At the outset, Er. Deepak Kumar Sahoo, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Berhampur welcomed all the persons assembled in the hearing. He briefed about the EIA Notification, 2006 and the objectives of the public hearing. He stated that Sri Krupasindhu Muduli, Project Proponent has proposed to have Environmental Impact Assessment for Kanaka Sand Quarry Mining project over mining lease area of 31.211 ha. for production of Ordinary Sand @ 1,00,400 cum/Annum in Kanaka village, Purushottampur Tahasil of District Ganjam and has applied to obtain Environmental Clearance and carried out Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Study.

Publicity regarding public hearing was made in the following manner -

- Advertisements through an Odia Daily "The Dharitri" dated 01.12.2022 and an English Daily "The Times of India" dated 01.12.2022 regarding the venue, date and time of the public hearing along with the places of availability of Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) report and Executive Summaries (Odia & English) in the office of the Collector & Dist. Magistrate, Ganjam, District Industries Centre(DIC). Ganjam, Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad, Ganjam, Head Office of the State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar, Regional Office of the State Pollution Control Board, Berhampur and Department of Forest, Environment & Climate Change Govt. of Odisha and also in the website of State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar (www.ospcboard.org).
- Executive summaries along with paper clippings regarding date, time, and venue of public hearing were made available to the Ranajhali Gram Panchayat, Bhimpur Gram Panchayat and the Block Development Office, Purushottampur, in the Dist. of Ganjam.

The Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Berhampur requested the audience to give their opinions orally, written or in both, based on the Environmental aspects. Then he requested the Sub-Collector-cum-Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Chatrapur to kindly preside and supervise in the public hearing.

The Sub-Collector-cum-Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Chatrapur welcomed the people for attending the hearing with a message to the audience that they should give their comments based on the Environment related aspects. He briefed about the project and elaborated the objective of conducting public hearing in respect of any project seeking Environmental Clearance. Then he asked Project Proponent to brief about the project.

Sri Deba Choudhury, representative of project proponent presented the salient features of the proposed Kanaka Sand Quarry, the present status of the environmental conditions, possible impact on the environment due to such activities and the remedial measures to be undertaken by the lessee to reduce the impact while executing the project in Odia language.

The Sub-Collector-cum-Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Chatrapur invited the public to offer their views, objections, opinions, comments and suggestions regarding the proposed project, specifically relating to environmental issues. About 90 persons were present in the public hearing meeting, only 83 nos. of persons signed in the attendance sheet, out of which 07 persons participated in the oral deliberation and signed in the oral deliberator's sheet. No written representations were received in the hearing. The attendance sheets and the Deliberator sheets are enclosed as **Annexure-I** and **Annexure-II** respectively.

The statements recorded are as follows:

1. Sri Ashok Kumar Mahakuda, Councillor Purushottampur NAC

He has highlighted/ demanded the followings:

- a) This is a welcome step taken by the Government.
- b) Sand will be easily available for construction purpose.
- c) Growth of shrubs shall be cleaned from sand bed for easy access to flowing water for bathing purpose.
- d) Both lessee and Government should take steps for clearing of shrubs from sand bed.

2. Sri Bhagaban Pradhan, Purushottampur

He has highlighted/demanded the followings:

- a) Scarcity of sand for construction of houses and other Government project at the locality due to non-operation of this source since last two years.
- b) The lessee shall take steps for protection of Environment.
- c) Legal sand mining will prohibit theft and also it will benefit local public.

3. Sri Jagannath Patra, Samiti Sabhya, Ranajhali, Purushottampur

He has highlighted/ demanded the followings:

- a) They have no objection for this mining if lessee will undertake protection measures as per EIA report.
- b) Mining will lead to development of panchayat.

4. Sri Mangaraj Behera, Purushottampur

He has highlighted/demanded the followings:

- a) First time public hearing is conducted for sand mining.
- b) Transporting trucks shall be covered with tarpaulin.
- c) Control speed of transporting vehicles.
- d) Water sprinkling at transportation roads.

5. Sri Seshadev Panda, Ranajhali, Purushottampur

He has highlighted/ demanded the followings:

- a) Scarcity of sand for construction of houses and other Government project at the locality due to non-operation of this source since last two years.
- b) Mining of sand at the locality will lead to availability of sand at cheaper price.
- c) They have no objection for this mining.
- d) Transporting trucks shall be properly covered with tarpaulin.

6. Sri Satyaban Behera, Purushottampur

He has highlighted/ demanded the followings:

- a) Speed of transporting vehicles shall be controlled during schooling hours.
- b) This shall be ensured by District Administration and lessee.

7. Sri Uttam Bihari Mahapatra, Purushottampur

He has highlighted/ demanded the followings:

- a) The lessee shall take steps to prohibit accidents due to sand transportation through village roads.
- b) Mining of sand shall be restricted in submerged or water flow area to avoid water pollution.
- c) Deposit of silts leading to growth of shrubs at river bed. The Administration and lessee shall take steps to clean river bed.
- d) The Administration and lessee shall take steps to supply sand at cheaper price to poor villagers for construction purpose.
- e) Transporting trucks shall be properly covered with tarpaulin to avoid spillage. Spillage of sand leads to accident in the locality. The lessee shall ensure that there will not be any accident in future.

Further the Sub-Collector-cum-Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Chatrapur and Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Berhampur also discussed on issues raised by the public and requested to the Project Proponent of Kanaka Sand Quarry to address the issues raised by the local public. Sri Biswajit Patro, Official representative of Kanaka Sand Quarry Mining Project addressed the apprehensions raised by the public.

Er. Deepak Kumar Sahoo, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Berhampur & representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha prepared the summary of the public hearing proceedings accurately reflecting the views and concerns, expressed by the oral deliberators. The minutes of the public hearing were prepared which has been ratified by Sub-Collector-cum-Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Chatrapur with the views and concerns of the deliberators. The video recording of the entire public hearing is enclosed herewith for ready reference.

The statement of issues and concerns of public with the comments of the project proponent, prepared in Odia and English Language are annexed as **Annexure-III** and **Annexure-IV** separately.

The public hearing was ended with vote of thanks by the chair.


