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**PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF M/S KHEMABEDA DECORATIVE STONE MINE OVER AN AREA OF 4.755 HA IN VILLAGE KHEMABEDA UNDER BOIPARIGUDA TEHSIL OF KORAPUT DISTRICT HELD ON 08.02.2023 AT 11:00 A.M. KHEMABEDA VILLAGE {KHATA NO. 273 PLOT NO. 1424, KISSAM (PADDY-1.0.4650 HA) AND PLOT NO-1425, (PADDY-1.0.2300 HA) (TOTAL- HC.0.6590)} BOIPARIGUDA TEHSIL OF KORAPUT**

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 08.02.2023 as per the schedule time and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in villages coming under Majhiguda Gram Panchayat of Boipariguda Tehsil area of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. Due process was followed during public hearing.

Er D. K. Biswal, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Koraput welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.



Shri Rajendra Majhi, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate, Koraput presided over and supervised the public hearing. He briefed about the importance of such hearing and invited the project proponent to highlight on the proposed project.

Project Consultant Sri Jagabandhu Bisoi, Consultant, Kalyani Laboratory (P) Ltd on behalf of M/s Khemabeda Decorative stone Mine has explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Environment Management Plan and socio-economic development of proposed plan.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Koraput.

**1. Sri Prahalada Gouda, Bhaliapadar**

Sri Gouda expressed that the people of the area are illiterate. He mentioned that the total area including land and forests belong to the locals as they have been guarding the area since the time of their ancestors. They are fulfilling their livelihood by selling the crops which grow in the forest as they don't have their own land with Patta. He also expressed that their agricultural lands might get destroyed due to plying of vehicles to and from the mine. He put forth some demands and said that they will allow operation of the mine if the demands are fulfilled. He demanded boundary wall for their village goddess, house to keep their utensils, a mandap, school boundary, drinking water supply etc from the project proponent. Lastly he demanded to provide them land with Patta so that they will not be dependent upon the Govt land for agriculture.



**2. Sri Balaram Pujari, Khataraguda**

Sri Pujari mentioned that they are guarding the forest since their ancestors and he feared that they might get displaced from their land and they might lose their livelihood due to the project. He also feared that the cattle grazing land in the vicinity of the project might get destroyed. The forests provide them with various kinds of foods in form of fruits, vegetables, roots, branches, leaves etc. He mentioned that they don't have their own agricultural land and solely depend upon the Forest land for agriculture. So, they are scared to lose their livelihood due to the mining project. So he appealed the officials to allow them to live in their natural habitat peacefully and strongly opposed the project.

**3. Sri Podu Gouda, Bhaliapadar**

Sri Gouda welcomed the project and said that the young locals are going to outside for search of jobs and this project will surely give employment to locals and their life will be better in future.

**4. Sri Gaburu Pangi, Bejapadar**

Sri Pangi mentioned that Kanda which is a food item is grown over that soil and expressed that the children of the area going for education to Malkangiri District may get good education in the locality if the project proponent will provide better education facilities.

**5. Sri Laba Gouda, Bhaliapadar**

Sri Gouda mentioned that all the villagers of Bhaliapadar has decided that if the company agrees to fulfill all their demands, they have no objection for the project.

**6. Sri Madana Gouda, Bhaliapadar**



Sri Gouda has clearly stated that the company should fulfill their demands before starting the project. He also pointed out that drinking water should be supplied in the school.

**7. Sri Mana Gouda, Bhaliapadar**

Sri Mana Gouda was afraid that they might lose their land and livelihood due to the project and hence expressed dissatisfaction for the project.

**8. Sri Kesaba Gouda, Bhaliapadar**

Sri Gouda shed light on the local drinking water problems in the locality especially during summer season and requested to make necessary arrangement on urgent basis for providing drinking water to the villagers. He also said the roads in the area are very bad in condition and requested to give jobs to young locals as per the company requirements. He welcomed the project with a condition that their demand should be fulfilled. He also mentioned that they have prepared a written representation in consultation with the villagers reflecting their demands and submitted the representation during the hearing.



**9. Sri Madhusudhan Gouda, Bhaliapadar**

He welcomed the project and requested to provide necessary job opportunities to the young locals.

**10. Sri Selia Golari, Khemabeda**

Sri Golari showed his resentment for the project apprehending that the company might not fulfill all the promises and has demanded that the company should fulfill some works like repair of roads, put guard walls in the bridge, supply of drinking water to all the nearby villages and provide ambulance services to all the villages prior to starting of the project. He mentioned that if the company fails to provide these services, they will oppose the project.

**11. Sri Krupa Gouda, Bhaliapadar**

Sri Gouda mentioned that they have Cashew plantations in the mining area which might be affected due to the project.

**12. Smt Manju Srikallia, Sarpanch, Majhiguda**

She welcomed the project and put forth the following demands; the roads should be repaired, provision of a hospital, provision of drinking water supply, employment opportunity to locals.

**13. Sri Arun Kumar Barik, Majhiguda**



Mr Barik welcomed the project and requested the project proponent to fulfill all the promises committed by the company. He said that the villagers will provide necessary assistance to the project proponent because he thinks that Majhiguda Gram Panchayat will flourish due to the project and their economic conditions will improve if unemployed youth will get job opportunities in the project.

**14. Sri M. Ashok kumar, Limaput**

Sri Kumar welcomed the project and said that the villagers are not able to understand the benefits to locals due to mining. He said that the mining will simultaneously bring development and also bring problems to the locals. However he emphasized on development of the area and demanded for employment to locals, provision for an ambulance to carry patients to nearby hospital, provision for yearly health camp, repair of roads, provision of mobile tower to avail online education to the children and all the works that are promised by the project proponent.

**15. Sri Mohan Shrikalia, Khemabeda**

Sri Shrikalia being the President of Bana Surakshya Samiti, Khemabeda and Ex-sarpanch indicated that they have been preserving the forests since long and shared an anecdote about how they have been appreciated earlier by the State Govt for developing and conserving forest in the area. He felt surprised when he heard that the forests are now being leased out for mining operation. So he demanded to provide



Patta to the locals where they have been doing agriculture since ages. Otherwise they will be affected by the project as they might lose their land for agriculture. He also expressed his dissatisfaction for interference of various Govt officials in their day to day living. He also demanded for generation of employment for local people.

#### **16. Sri Hari Gouda, Bhaliapadar**


Sri Hari Gouda mentioned that they have been doing agriculture in the forest land and requested to provide them Patta so that they can do agriculture.



List of the oral deliberators and participants in the hearing is annexed as Annexure-III & IV respectively. About 4 nos. of written representations were received on the spot on the day of public hearing which are enclosed as Annexure-V (a to d). The videography of proceedings are recorded and submitted as DVD.
