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PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING PROPOSED FOR GRANT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE FOR THE ENHANCEMENT IN IRON ORE PRODUCTION FROM 0.41 MILLION TPA TO 3 MILLION TPA WITH TOTAL EXCAVATION OF 4.073 MILLION TPA (ROM OF 3 MILLION TPA+1.073 MILLION TPA WASTE) AND SETTING UP A 100 TPH JIGGING & WASHING PLANT,TWO MOBILE JAW CRUSHERS OF 200 TPH CAPACITY EACH,TWO MOBILE CONE CRUSHERS OF 200 TPH CAPACITY EACH &TWO VIBRATORY MULTIPLE DRY SCREEN PLANTS OF 200 TPH CAPACITY EACH IN SANINDPUR IRON & MANGANESE MINES OF M/S. NATIONAL ENTERPRISES OVER AN AREA OF 70.917 HA. IN VILLAGE SANINDPUR UNDER BLOCK &TAHSIL OF KOIDA IN SUNDARGARH DISTRICT.

The public hearing for grant of Environmental Clearance of M/s. National Enterprises for the proposed enhancement in iron ore production from 0.41 MTPA to 3 MTPA with total excavation of 4.073 MTPA (ROM of 3 MTPA +1.073 MTPA Waste) and setting up a 100 TPH Jigging & Washing Plant, 2× 200 TPH mobile Jaw Crushers, 2× 200 TPH mobile Cone Crushers & 2× 200 TPH Vibratory Multiple Dry Screen Plants of Sanindpur Iron & Manganese mines over an area of 70.917 Ha. in the village Sanindpur under Koida Tahasil of Sundargarh District held on dated 05-04-2023 at 10:00am at Weekly Market Ground of Sanindpur Village under Koida Block of Sundargarh District. Sri Abhimanyu Behera, Addl. Dist. Magistrate, Sundargarh, supervised and presided over the public hearing process. Dr. Binod Bihari Dash, Addl. Chief Environmental Scientist and Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rourkela delivered welcome address, organized and conducted the public hearing meeting in association with the District Administration.

The Public Hearing in respect of the above proposed enhancement in iron ore production of Sanindpur Iron & Manganese mines of M/s. National Enterprises was held as per the schedule and the venue decided by the District Administration in accordance with the EIA Notification S.O.1533 (E) dated 14.09.2006 and subsequent amendment therein. State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar had advertised in the newspaper in Odia daily- Sambad on dtd 02.03.2023 and in English daily- The Times of India on dtd. 02.03.2023 regarding an announcement of public hearing venue, date and timing. The Public Hearing meeting with regards to date, place and time was announced in public address system apart from its publication in local dailies. The Attendance sheet


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of the public attended the public hearing is annexed as Annexure – I. Around 99 nos. of persons had attended the public hearing meeting whereas 71 persons had delivered their views whose list is annexed as Annexure II. 6 Nos. of written representations were received during public hearing which is annexed as Annexure III.

At the outset, Dr. Binod Bihari Dash, Addl. Chief Environmental Scientist, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rourkela welcomed the Official members and the public presented in the meeting. He briefly described the objectives and procedure followed for conducting the Public Hearing as per the EIA Notification S.O.1533 (E) dated 14.09.2006 of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF & CC), Govt. of India. He also explained about the importance of such public hearing for the proposed enhancement in iron ore production from 0.41 MTPA to 3 MTPA with total excavation of 4.073 MTPA (ROM of 3MTPA +1.073 MTPA Waste) and setting up a 100 TPH Jigging & Washing Plant, 2× 200 TPH mobile Jaw Crushers, 2× 200 TPH mobile Cone Crushers & 2× 200 TPH Vibratory Multiple Dry Screen Plants of Sanindpur Iron & Manganese mines of M/s. National Enterprises over an area of 70.917 Ha. for grant of Environmental Clearance. He invited views, comments, objections & opinions of the public which are necessary while considering the Environmental Clearance of the project and he also told that those who want to give their written statement about the proposed projects, they can do so during the public hearing process. He requested, Addl. Dist. Magistrate, Sundargarh to preside over the meeting.

Welcoming the public, the official members, Press Media, Police Officers and the assembled public in the meeting, Sri Abhimanyu Behera, Addl. Dist. Magistrate, Sundargarh, briefly explained about the purpose of the public hearing of the proposed enhancement in iron ore production from 0.41 MTPA to 3MTPA with total excavation of 4.073 MTPA (ROM of 3MTPA +1.073 MTPA Waste) and Setting up a 100 TPH Jigging& Washing Plant,2× 200 TPH mobile Jaw Crushers ,2× 200 TPH mobile Cone Crushers&2× 200 TPH Vibratory Multiple Dry Screen Plants of Sanindpur Iron & Manganese mines over an area of 70.917 Ha. in the village Sanindpur under Koida Tahsil of Sundargarh District. He also described the importance of environmental impact studies carried out for the proposed enhancement of iron ore production and the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public which are necessary while considering the Environmental Clearance of the project. He told that the project proponent will present the summary of Environmental impact studies for the proposed



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project for the knowledge of the Public. He invited the villagers to present their views, opinions & objections about the proposed project on Environmental consideration. He also told that the public can also submit written representations. The proceeding along with video recording of the meeting will be forwarded to the Government for further decision making process for grant of Environmental Clearance. He requested the Regional Officer, SPCB, Odisha, Rourkela to carry out further proceeding of the meeting.

