


PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 19.04.2023 (AT 11.00 AM) AT COMMUNITY CENTER GROUND, OMC TOWNSHIP, KALIAPANI UNDER SUKINDA TAHASIL, JAJPUR FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE IN RESPECT OF SOUTH KALIAPANI MINE OF M/S ODISHA MINING CORPORATION LTD. FOR MINING OF CHROMITE ORE WITHOUT CHANGE IN PRODUCTION CAPACITY OF 1.40 MTPA OF CHROMITE ORE [TOTAL EXCAVATION: 16.64 MTPA (PRODUCTION: 1.40 MTPA (ROM) + WASTE : 15.24 MTPA)] WITH INCREASE IN MINE LEASE AREA FROM 552.457 Ha TO 720.727 Ha ALONG WITH AN ANNUAL THROUGHPUT CAPACITY OF 4,74,000 TONNES OF COB PLANT LOCATED AT VILLAGES KALIAPANI, GURUJANGPAL, SUKURANGI AND SARUABIL, SUKINDA TEHSIL OF DISTRICT JAJPUR DISTRICT.

The public hearing in respect of South Kaliapani Mine of M/s Odisha Mining Corporation Ltd. for mining of chromite ore without change in production capacity of 1.40 MTPA of chromite ore [total excavation: 16.64 MTPA (production: 1.40 MTPA (rom) + waste : 15.24 MTPA)] with increase in mine lease area from 552.457 ha to 720.727 ha along with an annual throughput capacity of 4,74,000 tonnes of COB plant located at villages Kaliapani, Gurujangpal, Sukurangi and Saruabil, Sukinda Tehsil of Jajpur district was held on 19.04.2023 at 11.00 am over Community Center ground, OMC township, Kaliapani under Sukinda Tahasil, Jajpur with reference to

- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006
- II. Interim Operational Guidelines till 13th September 2007 in respect of applications made under EIA-1994

The Panel consisted of the following members:

Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and assisted by Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by South Kaliapani Chromite Mine of M/s. Odisha Mining Corporation Ltd.


Welcoming the public, Sri S.K. Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Asish Kumar Samantray, Regional Manager, M/s OMC Ltd addressed the committee members and assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinga Nagar, requested the public to give their views, comments and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. Sri Bharat Chandra Mohanta, Kaliapani G.P

He greeted everyone and referring to the Pallisabha held in 2018 for the expansion of the South Kaliapani Mines, he informed that 29 projects were still incomplete, and similarly the Pallisabha held for the Daitari mines approved 8.35 crores for the projects, but they were still unfinished. He told that as it was decided in the assembly, OMC should adopt villages like Kaliapani, Sukrangji, and Saruabil; however, this has to be validated on the



ground and the required assistance must be given. According to the commitment during Pallisabha, OMC will build an Adarsha School and reserved admission for kids from underprivileged tribal households of this region. He asked the authority of OMC via Pallisabha to appoint specialist doctors (Specialist of Medicine, Gynaecologist, Child, Skin Disease) in the township hospital so everyone in this area might benefit timely. He claimed that no noticeable development had occurred in this area and asked OMC to host their once-a-year Sourika Yuva Mahotsav and asked OMC personnel to donate Rs 5 lakhs annually to the Chandimata festival, which was held in Kaliapani. They were facing trouble due to lack of transport facility for students, so he asked OMC staff to set up a bus transport service so they could find assistance and he requested that the projects will be finished as well as the demands that had previously been made on Palisabha will come to fulfilment. He gave his complete support to the expansion of south kaliapani mine of M/s OMC Ltd for dumping of overburden.

2. Sri Bikash Kumar Patra, Sarapanch of Kaliapani G.P

He requested for the fulfilment of the demands that had been made in writing which was briefed by the previous speaker, Sri Bharat Ch. Mohanta. It was specifically requested to OMC that the school bus transportation facility should be fulfilled as soon as possible. Next, it was suggested that adopted villages should get special consideration. He offered his full support to the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion Project for OB Dumping.

3. Sri Biswajit Mohanty, Ex Sarapanch of Ransol G.P

He supported the project and urged that the demands made by the first speaker, Sri Bharat Ch. Mohanta, be quickly carried out so that this region will develop & progress and he supported the OMC South Kaliapani Mine public hearing.

