

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 28.02.2023 (11.00 AM) AT- JCDL CAMPUS NEAR JCD-NIMZ, PANKAPAL, KALINGANAGAR UNDER SUKINDA TAHSIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF 30 TPH CAPACITY CHROME ORE BENEFICIATION PLANT HAVING THROUGHPUT OF 1,98,000 TPA AND ANNUAL CHROME CONCENTRATION PRODUCTION OF 97,000 TPA BASED ON AVERAGE GRADE 30% Cr₂O₃ PROPOSED BY M/S MISRILALL MINES PVT. LTD. AT VILLAGE PANKAPAL UNDER SUKINDA TEHSIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT

The public hearing in respect of the project proposed by M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. for establishment of 30 TPH capacity chrome ore beneficiation plant having throughput of 1,98,000 TPA and annual chrome concentration production of 97,000 TPA based on average grade 30% Cr₂O₃ was held on scheduled date & time at JCDL campus near JCD-NIMZ, Pankapal, Kalinganagar under Sukinda Tahsil in the District of Jajpur with reference to:


- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006
- II. Interim Operational Guidelines till 13th September 2007 in respect of applications made under EIA-1994

The Panel consisted of the following members:

1. Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, Jajpur
2. Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Kalinganagar.

Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and assisted by Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by M/S Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd.



Welcoming the public, Sri S.K. Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Shyam Sundar Das, Sr. Manager(COB) addressed the committee members and assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Sri Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar, requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. **Ajay Bindhani, Vice Chairman, Pankapal**
He Greeted the panel member and gathering and said that they should be grateful to M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. for providing direct benefits to four to five villages, including Pankapal, Pingal, Chandia, Mantira, and Gobarghati, and they proud that they are getting the benefit of employment. Along with getting them engaged in different panchayat developmental aspects, the company has also offered jobs for local people. He proposed to support the plant's proposed expansion and expressed his support for its expansion.
2. **Manasi Dalai, Sarapanch, Pingal**
She welcomed to the local gathering and supported the proposed project.
3. **Satyabhama Chakra, Satgunma**
She greeted the panel member and welcomed to the local gathering. She expressed her gratitude to M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd for providing jobs to them for which all the families were getting benefitted. She shared her experience that with the company's assistance she can built a house in the village of Nimapalli that could accommodate 300 people, so that the SHG women got benefitted. She wished like this plant if one more plant will comes then they will be more benefitted. During the covid-19 time they have seen the difficulties faced by the persons who went outside for work; if another plant comes to their area, they will find more employment opportunity there.



4. **Rasmita Patra, Sarapanch, Mantira**
She greeted to the gathering and expressed her support to the plant.
5. **Pandusingh Khuntia, Sarapanch, Chandia**
He expressed his full support for the expansion project of M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. COB plant and the proposed public hearing.
6. **Budhiram Jarika, Samiti Sabhya, Chandia**
He expressed his support towards the project.
7. **Sadhucharan Tiku, Gobarghati**
He supported the expansion of M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd and requested that the company in near future the vacancy should be given to the local people on priority basis so that the local villagers will be benefited. He also requested everyone to support the expansion project of M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd.
8. **Bulu Yadav, Pankapal**
He greeted the panel, gathering, media & the company authorities. He told that some of the local issues haven't yet been resolved by the company authority and in this regard he addressed the issues with the local minister. He discussed the environmental issues that 670 elephants had died in the past six years as a result of not being able to obtain their primary food sources i.e. the Banyan and Aswatha trees. Then he claimed that during mining operation of M/s Misrilall mines pvt Ltd at Kaliapani, sukinda, 7000 crore rupees worth of chromite had been stolen at sukinda according to data obtained from the Indian Bureau of Mines. He stated his displeasure that the organization could not resolve the kidney problem, don't have it's water treatment facility, not involved in CSR work like promote education and job opportunities. The company has no responsibility to the environment, plants, or living creatures. He stated, this whole region is polluted, and Kalinganagar is ranked number 75 out of 100 most polluting cities in India. He told that none of these companies have built a water treatment facility. So he totally opposed this project.
9. **Pramod Barik, Pingal**
He greeted the panel member and gathering. He supported the expansion project of the plant as his relatives as well as the people nearby got job in the plant. He thanked M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt Ltd. for the support towards providing job with salary during the covid-19 and he requested to the ADM, that some poor people around 30 persons who gave their land to the plant but not yet getting job opportunity.