Regional Officer, SPCB, Odisha, Rourkela requested the representative of Project Proponent of proposed enhancement of iron ore production of Sanindpur Iron & Manganese mines of M/s. National Enterprises to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the details of Environmental Impact Assessment report of the proposed project in a simple summarized manner for better understanding of the Public.

On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Jitendra Kumar Sahu, Geologist, M/s. National Enterprises welcomed the official members, public and all other participants and gave a brief description about Sanindpur Iron & Manganese mines. He presented the salient features of the proposed enhancement in production of Iron ore which are as follows:

- Sanindpur Iron & Manganese Mines of M/s. National Enterprises is spread over an area of 70.917 Ha in Sanindpur village under Koida Tehsil of Sundargarh district, Odisha.
- The lease area is bounded between $21^{\circ} 54' 37''$ to $21^{\circ} 55' 16.43''$ N Latitude and $85^{\circ} 18' 25.71''$ to $85^{\circ} 19' 08.30''$ E Longitude.
- The Environmental Clearance for production level of 0.41 million TPA of iron ore has been obtained from MoEF vide letter no J-11015/375/2008-IA.II(M), dtd.28.06.2013.
- The modified mining plan for enhancement of production capacity from 0.41 million TPA to 3 million TPA was approved by IBM Regional Office, Bhubaneswar vide letter no. MRMP/A/36-ORI/BHU/2021-22, dtd.23.03.2022.
- Government of Odisha has issued ToR letter vide letter no. SIA/OR/MIN/76663/2022, dtd.03.11.2022.
- Various programs for environmental management and development will be adopted if the proposed mine becomes operational. Water will be sprinkled by tanks on Haul


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Road. Coir matting, plantation and grass seeding will be done for proper management of the dump. Extensive planting of trees around mine lease area will minimize sound wave penetration. To minimize dust generation, drilling with water flushing system, sprinkling of water before and after drilling in dry seasons will be adopted. Vehicles having Pollution under Control (PUC) Certificate will be engaged in the mines. Blasting will be done during day time and at a particular time. To control water pollution, retaining walls will be built around the dumps. Garland drains will also be constructed.

- Air quality in this area is within acceptable limits and even if there is a slight increase after commencement of mining activities, it will be kept within the permissible limits by proper management by the company.
- In this project, the local people will be given jobs directly and indirectly based on their merit and experience. Provision will be made for free health care, ambulance and medicines, etc. For the improvement of education, construction of school houses, provision of toilets, etc., improvement of rural roads, development of sports and culture, and various programs will be introduced for the development of livelihood and animal resources. Programs will be made for social development along with education, health, and livelihood.

Then Regional Officer, SPCB, Rourkela thereafter invited the public to enter their names to put forth their views, suggestion, comments and objections on matters relating to the environmental aspects of the project. Then the public deliberated on various issues one by one which are given as follows:


1.Sri Bhimsen Choudhury, Ex. MLA, Koida:

He greeted & welcomed the panel members, gathered public and all other participants to the meeting. He welcomed and extended full support for the proposed enhancement in iron ore production of Sanindpur Iron & Manganese mines of M/s. National Enterprises.

He greeted & welcomed the members, gathered public, electronics media and all other participants in the meeting. He welcomed and extended full support for the proposed enhancement in iron ore production of Sanindpur Iron & Manganese mines of M/s. National Enterprises. As per New Industrial Policy , many iron ore mines of that area were closed due to expiry of lease period granted by the


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government. Hence people are facing challenges for their livelihood. He demanded to give employment preferably to educated unemployed youth of Sanindpur, Badaindpur, Jadipada, Oraghat villages after enhancing its production capacity. M/s. National Enterprises is one of the oldest company of this area. The company had been doing mining in cooperation with the local people. He informed the gathered public that the company had already appointed two teachers in Sanindpur U.P. School but as number of students are increasing day by day, there is a requirement of more no. of teachers. He also demanded the appointment of teachers in Sanindpur & Jadipada U.P. School. He requested the company to organise different environmental awareness programmes and distribute plant saplings to each of the families of nearby areas. He demanded to facilitate supply of drinking water to the villagers as summer is approaching. He also requested the company to provide financial assistance to organise different cultural programmes in the locality.

3. Sri Janardan Dehury, Ex-MLA, Koida:

He greeted & welcomed the members, gathered public and all other participants in the meeting. He said that Koida area is full of mineral resources. He extended support to the project and urged the gathered public to do the same. He demanded that for transportation of iron and manganese ores, local transporters should be engaged. He also demanded to provide employment to local people as per their required skill.

4. Sri Ghanashyam Barik, Beldihi:


He welcomed the members, gathered public, villagers and all other participants in the meeting. He expressed his happiness for such a large number of gatherings in the meeting. He said that mines play a key role in the development of the country. Due to the operation of mines, they earn their livelihood.