4. Smt Jena Chaki, Zilla parisad of 37 No. zone of Sukinda block, Kaliapani G.P

She greeted everyone and expressed her complete support for the public hearing on the OMC South Kaliapani Mine. She asked Regional Manager of OMC & CSR coordinator for quick execution of 14-point demanded and the fulfilment of the projects that were promised under the Daitari Mines. She advised OMC personnel to focus on children's education, drinking water, roads, and basic amenities for those common people who were displaced from their land and colony.



5. Sri Sanjay Parida, Sarapanch of Kankadpal G.P

He fully supported the OMC's plans to extend the South Kaliapani Mine. He said, residents in the seven wards in this area would be impacted to some level, thus they should have access to the basic necessities. He requested the OMC authority to create enough plantations and create jobs and expressed thankfulness to the OMC for providing jobs and basic necessities as promised in the 2018 Pallisabha and requested that current needs should be given priority.

6. Sri Jagabandhu Mohanta, Kalarangiatta G.P

He greeted everyone and fully supported the OMC's South Kaliapani chromite mine. He asked OMC to give highest priority for education and reforestation. The underprivileged kids who missed out on education must receive full support.

7. Smt Bhagabati Mohanta, Ex chairman of Sukinda


She greeted everyone and requested the ADM sir for the fulfilment of 14-point written demand they had prepared for the benefit of everyone in this area. She asked CSR coordinator and the authorities for quick execution of the projects that were promised under the Daitari Mines. She gave her full support to the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion.

8. Smt Kanakalata Sardar, Sarpanch, Ransol

She supported the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion. As the five villages were getting more affected, she stated her demands for the CSR activities to be properly implemented. Including this mine extension, the deterioration of the environment should be taken care of and the environment should be restored. She made demands for drinking water, roads, health and education. She expressed her gratitude to OMC for giving Adarsha vidyalaya and asked for the establishment of a technical college so that jobless people might gain skills and find employment accordingly. In terms of health, she requested that the OMC should provide specialists doctors in child, women's, medicine, cancer, and tuberculosis to the Township hospital and make awareness campaign. In water issues as the mine is becoming deeper and they were experiencing a water shortage, so the needful measure should be made and requested that the school and college bus transportation facility should be started.

9. Smt Rajarani Dehuri, Sarapanch of Kansa

She greeted everyone and fully supported the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine extension. She requested for a solution to the problem of water scarcity in her G.P. She stated that her GP is nearby the extension project and the displaced people should be benefitted.



10. Smt Anjali Dehuri, Sarapanch of Chingudipal

Welcoming the gathering she greeted everyone and fully supported the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine Extension Project for OB Dumping. She requested the OMC's authorities to give attention to Chingudipal G.P & Patana village as adopted village.

11. Smt Rani Majhi, PS member of Chingudipal

She fully supported the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine public hearing.

12. Sri Saluka Hamuga, PRI member of Kaliapani G.P

He greeted everyone and thankful to OMC because they provided bus service for college students in the mining-affected area and committed to create the Adarsh Vidyalaya. M/s OMC should follow their commitments.

13. Smt Umarani Pradhan, Ransol G.P

She greeted everyone and thankful to OMC as because they created the Adarsh Vidyalaya and she fully supported OMC's South Kaliapani Mine OB dump extension.

14. Sri Haladhar Mohanta, Kaliapani G.P

He greeted everyone and expressed his full support to OMC's South Kaliapani Mine OB dump extension and requested the OMC authorities to offer a long-term drinking water solution.

15. Smt Nitima Munda, PS member of Kansa G.P

She requested that the 30 numbers of chirusahi households of Kansa G.P. who will be relocated should receive compensation as soon possible. She requested to solve the panchayat's unemployment issues. The drinking water supply given by the nearby mines was also insufficient. She gave complete support to the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion.

16. Sri Samara Munda, Samiti Sabhya of Kankadpal G.P

He greeted everyone and thanks the OMC for providing health campaign to poor people and gave his full support to the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion.

17. Sri Ashis Kumar Jena, Kaliapani

He requested the OMC authority to fulfil the demands made by the five sarapanchs of Ransol, Kankadpal, Chingudipal, Kaliapani, and Kansa as soon as possible. He gave his full support to the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion.



