

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF M/S. MSP SPONGE IRON LTD. FOR EXPANSION OF EXISTING INTEGRATED STEEL PLANT TO FINAL CAPACITY OF IRON ORE BENEFICIATION- 2.0 MTPA, IRON ORE GRINDING- 1.5 MTPA, PELLET- 1.8 MTPA, SPONGE IRON- 0.372 MTPA, BILLET (IF & CCM)- 0.484 MTPA, HOT ROLLED PRODUCT- 0.41 MTPA, CPP- 44 MW (WHRB- 30 MW & AFBC- 14 MW), PGP- 17100 NM³/HR, PCI- 13.16 TPH AND SLAG CRUSHER- 11.25 TPH HELD ON 05.04.2023 AT 11.00 AM AT VILLAGE HALDIAGUNA UNDER TAHASIL SADAR AT- PLOT NO- 189, KHATA NO. 72, KISAM- GOGASTA IN THE DISTRICT OF KEONJHAR.

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 05.04.2023 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in nearby villages of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Er P Kar, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Sri Bishnu Prasad Acharya, OAS(S), CDO-Cum-EO, Zilla Parishad, Keonjhar presided over and supervised the public hearing. He briefed about the importance and objectives of such hearing and invited the project proponent to highlight on proposed project.

Sri Pradip Kumar Dey, Director of the unit explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the industry.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Keonjhar.

1. Sri Tankadhar Barik, Balisuan

Sri Barik supported the public hearing and expressed that the plant has been running since last 25 years due to which many people could get employment. He informed that the company has proposed for 9 Nos. of expansion projects and for which basic requirements like raw materials, electricity, water, labour, transport & communication, marketing etc. are necessary. These aforesaid items are easily available in cheap rate due to its locational advantages. The company has been controlling dust and smoke through Electrostatic Precipitator (ESP) and does not let out the dust and smoke directly to the atmosphere. MSP has already concreted 300 meters of approach road from plant to NH 20 and regular water sprinkling is being done as a result air pollution created by transportation is controlled. The waste material like coal dust etc. has been kept inside the plant safely and water sprinkling is being done on a regular basis to restrict the dust pollution. So, he has no objection if this expansion project is approved because due to this expansion project, in future many unemployed youths will get employment. He informed that more than 90% of people of their locality have got direct & indirect employment in MSP. Moreover, people from other Panchayats and Keonjhar district has also got employment in this plant. Company has provided door to door drinking water, facilities like medical, banking etc. has also been provided by the company.

He demanded the minimum salary of Rs.18000/- per month, contractual workers need to be made permanent, drinking water supply through pipe from Ardei River, free medicines need to be provided, Seed and fertilizer need to be provided to the farmers & there shall be provision for old age pension.

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2. Sri Srikanta Mahanta, Bankamaruni

Sri Mahanta while supporting the public hearing demanded employment to the land losers directly without conducting any interview on priority basis. He requested to provide employment to the skilled unemployed youths of four villages in the new project. Further, he requested to accelerate the afforestation job and keep a close monitoring on those who has been given responsibility to maintain the afforestation project. He expressed his gratitude about the harmonious and cordial relationship of the company with the employee and the locality. Lastly, he requested to give preference to the local people for employment.

3. Sri Sashikanta Mahanta, Haldiaguna

Sri Sashikanta while supporting the public hearing expressed that due to operation of MSP plant the local educated youth has got employment. He said that a number of plants has already been closed due to various problems and it's not easy to get a job. On an average only two in every 500 person are getting Govt. job and rest are dependent upon private firms for employment. So he urged that the plant should run and wholeheartedly supported expansion project of this plant.

4. Sri Sanjay Munda, Banua

Sri Munda supported the public hearing and stated that a country becomes economically prosperous when there is massive industrialization. He informed that approximately 3000 people are directly engaged in the MSP plant and indirectly more than 10000 people are dependent on this plant. The company has provided streetlight, drinking water to all houses of four nos. of villages. He expressed his happiness for the cordial and harmonious relationship maintained by MSP with the villagers. The company has suo moto decided to provide one community centre in their village and for which they have requested to identify the place which is certainly a good gesture. He said that it is the responsibility of every person to protect the environment. Nobody has right to damage the environment. When this project will be implemented there will be some adverse impact on environment, so he requested everybody to extend their co-operation for protection of environment with the help of company. He requested the company to resolve the drinking water problem and local employment issues. He hoped that company will fulfil their expectations.

