

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 29.04.2023 & AT 11.00 AM AT DANAGADI BHAWAN, DANAGADI OF JAJPUR DISTRICT PROPOSED BY SRI SIDDARTH SHARMA FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE IN RESPECT OF M/S JATIA STEEL LTD. GREENFIELD PROJECT FOR PRODUCTION OF 7,50,000 TPA ROLLED PRODUCTS AT KALINGANAGAR INDUSTRIAL COMPLEX IN VILLAGE JAKHAPURA UNDER DANAGADI TEHSIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT

The public hearing in respect of the Jatia Steel Ltd. for proposed Greenfield project for production of 7,50,000 TPA Rolled product at Kalinganagar Industrial Complex in village Jakhapura under Danagadi Tehsil in Jajpur District was held on scheduled date & time at Danagadi Bhawan under Danagadi Tehsil of Jajpur district with reference to EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006 and amendments thereof.

The Panel consisted of the following members:

2. Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Kalinganagar.

Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, Jajpur, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and assisted by Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed during the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of Jatia Steel Ltd., at Kalinganagar Industrial Complex in village Jakhapura, Tehsil Danagadi in Jajpur District.



Welcoming the public, Sri Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, Jaipur welcomed the public and explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public.

On behalf of the project proponent, Sri Sudhanidi Rout, representative of Jatia Steel Ltd. briefed the proposal and Environmental impact of the project. He addressed the dais and assembled public and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, afforestation programme and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Sri Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar, Jaipur requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:


1. **Sri Prasant Kumar Rout, Jakhapura**
Sri Rout greeted the gathering & welcomed the proposed project and assured the Company to provide necessary assistance in the project. He requested the Company to take step for environment protection, primary healthcare facility, drinking water supply, education, repairing of road connecting visa steel to manpur siding and local area development etc.
2. **Sri Dillip Kumar Nayak, Jakhapura**
He greeted the dais & gathering and urged the company to fulfill the commitment as briefed by the Company representative. He further requested the Company to given written commitment for providing service and carry out development activity in the local area. Finally, he expressed his support for the proposed project of the Company.
3. **Sri Kailash Jena, Jakhapura**
Sri Jena told that he is not opposing the project but requested the Company to take adequate environment protection measure in the proposed plant.




4. **Sri Kalandi Sethi, Jakhapura**
Sri Sethi welcomed the gathering and expressed his hope for local area development by establishment of the proposed plant of M/s Jatia Steel Ltd.
5. **Mrs. Jayanti Mallick, Mantira**
She demanded preference to local people during employment in the proposed plant of the Company.
6. **Mrs. Renubala Pradhan, Mangalpur**
She expressed her support for the proposed plant and complaint that Companies are not fulfilling their earlier commitments. She requested the Company to fulfill its commitments.
7. **Mrs. Sonali Pahi, Jakhapura**
She greeted the gathering and requested the company to support the local women & SHG group.
8. **Sri Pandu Singh Khuntia, Sarpanch (Chandia GP)**
He supported the proposed project but requested periphery and local area development.
9. **Mrs. Yasaswini Sahu, Jakhapura**
Mrs. Sahu supported the project and demanded local employment, periphery development, environment protection, women empowerment, preference to local people in employment etc.
10. **Sri Bishnu Mallick, Mangalpur**
He expressed his support and demanded local employment and periphery development etc.
11. **Sri Babuli Natia, Nuagaon**
Sri Natia complaint that companies are not fulfilling commitments and doing any development work in the locality. He questioned the company on the proposed development work as the project seems to be a small unit. He supported the proposed plant and demanded local development, education and healthcare facility etc.
12. **Sri Abhisek Samal, Jakhapura**
Sri Samal expressed his support and complaint that companies are not fulfilling their commitments. He demanded employment, local development and fulfill other local demands.