- 18. Sri Balaram Das, Ransol**
He gave his support to the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine. He requested OMC authority, Mr. Ashok Behera to give direct employment to the affected area.
- 19. Smt Sabitri Mohanta, Chingudipal**
She fully supported OMC's South Kaliapani Mine OB dump expansion.
- 20. Sri Dillp Kumar Sardar, Baragaji**
He fully supported OMC's South Kaliapani Mine OB dump expansion.
- 21. Sri Motilal Mohanta, Kaliapani**
He fully supported OMC's South Kaliapani Mine OB dump extension public hearing. He requested more specific measures will be taken against the wind-borne dust that will be produced from the OB dump and requested that the water after treatment in ETP only be discharged to outside so that it will not affect to human and domestic health.
- 22. Sri Manas Ranjan Bhanja, Kalarangiatta**
He supported OMC's South Kaliapani Mine's public hearing for expansion.
- 23. Sri Sanjay Kumar Mohanta, Baragaji**
He supported the expansion of OB dump of South Kaliapani Mine of OMC Ltd.
- 24. Sri Kailash Chandra Mahakud, Ransol**
He fully supported the expansion of OB dump of South Kaliapani Mine of OMC Ltd.
- 25. Sri Dasarath Mohanta, Ransol**
He supported South Kaliapani Mine expansion project and requested to the OMC authorities and ADM to increase the local employment and growth by reopening the Kalarangiatta mines as 600 to 700 labours who were working lost their jobs when the mine was closed before 22 years.
- 26. Sri Ajay Nayak, Kaduabandi**
Welcoming the gathering he greeted everyone and spoke about that in these five villages, dumping activities were more significantly impacted by dust and water than mining activity. He supported OMC's South Kaliapani Mine extension project as OMC had previously prioritised this area. He thought that the OB dump extension will have a greater impact on Kankadpal Village considering it share the most of the territory. He asked ADM to give the people of Kankadpal most consideration as possible. They



asked for an educational institution and medical facilities for the five affected villages.

27. Sri Manoj Ku. Mohanta, Bhimtangar

He greeted everyone and supported OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion project.

28. Sri Sarat Kumar Nayak, Kankadpal

He greeted everyone and supported OMC's South Kaliapani Mine extension project as he satisfied with the project proponent briefing.

29. Smt Manjulata Mohanta, Mahulkhala

She greeted everyone and supported the public hearing for OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion.

30. Smt Sukurmani Hasda, Kansa

She greeted everyone and supported the public hearing for OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion.

31. Smt Jinita Munda, Gurujanga

She greeted everyone and supported OMC's South Kaliapani Mine extension public hearing. She demanded to know why locals weren't being employed in mining activities, if hired then by through contractors only, and she requested for consideration in the above matter.

32. Smt Bhanumati Mohanta, Ransol

She greeted everyone and supported OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion.

33. Smt Susama Nayak, Kalarangiatta

She supported the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine extension public hearing. She referred previous speaker Sri Dasarath Mohanta for reopening of Kalarangi mines so local employment will increase.

34. Smt Sakuntala Mohanta, Ostapal

She greeted everyone and supported OMC's South Kaliapani Mine extension public hearing.

35. Smt Sangita Pradhan, Kaliapani

She greeted everyone and supported the expansion of South Kaliapani Mine.



- 36. Smt Sabita Mohanta, Bhalukipatala**
She greeted everyone and supported OMC's South Kaliapani Mine extension public hearing and demanded for permanent employment should be provided to the locals in accordance with their educational levels. OMC should help the SHG group women in training to become self-sufficient.
- 37. Smt Rashmi Oram, Saruabil**
She expressed her support for expansion of South Kaliapani Mine of OMC Ltd.
- 38. Smt Gitanjali Mohanta, Kaliapani**
She supported OMC's South Kaliapani Mine extension public hearing. She explained how any mining operations must have been planned with a 100-year vision consideration before beginning, and she requested for giving priority to education in this area.
- 39. Smt Subhasini Mohanta, Kaliapani**
She supported for the expansion of South Kaliapani Chromite Mine.
- 40. Smt Priyanka Priyadarsini Mohanta, Kaliapani**
She greeted everyone and supported the public hearing for OMC's South Kaliapani Chromite Mine.
- 41. Sri Nilendra Pradhan, Chingudipal**
He expressed his support for OMC's South Kaliapani Mine extension public hearing. In the near future, the OMC authorities should consider their demands
- 42. Sri Ashok Pradhan, Kaliapani**
He greeted everyone and supported the public hearing for OMC's South Kaliapani Chromite Mine.
- 43. Sri Susanta Pradhan, Kansa**
He welcomed the project and supported OMC's South Kaliapani Chromite Mine extension public hearing. He requested for reopening of Kalarangi mines so that employment will increase in their village.
- 44. Sri Ramesh Mohanta, Ostapal**
He supported OMC's South Kaliapani Chromite Mine extension public hearing. He asked ADM Sir to widen the road in this area as on regular basis 100 of trucks were passing. Because of this narrow route, 3 to 4 accidents occurring in each month.