5. Sri Ramchandra Mahanta, Banua

Sri Mahanta supported the public hearing and the upcoming project.


6. Smt. Bharati Munda, Sarpanch, Khuntapada

Smt. Munda while supporting the public hearing requested for providing employment to the unemployed youths, to accelerate the CSR activities and to do whatever necessary for environment protection.

7. Sri Ratha Munda, Member Zilla Parishad, Zone No.5, Sendkap

Sri Munda expressed his happiness for expansion of existing plant. While supporting the public hearing he requested to give attention for tree plantation in some of the vacant land. Considering employment, he requested to give equal importance to the villages of Kaurikala and Gobordhan GPs situated in and around the plant and emphasized on utmost attention for local employment. He also requested to give attention to the contractual employees so that they will




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not be deprived of their rights due to monopoly attitude of contractors. He expressed his happiness towards the plant for controlling the pollution. He informed that supplying of drinking water problem has been almost resolved and he requested to avoid the employment from other district/state who are influencing the higher Govt. authorities for getting employment.

8. Sri Debraj Barik, Balisuan

Sri Barik supported the public hearing. He said that when the new project will come up many people will get employment. By this project Govt. economy will boost up and country will be benefitted. He is hopeful that MSP Steel will continue to provide all sorts of facilities in future also like what it is providing now.

9. Sri Maheswar Mahanta, Haldiaguna

Sri Mahanta while supporting the public hearing stated that due to the plant there has been development in socio-economic condition of the local people. He was happy that they could get drinking water facility, Kuchha road has also been completed by concreted, Street Light has been provided and development has been made in providing medical support. He requested for provision of one modern English Medium school for the small children, coaching centre for development in education, computer coaching centre, stitching machine for women and to provide seed and fertilizers to the farmers.

10. Sri Tapas Kumar Mahanta, Haldiaguna

Sri Mahanta while supporting the public hearing requested the company authority to continue the CSR activities like what they have been doing till date. He requested to give more attention for environment protection. He requested to give attention for education and development and for employment to land loser educated unemployed youths according to their qualifications. Lastly, he thanked MSP Steel Plant Authority for providing support to manage their livelihood during Covid 19 pandemics.

11. Sri Lambodar Mahanta, Bankamaruni

Sri Lambodar while supporting the public hearing requested for employment to the locals. He also requested that ITI and B.Tech educated local youth needs to be given employment.

12. Sri Dilip Kumar Chakra, Banua

Sri Chakra wholeheartedly supported the public hearing. He thanked MSP Plant authority for their excellent work done for the villagers in the past. He kept four demands in front of Company Authority as follows:

- i) One additional ambulance to cater the need of the immediate health issues,
- ii) Two local persons may be identified for development of local area so that they can coordinate with plant and Government authority to resolve any local issues smoothly.
- iii) MSP Authority with the help of Mission Shakti should encourage women for their growth which will make them self-dependent by which women growth can be possible.
- iv) A committee need to be formed for environment protection related issues.

13. Dr. Niladri Bihari Mishra, President, Paribesh Surakshya Samiti, Joda

Dr. Mishra persuaded to adapt most modern state of art technology for environment protection instead of traditional method. He stressed to form a committee to monitor afforestation

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programme for better plant survival rate. At the same time, he requested to encourage for organic farming. He persuaded to harvest the water flows from adjacent hills in rainy season and to reuse in the process. He also suggested to engage local people in plantation jobs. Lastly, he supported the hearing.