10. **Parsuram Bindhani, Pingal**

He greeted the panel member and gathering. He expressed his belief that, prior to M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd., many people in his tribal village of Baghabahali, where there was a lack of employment opportunities used to go for searching employment outside. However Toady, many of them are employed in company and living good lives. He therefore hoped that by adding one more plant, everyone would be benefitted.

11. **Krupasindhu Samantray, Pingal**

He greeted the panel, gathering & media. He questioned what benefits they had already been received from the 15 plants that were already in Kalinganagar. He claimed that they have given them property and forest, but they were not getting jobs. Every family in Monaharpur & Pingal village has a kidney patient. M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. using the groundwater, it has been questioned as to why the plant not using river water. In the past, they could able to find groundwater at a depth of 60 to 70 feet below ground level but now ground water is not available at 150 ft below ground level. He questioned the company's leadership about what actions they had taken during active plant operations to protect the environment. In addition, he supported to the former speaker Bulu Yadav, by saying that the monopoly rule was observed by the plant authority and told that if the company didn't listen to the central ministers, then chances of hearing to common people's problem is rare. He urged supporters to reconsider the number of employees have been hired and asked the ADM sir to stop the public hearing so that the company will address the issues.

12. **Pritam Barik, Pingal**


He expressed his full support towards the plant expansion because in his region people were getting some benefit out of it and this project expansion will bring more employment.

13. **Surendra Pradhan, Pankapal**

He greeted everyone. He expressed the benefit of M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. received as he is employed there. The people of Pingal and Pankapal are aware of the company's efforts and what the company has done earlier. He told they are not having any issues and they are supporting the plant now and in future they will also support.

14. **Biswaranjan Swain, Duburi**

He welcomed the panel and gathering. According to his knowledge, M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd is a mining company for 80 years. He described his observation that the factory workers lacked safety accessories including safety shoes and helmets, not finding drinking water facilities. With regard to the water management by the plant, referring to the TATA raw water



management system, if the company will not establish it's own water treatment plant, then the Pollution Control Board and District Administration will be accountable and second issue is the regional ground water depletion. According to his past activities, he opposed to the plant and concerned about the waste water treatment facility. He will support the expansion unit if the plant will treat and recycle the plant's waste water; otherwise, he will be against the expansion

15. **Dilip Ku. Samal, Pankapal**

He greeted the panel, gathering, company authorities & media persons. He mentioned the project proponent's presentation briefing and said the public's concern focuses on waste water treatment. He stated that waste water is not sent outside until it is permitted during the monsoon and told that it is recommended to reuse of the processed water. He urged that 33% of plant area should be covered under plantation. He fully supported the plant expansion. In the future, he requested for development of education, society, and the periphery and appreciated the M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd.'s engagement of rupees 22 lakhs in development of projects at Pankapal, Monaharpur and requested the plant's general manager to build the pendal at Binapani Bidya Pitha and create employment opportunity for the local villagers of pankapal panchayat.

16. **Bhaskar Satpathy, Nilamanideipur**

He welcomed the panel and gathering and expressed his supports to M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd for its expansion. He requested that attention will be given to pollution control measures and employment assurance. Stating the advantage of it, his children were not worry for the food at least. He felt changes on him in appearance and outfit on welcoming the plant and he felt proud for it.

17. **Sirka pruti, Bhagabahali**

He welcomed the gathering. He shared his own experience of going to school in a lungi before the plant and now sending his kids to school in a pant and shirt. He is happy for getting advantages they received after the plant comes

18. **Rabindra Ku. Jena, Nilamanideipur**

He welcomed the panel and expressed his support for the expansion of M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. He suggested everyone to support M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. since it is profitable for them and requested the plant authority to provide full employment opportunities in his locality and follow environmental regulations.



19. **Nirupama Behera, Samiti Sabhya, Pingal**

She gave her full support by explaining that it would lead to increased jobs in the villages and developmental activities in schools and villages. She told a recent experience of her that in their school they were facing trouble in getting drinking water. Thus, she requested to M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. to provide an aqua guard to their school so that more than 500 children would get benefited

20. **Smruti Ranjan Jena, Sarapanch, Pankapal**

He greeted everyone and expressed nothing to oppose against M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd, the plant will follow the rules and regulations. Referring to the previous speaker, he remarked that Misrilall had been mining for 70 years, and that this plant was formed 15 years ago, and he questioned what he had done for them during that time. Then he questioned to the ADM, Kalingagar whether he knew from where the industry is getting their water. He claimed that the plant violates the rules and regulations, so they cannot support the plant. Remarking the previous speaker's estimate of providing aqua guard and school boundary development, 2% to 5% company profit share for CSR work that is not executed by the plant, he strongly opposed to the project as the unit didn't comply the laws and regulations.