- 45. Sri Bibhuti Pradhan, Ransol**

Welcoming the panel he supported OMC's South Kaliapani Chromite Mine extension public hearing as it will bring the employment opportunity. It will be very beneficial because it will create jobs, peripheral development will occur, and he advised for reforestation and orchard planting in vacant village land. He claimed that although they had promised to fulfil their promises, many mines had received support for setting up in this area. He added that if commitments got addressed, it would be helpful.
- 50. Sri Sagar Hembram, Giringamali**
He greeted everyone and supported OMC's South Kaliapani Chromite Mine extension public hearing. He claimed that the first villages to be impacted by this OB dump are Giringamali, Garadagadia, Kakudia, and Disamundia, and he asked for permanent employment to above villagers as well as to take mitigation measures against air pollution, employ educated residents of the villages, and improve the road, health, and transportation facilities.
- 51. Smt Sunatha Mohanta, Ransol**
She greeted everyone and supported OMC's South Kaliapani Chromite Mine extension public hearing.
- 52. Sri Manoranjan Mohanta, Ransol**
He expressed his greetings to everyone and supported for the expansion OMC's South Kaliapani Chromite Mine.



53. Sri Ranjan Kumar Thatoi, Saruabil

He greeted the panel and public and supported the expansion project of South Kaliapani Chromite Mine.



<p>The issues raised at the public hearing meeting are as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Health 2. Education 3. CSR activities 4. Employment 5. Environment 	<p>Sri Ashok Kumar Behera, GM, P&A made commitment to certain issues raised by the public are as follows:</p> <p>He told that people from nearby five gram panchayats depend on Central Hospital of M/s OMC Ltd. He told that as per prior commitment, specialist doctors are coming to hospital every week. He also committed that specialist doctors such as medicine, gynaecology, paediatrics and orthopaedics will come shortly from Bhubaneswar, Cuttack or from Jajpur for the sake of nearby villagers as well as employ of OMC. He also told that they will hold health camp for critical care such as cancer and cardiology. He suggested that they will run campaigns and programmes to raise health awareness among people. He requested people to share the doctor's visit chart among surrounding peoples so that maximum people will be get benefitted.</p> <p>One Adarsha Vidyalaya will be established with the help of M/s OMC Ltd for the benefit of periphery students who are deprived from education facilities. The school will be</p>




functional from standard 1st to standard 12th where students will find education & hostel facilities with free of cost & admissions will begin from the month of June of this year.

He told that they will provide bus transportation facilities for school students very shortly.

He told that they will extend the CSR activities in the adopted villages such as transportation, light and other facilities. As requested, they will conduct a new survey with CSR team to reduce the gaps if any in the adopted villages. He told that few peoples were requested for reopening the Kalarangiatta mine under OMC Ltd. which is non-operational since 2006, The mine is closed because of forest clearance. Now they are doing exploration and according to the viability, the mine will reopen.


He told that OMC is a government organisation and there are government procedures for getting employment in OMC. In recent past OMC held a walk in interview at Barbil where some people from this of this region have found employment in the post of surveyor, foreman and mining mate. He told that direct employment in the Govt. organization is not possible & maximum local people are engaged through outsourcing.

For dust suppression and stabilization of dump, mobile water sprinkling facility & coir mating through vertibro grass have been practised.

He told that they will extend the facilities for SHG which




	<p>will be helpful for woman empowerment. They have provided additional employees to the CSR group; so that the CSR projects could be finished as soon as possible and the subsequent project will begin concurrently.</p> <p>They will accept the 14-points demanded by the local people after discussion with the management. He gave assurance that majority of the demands will be fulfilled.</p> <p>And lastly he gave thanks to everybody present in the public hearing meeting & told that besides people's demand they were committed from the beginning in numerous development efforts and referring few examples that they have established Kaliapani bus terminal with market complex, provided life support ambulance services and other medical facilities. He also told that snake bites are common in this area and they are planning to organise a campaign to raise awareness on snake bite in the presence of Sri Suwendu Mallick, Chairman, State snake help line.</p>

The public hearing in respect of South Kaliapani Mine of M/s Odisha Mining Corporation Ltd. for mining of chromite ore without change in production capacity of 1.40 MTPA of chromite ore [total excavation: 16.64 MTPA (production: 1.40 MTPA (rom) + waste : 15.24 MTPA)] with increase in mine lease area from 552.457 ha to 720.727 ha along with an annual throughput capacity of 4,74,000 tonnes of COB plant located at villages Kaliapani, Gurujangpal, Sukurangi and Saruabil, Sukinda Tehsil of Jajpur district was held on 19.04.2023 at 11.00 am over Community Center ground, OMC township, Kaliapani under Sukinda Tahasil, Jajpur with reference to

Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and assisted by Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by South Kaliapani Chromite Mine of M/s. Odisha Mining Corporation Ltd.