14. Sri Siddhartha Shankar Sahoo, Padmapur

Sri Sahoo while supporting the public hearing thanked MSP authority for helping him in practical training during his B.Tech Study. He is satisfied for the steps taken by the company for controlling dust pollution, reuse and recycle of the waste product to reduce pollution. He expressed his gratefulness to the company on behalf of Padmapur Panchayet. Lastly, he said that MSP is not confined to only four villages in conducting their CSR activities. It has carried out many developmental work in other Panchayats also. He promised on behalf of youth mass and expressed his solidarity to cooperate the company for the job like reuse and recharging of ground water etc. in future.

15. Smt. Lilabati Mahanta, Member Zilla Parishad, Zone-4, Mursuan

Smt. Mahanta while supporting the public hearing expressed her satisfaction for the work done by the company with respect to Socio-Economic development, employment provision, free ambulance & CSR activities, road construction, street light provision, plantation etc. At the same time, she requested for providing stitching training and mushroom cultivation for SHG.

16. Sri Rajat Kumar Mishra, Banua

Sri Mishra supported the public hearing.

17. Smt. Rasmi Rekha Mahanta, Haldiaguna

Smt. Mahanta while supporting the public hearing stated that due to operation of the plant the local people are able to earn their livelihood and need not have to go outside. At the same time, she demanded that there should not be any adverse effect on water bodies, forest and human lives due to expansion project. She requested to give attention for tree plantation, arrangement of drinking water and right wages.

18. Smt. Gugita Manjari Mahanta, Haldiaguna

Smt. Manjari while supporting the public hearing stated that not only their village but everybody has been socio-economically benefitted by the developmental work of company since its inception. Many people got employment. Company has provided benefits like concrete road, drinking water, free ambulance, free medical check-up, plantation, streetlight etc. She requested for massive plantation to minimize air pollution, construction of school and provide trained teacher to run the school smoothly, computer training, coaching centre, and stitching training for all round development of the women of the village.

19. Smt. Surjyamani Giri, Balisuan

Smt. Giri supported the public hearing and requested for all round developmental work like health, education, employment and economic development etc.

20. Sri Bideshi Naik, Balisuan

Sri Naik supported the public hearing.

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21. Smt. Basanti Naik, Sarpanch, Palaspanga GP

Smt. Basanti while supporting the public hearing requested to give employment to all according to their qualifications. She requested to provide stitching training centre, support for mushroom cultivation, education etc.

22. Sri Ranjan Kumar Mohanta, Haldiaguna

Sri Mahanta supported the public hearing.

23. Sri Sanjay Kumar Naik, PS Member, Palaspanga

Sri Naik while supporting the public hearing stated that due to existence of MSP plant he could see all round development of their locality. Prior to starting of this plant this area had no roads, no employment etc. He said he is hopeful that after expansion of this plant, more and more people will be benefitted.

24. Smt. Jyotirmayee Naik, Sadar Block Chairman, Kaurikala

Smt. Naik while supporting the public hearing requested for provision of medical and staff quarters and to provide boring facilities to draw water.

25. Smt. Shantilata Mahanta, PS Member, Gobardhan

Smt. Mahanta supported the public hearing. She expressed her hopefulness that in future also they will get help and cooperation from company as they did in past.

26. Smt. Nibedita Naik, Balisuan

Smt. Naik supported the expansion project.

27. Smt. Rebati Mahanta, Naib Sarpanch, Gobardhan

Smt. Mahanta supported the public hearing for the upcoming expansion project of MSP so that youths of their locality can be benefitted.

28. Sri Srikanta Mahanta, Haladiaguna

Sri Mahanta while supporting the public hearing requested for employment of the locals.

29. Sri Kandarpa Giri, Balisuan

Sri Giri supported the expansion project of MSP Steel.

30. Sri Charan Munda, Haladiaguna

Sri Munda supported the expansion project of MSP.

31. Sri Ranjan Kumar Mahanta, Haladiaguna

Sri Ranjan while supporting the public hearing stated that they have been working with the company since 7 ½ years but still they have not been made permanent. He requested to give opportunities according to their qualifications and skill. He also said that trained employees are

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also not getting appropriate works. He requested the management of MSP to give equal opportunities to all those who are engaged in MSP.