13. **Mrs. Pusalata Ghadei, Mantira**
She complaint on the environment pollution in the local area. She demanded environment protection, women empowerment, preference for local development etc.
14. **Sri Bulu Yadav, Pingal**
Sri Yadav greeted the dais and gathered public. He demanded plantation, education, heathcare, local employment, women empowerment, local development etc. He further demanded employment to 100 nos. of people from Jakhapura village, development of Jakhapura village and supported the proposed project of M/s Jatia Steel Ltd.
15. **Sri Sudam Charan Nayak, Golagaon**
He expressed his support and demanded the Company to fulfill all the commitments.
16. **Sri Duryodhan Behera, Mantira**
He supported the project.
17. **Sri Trilochan Dhal, Jakhapura**
Sri Dhal urged the public to support the proposed project and demanded local employment, drinking water supply and plantation etc.
18. **Mrs. Sujata Laxmi Mohanty, Mangalpur**
She expressed her support to the proposed plant and demanded periphery development, permanent employment etc.
19. **Sri Chandan Patra, Dasmania**
He supported the project and requested for environment protection.
20. **Sri Krushna Chandra Pal, Dakhanapada**
Sri Pal informed that his village is located proximity to the proposed plant and requested the Company for environment protection, dust control, road traffic control, preference for local employment etc.
21. **Sri Deepak Kumar Mohanty, Balungabandi**
Sri Mohanty expressed his support to the proposed project and requested the Company to give preference in employment to his local village people as per their qualification. He further demanded environment protection, plantation and periphery development etc.




22. **Sri Biswanath Patra, Secretary united forum, Jajpur**
He welcomed the gathering but complaint that local people are not getting benefits as per commitment. He demanded for local rights, employment Jakhapura people, plantation and periphery development etc.
23. **Sri Bijay Kumar Das, Jakhapura**
He requested rehabilitation rule be followed and local people be given benefits.
24. **Sri Biswajit Nayak, Jakhapura**
Sri Nayak requested local employment during construction and operation of the plant and preference be given to Jakhapura GP people. He also requested to give employment in technical post as per their skill and educational qualification. He expressed his support to the proposed plant but complaint that companies are not fulfilling their commitments. He told that people of Jakhapura are hopeful of getting benefit from the proposed project.
25. **Sri Deepesh Kumar Ghadei, Mantira**
Sri Ghadei expressed his support to the proposed plant and complaint that maximum outsider people are getting employment in the local area. He requested the Company to assist farmers of the local area and give preference in employment to local people.
26. **Sri Udaya Rout, Mangalpur**
Sri Rout supported the proposed project and demanded support for agriculture, domestic animals and farmers of the local area under periphery development activity of the Company.
27. **Sri Ranjan Kumar Dhir, Danagadi**
He expressed his support to the proposed project and informed that several plants in the area are under shutdown since long which has caused unemployment to so many people. He further informed that twelve GP of Danagadi block are affected by local industry activity. Sri Dhir demanded skill development training to local public, environment protection, plantation, local employment and requested the Administration to complete water supply project in the local area and finish road widening project in the Danagadi area.
28. **Sri Prashant Nayak, Jakhapura**
Sri Nayak expressed his support to the proposed plant of M/s Jatia Steel Ltd. He complaint that land settlement under Jakhapura GP is not yet completed and demanded the District Administration to take step for land settlement.



The Panel has received 04 nos. of written representations during the hearing. Total 29 nos of local public have registered their name to express their view ad 28 nos. expressed their speech on the proposed project. Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar, Jajpur asked the project proponent to present their comments to the people with respect to the demands raised by the public in the public hearing meeting. Sri Subhanidi Rout, representative of M/s. Jatia Steel Ltd. made the commitment on issues raised by the public. The statement of issues and concern of the public with comments of the applicant prepared in English & Odia language are annexed separately. The meeting was ended with thanks to the chair.







It is brought to the notice of all concerned that Sh. Siddarth Sharma has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for M/s. Jata Steel Ltd. Greenfield project for production of 7,50,000 TPA Rolled Products at Kalinganagar Industrial Complex in village Jakhapura under Danagadi tahsil of Jajpur district to obtain Environmental Clearance from State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha. The proponent has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for a Public Hearing.

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India Notification No. SO-1533 (E) Dt. 14.09.2003, the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site / sites of displacement / sites likely to be affected.

For the above purpose, a person will only mean:

- A. Any person who is likely to be affected by the grant of Environmental Clearance.
- B. Any person who owns his control over the project with respect to which an application has been submitted for environmental clearance.
- C. Any association of persons whether incorporated or likely to be affected by the project and / or functioning in the field of environment.
- D. Any local authority within any part of whose limit is within the neighborhood wherein the project is proposed to be located.

Persons as above who desire to submit their views, comments, objections etc. relevant to the project, may do so in writing within 30 days from the date of publication of this notice addressing the same to the Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha through Registered Post. Besides this, persons interested to submit their views relevant to the proposed project in writing or orally may also do so during the public hearing to be conducted on 29-04-2023 11.00 A.M. at Danagadi Bhawan, Danagadi of Jajpur district.