Welcoming the public, Sri S.K. Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Asish Kumar Samantray, Regional Manager, M/s OMC Ltd addressed the committee members and assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinga Nagar, requested the public to give their views, comments and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. Sri Bharat Chandra Mohanta, Kaliapani G.P

He greeted everyone and referring to the Pallisabha held in 2018 for the expansion of the South Kaliapani Mines, he informed that 29 projects were still incomplete, and similarly the Pallisabha held for the Daitari mines approved 8.35 crores for the projects, but they were still unfinished. He told that as it was decided in the assembly, OMC should adopt villages like Kaliapani, Sukrangi, and Saruabil; however, this has to be validated on the



ground and the required assistance must be given. According to the commitment during Pallisabha, OMC will build an Adarsha School and reserved admission for kids from underprivileged tribal households of this region. He asked the authority of OMC via Pallisabha to appoint specialist doctors (Specialist of Medicine, Gynaecologist, Child, Skin Disease) in the township hospital so everyone in this area might benefit timely. He claimed that no noticeable development had occurred in this area and asked OMC to host their once-a-year Sourika Yuva Mahotsav and asked OMC personnel to donate Rs 5 lakhs annually to the Chandimata festival, which was held in Kaliapani. They were facing trouble due to lack of transport facility for students, so he asked OMC staff to set up a bus transport service so they could find assistance and he requested that the projects will be finished as well as the demands that had previously been made on Palisabha will come to fulfilment. He gave his complete support to the expansion of south kaliapani mine of M/s OMC Ltd for dumping of overburden.

2. Sri Bikash Kumar Patra, Sarapanch of Kaliapani G.P

He requested for the fulfilment of the demands that had been made in writing which was briefed by the previous speaker, Sri Bharat Ch. Mohanta. It was specifically requested to OMC that the school bus transportation facility should be fulfilled as soon as possible. Next, it was suggested that adopted villages should get special consideration. He offered his full support to the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion Project for OB Dumping.

3. Sri Biswajit Mohanty, Ex Sarapanch of Ransol G.P

He supported the project and urged that the demands made by the first speaker, Sri Bharat Ch. Mohanta, be quickly carried out so that this region will develop & progress and he supported the OMC South Kaliapani Mine public hearing.

4. Smt Jena Chaki, Zilla parisad of 37 No. zone of Sukinda block, Kaliapani G.P

She greeted everyone and expressed her complete support for the public hearing on the OMC South Kaliapani Mine. She asked Regional Manager of OMC & CSR coordinator for quick execution of 14-point demanded and the fulfilment of the projects that were promised under the Daitari Mines. She advised OMC personnel to focus on children's education, drinking water, roads, and basic amenities for those common people who were displaced from their land and colony.



5. Sri Sanjay Parida, Sarapanch of Kankadpal G.P

He fully supported the OMC's plans to extend the South Kaliapani Mine. He said, residents in the seven wards in this area would be impacted to some level, thus they should have access to the basic necessities. He requested the OMC authority to create enough plantations and create jobs and expressed thankfulness to the OMC for providing jobs and basic necessities as promised in the 2018 Pallisabha and requested that current needs should be given priority.

6. Sri Jagabandhu Mohanta, Kalarangiatta G.P

He greeted everyone and fully supported the OMC's South Kaliapani chromite mine. He asked OMC to give highest priority for education and reforestation. The underprivileged kids who missed out on education must receive full support.

7. Smt Bhagabati Mohanta, Ex chairman of Sukinda


She greeted everyone and requested the ADM sir for the fulfilment of 14-point written demand they had prepared for the benefit of everyone in this area. She asked CSR coordinator and the authorities for quick execution of the projects that were promised under the Daitari Mines. She gave her full support to the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion.