32. Sri Subhod Kumar Mishra, Banua

Sri Mishra while supporting the public hearing appreciated the efforts of the company for operating the plant despite high electricity rate as it has no captive power plant. He said that if MSP runs smoothly everybody will grow. He requested to provide jobs to the unemployed youths. He also thanked company for renovation of their village Lord Shiva temples of Jaleswar Baba. He requested for more and more developmental jobs.

33. Sri Subasish Rout, Banua

Sri Rout extended full support for expansion.

34. Sri Chintamani Giri, Balisuan

Sri Chintamani supported MSP expansion proposal.

35. Sri Hemanta Mahanta, Haladiaguna

Sri Mahanta supported the expansion project of MSP.

36. Sri Raj kishore Mahanta, Bankamaruni

Sri Mahanta while supporting the public hearing and stated that nobody spoke about education only one person told about the education and school. Everybody previously said about the employment, health, environment etc. but nobody has given importance to education. If management looks after the education, they will be grateful to the company.

37. Sri January Mahanta, Bankamaruni

Sri Mahanta while supporting the public hearing expressed that he has suffered a lot when the plant was closed due to which he went to other state as a migrant labour for his livelihood. He expressed that there is acute shortage of water in their village as they have only two nos. of tube wells. He requested to provide water to the villagers.

38. Sri Manoranjan Barik, Balisuan

Sri Barik supported the public hearing and said that the plant expansion should go ahead.

39. Sri Umesh Kumar Mahanta, Haladiaguna

Sri Mahanta while supporting the public hearing requested the company to give employment to the retired employees who are land losers either in the company or under contractor as they have already given their land to the company.

40. Sri Sibananda Sahu, Gobardhan

Sri Sahu supported the public hearing.

41. Sri Gobinda Chandra Sahoo, Gobardhan

Sri Sahoo in his address raised question that will the environment be protected only by plantation of few trees, some concrete roads etc. He told that this plant should not be confined to

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carry developmental works only for one or two villages and Panchyats, rather it should think for development of all villages and Panchayats around the plant. He told the plant is being operated for last 25 years and since then ground water is being extracted for plant use. He wanted to know when plant will start to use other water sources for plant use. He requested to carry out the proposals as soon as possible and give employment to the youths.

42. Sri Asit Kumar Barik, Balisuan

Sri Barik wholeheartedly supported the public hearing.

43. Sri Shusanta Kumar Majhi, Jadichatar

Sri Majhi supported the expansion project and requested to give employment to more and more local youths.

44. Sri Pacharatna Mahanta, Haladiaguna

Sri Mahanta expressed his full support for expansion project.

45. Smt. Hemalata Mahanta, Haladiaguna

Smt. Mahanta said that MSP should provide employment to locals, enhance salaries and the villages shall be supplied with power through new power plant and supported for expansion.

46. Smt. Lizamani Mahanta, Haladiaguan

Smt. Mahanta supported the expansion project.

47. Sri Satyanarayan Mahanta, Bankamaruni

Sri Mahanta supported the public hearing.

48. Smt. Nandini Mahanta, Haladiaguna

Smt. Nandini while supporting the expansion project demanded to open a coaching centre for Class I to X students for their upliftment.

49. Sri Bhubaneswar Mahanta, Haladiaguna

Sri Mahanta registered his name after saying in the forum. He supported the public hearing.

50. Smt. Mamata Munda, Haladiaguna

Smt. Munda expressed her agony that even she approached so many times to the company management for employment of her husband nobody has paid any heed to her request. Further, her deliberation could not understood.

51. Sri Parsuram Mahanta, Bankamaruni

Sri Mahanta wholeheartedly supported the public hearing.

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The Regional Officer, SPCB, Keonjhar read over the issues raised by the public in the hearing. Sri Pradip Kumar Dey, Director of the unit responded to the issues raised. Sri Bishnu Prasad Acharya OAS(S), CDO-Cum-EO, Zilla Parishad, Keonjhar gave concluding remarks of the Hearing.

The issues raised by the public and corresponding comments of the applicant were prepared in Odia and English and it is annexed with the proceedings as Annexure I & II respectively, list of the oral deliberators and participants in the hearing is annexed as Annexure III & IV respectively. 