21. **Prasanjit Ray, Pankapal**

He welcomed the panel and gathering. He requested a clarification from M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. regarding the number of direct and indirect jobs provided to local people &, asking them to kindly display the details on the amount of money spent on CSR activities over the previous three years on the notice boards in their Gram Panchayat particularly for Nimapalli and Pankapal Panchyat. He requested for written explanations to the plant authority about the utilization of funds for infrastructure, livelihood missions, plantations, and put in notice boards in panchayat. He want to get clarified yet again that the plant will be run by uncle and nephew or by management because, as he claimed that the production of the plant was halted in the previous six months or a year ago because to certain internal problems. Due to the dusty location, he asked to run a mobile water sprinkler around Bangala Chaka. In order to assist with some livelihood missions, government projects, and the agricultural sector in some villages, he advised the officials of M/s Misrilall Plant to interact with sarapanchs, panchayat members, villagers, and political persons. He wished for the growth of the plant and successful public hearing.

22. **Ramakant Rout, Youth president, Pingal**

He expressed his gratitude to ADM Sir and the workers from M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd for organizing the public hearing. There are many large-scale plants in Kalinganagar including TATA, JINDAL, and MESCO, but the locals



don't understand what a public hearing is because Misrilall is only equipped with a small furnace. He questioned the previous speakers that have asked the contractor regarding the dust generated at Bangala Chaka. Whereas in Misrilall, employees are wearing white shirts while working in the plant and insisted that the plant was clean. Common people will oppose where as they supported the upcoming COB plant. He said that the public would not understand how many people's livelihoods depend on this plant. He told that M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. Has provided rupees 20 lakhs for the building of a lord Hanuman temple in the village of Nimapalli. Local people were getting employed and benefited from the plant and will be much obliged if this plant come.

23. **Manoj Sundar Ray, Pankapal**

He greeted the panel, gathering & media persons. He claimed that the plant only employed labourers and unskilled workers from the villages since permanent positions had not been offered; if permanent positions had been offered, then requested to put in notice board of three panchayat. He questioned the administration who allowed M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. to withdraw ground water that has to be put on notice board in public if it is authorized to use underground water. He told everyone to oppose the expansion of M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. as neither needed nor acceptable and advised by thoughts from knowledgeable persons and environmentalists that the COB facility was not needed. He claimed that not a single tree in this area has been planted by M/s Misrilall.

24. **Ajay Ku. Rout, Pingal**

He greeted the panel, gathering. He requested everyone to stick into the environmental pollution related concern, drinking water, plantation and the needful should get the job. And he shared his experience by telling the pre-and post-industrial conditions in the Sukinda constituency. He advised everyone to welcome the plant and requested the plant authority to carry out some beneficial work in the villages.

25. **Sritam Barik, Ragadi**

He welcomed everyone in the public hearing. He claimed it took eight months to bring justice to an accidental death of a plant worker from the Pankapal village and requested to take preventive measures to avoid similar incidents in the future. Plant must take into account the surrounding environment. He requested the plant authority to provide financial support for constructing lord Shiv temple in their area. He wished for the development of M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd.'s COB plant and also advised into consideration the surrounding. He advised the company to employ more locals rather than outsiders.