8. Smt Kanakalata Sardar, Sarpanch, Ransol

She supported the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion. As the five villages were getting more affected, she stated her demands for the CSR activities to be properly implemented. Including this mine extension, the deterioration of the environment should be taken care of and the environment should be restored. She made demands for drinking water, roads, health and education. She expressed her gratitude to OMC for giving Adarsha vidyalaya and asked for the establishment of a technical college so that jobless people might gain skills and find employment accordingly. In terms of health, she requested that the OMC should provide specialists doctors in child, women's, medicine, cancer, and tuberculosis to the Township hospital and make awareness campaign. In water issues as the mine is becoming deeper and they were experiencing a water shortage, so the needful measure should be made and requested that the school and college bus transportation facility should be started.

9. Smt Rajarani Dehuri, Sarapanch of Kansa

She greeted everyone and fully supported the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine extension. She requested for a solution to the problem of water scarcity in her G.P. She stated that her GP is nearby the extension project and the displaced people should be benefitted.



10. Smt Anjali Dehuri, Sarapanch of Chingudipal

Welcoming the gathering she greeted everyone and fully supported the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine Extension Project for OB Dumping. She requested the OMC's authorities to give attention to Chingudipal G.P & Patana village as adopted village.

11. Smt Rani Majhi, PS member of Chingudipal

She fully supported the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine public hearing.

12. Sri Saluka Hamuga, PRI member of Kaliapani G.P

He greeted everyone and thankful to OMC because they provided bus service for college students in the mining-affected area and committed to create the Adarsh Vidyalaya. M/s OMC should follow their commitments.

13. Smt Umarani Pradhan, Ransol G.P

She greeted everyone and thankful to OMC as because they created the Adarsh Vidyalaya and she fully supported OMC's South Kaliapani Mine OB dump extension.

14. Sri Haladhar Mohanta, Kaliapani G.P

He greeted everyone and expressed his full support to OMC's South Kaliapani Mine OB dump extension and requested the OMC authorities to offer a long-term drinking water solution.

15. Smt Nitima Munda, PS member of Kansa G.P

She requested that the 30 numbers of chirusahi households of Kansa G.P. who will be relocated should receive compensation as soon possible. She requested to solve the panchayat's unemployment issues. The drinking water supply given by the nearby mines was also insufficient. She gave complete support to the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion.

16. Sri Samara Munda, Samiti Sabhya of Kankadpal G.P

He greeted everyone and thanks the OMC for providing health campaign to poor people and gave his full support to the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion.

17. Sri Ashis Kumar Jena, Kaliapani

He requested the OMC authority to fulfil the demands made by the five sarapanchs of Ransol, Kankadpal, Chingudipal, Kaliapani, and Kansa as soon as possible. He gave his full support to the OMC's South Kaliapani Mine expansion.





He told that as per prior commitment, specialist doctors are coming to hospital every week. He also committed that specialist doctors such as medicine, gynaecology, paediatrics and orthopaedics will come shortly from Bhubaneswar, Cuttack or from Jajpur for the sake of nearby villagers as well as employ of OMC. He also told that they will hold health camp for critical care such as cancer and cardiology. He suggested that they will run campaigns and programmes to raise health awareness among people. He requested people to share the doctor's visit chart among surrounding peoples so that maximum people will be get benefitted.</p> <p>One Adarsha Vidyalaya will be established with the help of M/s OMC Ltd for the benefit of periphery students who are deprived from education facilities. The school will be</p>




functional from standard 1st to standard 12th where students will find education & hostel facilities with free of cost & admissions will begin from the month of June of this year.


He told that they will provide bus transportation facilities for school students very shortly.

He told that they will extend the CSR activities in the adopted villages such as transportation, light and other facilities. As requested, they will conduct a new survey with CSR team to reduce the gaps if any in the adopted villages. He told that few peoples were requested for reopening the Kalarangiatta mine under OMC Ltd. which is non-operational since 2006, The mine is closed because of forest clearance. Now they are doing exploration and according to the viability, the mine will reopen.

He told that OMC is a government organisation and there are government procedures for getting employment in OMC. In recent past OMC held a walk in interview at Barbil where some people from this of this region have found employment in the post of surveyor, foreman and mining mate. He told that direct employment in the Govt. organization is not possible & maximum local people are engaged through outsourcing.

For dust suppression and stabilization of dump, mobile water sprinkling facility & coir mating through vertibro grass have been practised.


He told that they will extend the facilities for SHG which



will be helpful for woman empowerment. They have provided additional employees to the CSR group; so that the CSR projects could be finished as soon as possible and the subsequent project will begin concurrently.

They will accept the 14-points demanded by the local people after discussion with the management. He gave assurance that majority of the demands will be fulfilled.


