultivating on Government land.
- b) Record of Rights shall be issued to them under Forest Right Act.

# 7. Sri Jagamohan Mallik, Osamaska khesra, Nayagarh

He has highlighted/ demanded the followings:

a) He strongly opposed this mining project.

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- b) The precious flora, fauna residing in the locality will be affected due to mining. Endangered species like pangolins are habitants to that place.
- c) Illegal mining and mining about that locality will damage Bhatagada Tourist/Historical place.
- d) Government has failed to undertake development (Road infrastructure, Tower etc.) in that locality in last 75 years.
- e) Palli Sabha/ Grama Sabha were not conducted before public hearing therefore they were not aware of this public hearing.
- f) Six nos. of schools will be affected due to mining and transportation of heavy vehicles on the roads. There are possibilities of rocks sliding in that area due to mining.
- g) Government has failed to allocate ROR to local public to the tune of only four decimal land however leasing out huge amount of Government land to private mine owners. This is leading to destroy of Environment and Forest. Safety of local public is compromised.
- h) Local residents of surrounding 20 villages will suffer from breathing problems and respiratory diseases due to mining activity.
- i) Obstruction of communication roads due to mining.
- j) At the end he strongly opposed this project.

# 8) Dr. Prafulla Kumar Dash, Journalist, Dasapalla, Nayagarh

He has highlighted/ demanded the followings:

- a) The project proponent shall clearly describe the proposed mitigation measures to be adopted to control air, water and noise pollution.
- b) Who will take responsibility in case violation that should be clearly mentioned.
- c) Grama Sabha/ Palli Sabha not conducted prior to this.
- d) Sri Jagmohan Mallik is representing a section of the society therefore his views should be considered as representative view of that section.

# 9) Sri Ratnakara Hota, Journalist, Dasapalla, Nayagarh

He referred to Sarala Mahabharat and stated that Bhatagada should be a protected Monument. So he demanded to take steps accordingly keeping Odia and Hindu culture in mind.

# 10) Sri Manoj Kumar Jani, Badakurubari, Nayagarh

He has highlighted/demanded the followings:

- a) Traffic congestion due to slow movement of loaded vehicles from mines. Transportation shall be expedited for smooth traffic movement.
- b) Damage of agricultural land due transportation. Farmers shall be compensated. Development of road connecting from Rangamatia to Hanumanta.

Further the Additional District Magistrate, Nayagarh and Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Berhampur also discussed on issues raised by the public and requested to the Project Proponent of Kudubadi Decorative Stone Mines to address the issues raised by the local public. Sri Arup Kumar Samanta, Technical Manager of M/s. SGS Mines and Industries Pvt. Ltd. addressed the apprehensions raised by the public.

Er. Deepak Kumar Sahoo, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board Berhampur & representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha prepared the summary of the public hearing proceedings accurately reflecting the views and concerns, expressed by the oral deliberators. The minutes of the public hearing were prepared which has been ratified by Sri Bidhan Chandra Ray, OAS(S), Additional District Magistrate, Nayagarh with the views and concerns of the deliberators. The video recording of the entire public hearing is enclosed herewith for ready reference.

The statement of issues and concerns of public with the comments of the project proponent, prepared in Odia and English Language are annexed as **Annexure-III** and **Annexure-IV** separately.

The public hearing was ended with vote of thanks by the chair.