26. **Manmohan Satpathy, Nilamanideipur**
He requested to plant authority to consider their employment in the plant.
27. **Subash Chandra Ray, Pankapal**
He congratulated and supported the public hearing as so many young people from his area have got job opportunity there and are taking care of their families.
28. **Tapan Swain, Pankapal**
He greeted to everyone. He requested the plant authority for helping those who are suffering from kidney diseases. By mentioning that one of his friends once worked for the company, became ill with kidney illness and ultimately passed away without receiving assistance from the company.
29. **Deepak Ray, Pankapal**
He expressed his full support for M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd.'s COB plant.
30. **Ramesh Chandra Purty, Pingal**
He greeted the panel and gathering. There were no vehicles in their village prior to seven or eight years. After the factory comes, every household has access to a vehicle. He requested the plant authority to give priority to the villages of Jhumpuri Sahi, Jatrapal. and Pankapal.
31. **Monaj Pradhan, Pankapal**
He expressed his full support to the plant.
32. **Buna Samal, Manaharpur**
He welcomed the panel and gathering. He opposed the public hearing as not enough jobs were provided to the villages. A former employe of the plant namely Bijay kumar Nayak had kidney disease and was forced to leave the company and later passed away within two years later. He questioned as to what Misrilall had done for the many people of Pankapal, Pingal, Mantira, and Jhakpura who were getting affected from kidney disease due to pollution.
33. **Akash Parida, Pankapal**
He welcomed everyone and told that his paralyzed father received assistance and food from M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd so he thanked the plant for everything he received.
34. **Suvendu Muduli, Pankapal**
He welcomed everyone and congratulated the Plant and supported for the public hearing. Since he is a medical student, he made an effort to explain to the previous speakers, who concerned about kidney disease, that their diet




and lifestyle, water intake, and way of life were contributing factors and asked everyone to support and make a legitimate demand.

35. **Madhabanenda Behera, Galagaon**
He greeted everyone and welcomed the public hearing of M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. and expressed his full support to the plant.
36. **Pabitra Jena, Pankapal**
He greeted everyone and opposed the public hearing because air and water pollution level are very high. The industry doesn't think about agriculture and asked for number of trees they have planted in panchayat. He claimed that the rise of road accidents occurring due to the increase of vehicle working in plant. He requested plant authority to make plantation and use of river water.
37. **Brajmohan Jena, Pankapal**
He is against the proposed plant expansion. He stated that a thick coating of dust has been deposited over the well water in Hanumathpatana, Pankapal, and over tree leaf as a result of operation of the industry. Till date the plant haven't taken any step towards plantations.
38. **Satyabrata Puhan, Gobardhanpur**
As a company employee, he made an effort to reassure everyone about their water treatment and recycling system as well as the maintenance and operations of their pollution control equipment.
39. **Tapu Ray, Pankapal**
He greeted everyone and expressed his full support to M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd.
40. **Ranjit Ray, Pankapal**
He expressed his support to M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd.
41. **Manas Sundar Ray, Pankapal**
He expressed his full support to the public hearing of M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. He told that in his knowledge there were many people who are working in the plant and told that some ongoing developmental work by Misrilal like Hanuman temple in Pankapal village, Mangala Mandap in Nilamanidei pur.
42. **Dasarathi Purty, Baghabahali**
He expressed his support to public hearing proposed by M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd.



43. **Deepa Penthei, Pankapal**
She described the current situation of her village and stated that there is just one tube-well with dusty water in their locality and there are no temple in their area.
44. **Urchana Munda, Pankapal**
He said that while development is taking place in other villages except ward No-1, Jatrapal and he requested the plant to use river water for their need.
45. **Hira Behera, Asanabohali**
She told that she received no help and that her son was jobless. She even could not able to get food or water in her house for daily livelihoods.
46. **Sanju Paika, Asanabohali**
She requested to the local sarapanch and the ward members to repair the temple as they are not finding any help from government.
47. **Manoj Mundri, Jhumpuri sahi**
He greeted everyone and asked M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. to adopt Jhumpuri sahi village. He told about a deep bore well was provided by the plant and they will be very grateful if they will get job opportunity.
48. **Tapan Rout, Pingal**
He welcomed the panel and gathering. He opposed the public hearing because not providing permanent employment and withdrawn of underground water.
49. **Susanta Barik, Pingal**
He expressed his support to M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd.
50. **Bijay Behera, Pingal**
He told that if the company wanted for extension, it should be done. People will get employment in the panchayats of Pingal, Pankapal, and Chandia. He asked other panchayats to support its expansion so that everyone will be benefitted.
51. **Alok Ranjan Bala, Nimapali**
He welcomed the panel and gathering. He said the groundwater level at the bore well was 84 feet in 1990s and now it is 135 feet and he advised the plant to receive water from the river before March or else they will face public agitation.



52. **Hemanta Mudului, Nimapali**
He advised doing what is necessary to protect the ecosystem, such as switching from groundwater to river water and planting trees. He requested to put a notice on the notice board about the funds offered in Nimapalli panchayat and adjacent villages.
53. **Binay Jena, Pankapal**
He welcomed the panel and gathering. The mistakes made by the plant with regard to the environment must be corrected, the workers must be regularized, and some unfinished activity that has lingered for eight years must be finished in the village of Pankapal.
54. **Bishal Ray, Pankapal**
He told that as promised made by M/s Misrilall, plantations should be done. In addition to the pond and well-being covered with dust, the level of groundwater has decreased. He warned the company that they will face public agitation if promises are not kept.
55. **Sunil Dei, Badunga**
She requested that her husband be given another chance and reemployed in the plant
56. **Gadadhar Swain, Koitha**
He expressed his support to the public hearing of M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd.
57. **Priyabrata Lenka, Pankapal**
He opposed the public hearing because it won't give jobs to poor people, it won't do plantations and the groundwater level has been decreased.
58. **Jamin Purti, Pankapal**
She requested to the company for assistance because her late husband, Ganga Purti, who was once employed in the plant.
59. **Tuhuna Balmu, Baghabahali**
The pond in Ward No. 4 is around 100 metres away from the plant and is covered with dust. Crop cultivation is also dusty close to this plant. He told that the nearby borewell no longer receives water because Misrilall is using groundwater. He requested for plantation, medical facility and drinking water.
60. **Pradeep Biswal, Pankapal**
He welcomed the panel, He told that Misrilall made contribution to village development work in Manharpur and provided rupees 20 and 25 lakhs for the construction of shiv temple. He is observing the changes made by the plant in



the pingal and pankapal panchayats as well as the employment of people. He gave his full support and is happy with the plant's progress.

61. **Burla Munda, Jatrapal**

He greeted everyone, and mentioned that although Jatrapal remained near to the plant, there was no support or development there.

62. **Prabin Ku. Bhatua, Pankapal**

He expressed his support to the M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd.

63. **Ratnakar Dalai, Kaitha**

According to him, M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. should make plantation of 50,000 trees in the plant surrounding area to ensure clean air and water and he suggested every plant in Kaniganagar industrial area should look the same.

64. **Alok Ku. Rout, Manhorpur**

He greeted everyone and expressed his support for the public hearing proposed by M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd because 40 people from his village were employed and received assistance during the COVID-19 period and also helped the nearby village like Pankapal with medical or other development projects.

65. **Basudev Danga, Baghabahali**

He said that as the factory grew, the local young would get benefited, thus they support M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd.

66. **Satyabrata Das, Pankapal**

He suggested that the plant should give more women work opportunities and told to support the family of late Santosh Ray.

67. **Pankaj Ku. Jena, Nilamanideipur**

He expressed his full support to the COB plant of M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd. because it recently hired 20 to 25 people from his community and helped with the development of the Mangala temple.

68. **Karunakar Tudu, Pingal**

He expressed his support to the M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd.


69. **Sribatsya Ray, Pankapal**





Groundwater level depletion 6. Peripheral development 7. Medical Facility 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sri Ujjal Ku. Sinha, CEO of M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd(COB)., who was present at the public hearing meeting, committed to certain issues raised by the public are as follows: 2. Sri Sinha greeted the guest and gathering. He clarified the current working employee strength of M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt. Ltd Is 350 where only 5% is outsider and 95% are of local people. In future if any expansion will come, they will give employment opportunity to local people. 3. In CSR work, M/s Misrilall Mines Pvt Ltd. is spending 5% of total profit and the documents will be produced. 4. Plantation is being done as per the norms of Pollution Control Board and verified by the scientists and engineers from SPCB regularly. 5. They are obeying the guidelines of water pollution, air pollution, and noise pollution. They are not working beyond the norms & guidelines as prescribed. It has been monitored by the Pollution Control Board and they have authorized consultant and the consultant provided the data to SPCB.

6. In groundwater level depletion concern by locals, they have already applied to IDCO for water supply from Brahmani River through separate pipeline and assumed that it will be completed very soon.
7. The COB plant is an ancillary unit of the plant and informed that they purchased low grade chrome ore from M/s OMC or M/s TATA Steel and they will process in the proposed plant. The waste water generated during beneficiation process will be completely recycled and only about 4KL of fresh water will be required for makeup. They ensured that not a single drop of processed water will go outside in the Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) concept. The treatment system that will be installed in the ZLD concept. They will provide separate tailing pond for storage of tailings and further disposed to M/s Ramky or any authorized recycler for disposal.
8. As they have lack of medical facility inside plant premises. They are paying to ESI for health checkup of their employees and other medical facilities.
9. They have planted 6700 trees inside the plant. They will plant more trees if there is still vacant area according to rules.
