

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING FOR GRANT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE FOR PATABEDA IRON & MANGANESE MINES OF M/S. M.G. MOHANTY FOR ENHANCEMENT OF IRON ORE PRODUCTION FROM 1,80,000 TPA TO 5,72,305 TPA (5,42,625 TPA FROM EXCAVATION + 29,680 TPA FROM OB DUMP RE-HANDLING INVOLVING A TOTAL HANDLING OF 6,28,911 TPA) AND SETTING UP ADDITIONAL 250TPH CAPACITY CRUSHER AND A 250TPH CAPACITY SCREEN PLANT OVER AN AREA OF 19.425 HA. IN VILLAGE PATABEDA UNDER TAHASIL OF KOIRA IN SUNDARGARH DISTRICT HELD ON DTD.09.05.2023 AT 10.00AM AT PATABEDA VILLAGE UNDER BLOCK & TAHASIL OF KOIRA IN SUNDARGARH DISTRICT.

The public hearing for grant of Environmental Clearance of M/s. M.G. Mohanty for the proposed enhancement of Iron ore production from 1,80,000TPA to 5,72,305TPA (5,42,625TPA From Excavation + 29,680 TPA From OB Dump Re-Handling Involving a Total Handling of 6,28,911TPA)and setting up Additional 250TPH Capacity Crusher and a 250TPH Capacity Screen Plant of Patabeda Iron & Manganese Mines over an area of 19.425 Ha. in the village Patabeda under Koira Tahesil of Sundargarh District was held on dated 09-05-2023 at 10:00AM at Football Play Ground of Patabeda Village under Koira Block of Sundargarh District.Sri Abhimanyu Behera, Addl. Dist. Magistrate, Sundargarh, supervised and presided over the public hearing process. Dr. BinodBihari Dash, Addl. Chief Environmental Scientist and Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rourkela delivered welcome address, organized and conducted the public hearing meeting in association with theDistrict Administration.

The Public Hearing in respect of the above proposed enhancement in iron ore production of Patabeda Iron & Manganese Mines of M/s. M.G. Mohanty was held as per the schedule and the venue decided by the District Administration in accordance with the EIA Notification S.O.1533 (E) dated 14.09.2006 and subsequent amendment therein. State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar had advertised in the newspaper in Odia Daily- "The Samaj" on dtd. 05.04.2023 and in English Daily-"The Times of India" on dtd.

05.04.2023 regarding announcement of public hearing venue, date and timing. The Public Hearing meeting with regards to date, place and time was announced in public address system apart from its publication in local daily newspapers. The Attendance sheet of the public attended the public hearing is annexed as Annexure - I. Around 119 nos. of persons had attended the public hearing meeting where as Sixty Six Number of persons had delivered their views whose list is annexed as Annexure - II. Thirty One Nos. of written representations were received during public hearing which is annexed as Annexure- III.

At the outset, Dr. Binod Bihari Dash, Addl. Chief Environmental Scientist & Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rourkela welcomed the Official members and the public presented in the meeting. He briefly described the objectives and procedure followed for conducting the Public Hearing as per the EIA Notification S.O.1533 (E) dated 14.09.2006 of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF & CC), Govt. of India. He also explained about the importance of such public hearing for the proposed enhancement in iron ore production from 1,80,000TPA to 5,72,305TPA (5,42,625 TPA from Excavation + 29,680 TPA From OB Dump Re-Handling Involving a Total Handling of 6,28,911 TPA) and setting up Additional 250TPH Capacity Crusher and a 250TPH Capacity Screen Plant of Patabeda Iron & Manganese Mines of M/s M.G. Mohanty over an area of 19.425 Ha. in the village Patabeda under Koira Tahasil of Sundargarh District for grant of Environmental Clearance. He invited for views, comments, objections & opinions of the public which are necessary while considering the Environmental Clearance of the project and he also told that those who want to give their written statement about the proposed projects, they can do so during the public hearing process. He requested Sri Abhimanyu Behera, Additional District Magistrate, Sundargarh to preside over the meeting.

Welcoming the public, the official members, Press Media, Police Officers and the assembled public in the meeting, Sri Abhimanyu Behera, Addl. Dist. Magistrate, Sundargarh, briefly explained about the purpose of the public

hearing of the proposed enhancement in iron ore production from 1,80,000 TPA to 5,72,305 TPA (5,42,625 TPA From Excavation + 29,680 TPA From OB Dump Re-Handling Involving a Total Handling of 6,28,911 TPA) and setting up Additional 250 TPH Capacity Crusher and a 250 TPH Capacity Screen Plant of Patabeda Iron & Manganese Mines over an area of 19.425 Ha. in the village Patabeda under Koira Tahasil of Sundargarh District. He also described the importance of environmental impact studies carried out for the proposed enhancement of Iron ore production and the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public which are necessary while considering the Environmental Clearance of the project. He told that the project proponent will present the summary of Environmental impact studies for the proposed project for the knowledge of the Public. He invited the villagers to present their views, opinions & objections about the proposed project on Environmental consideration. He also told that the public can also submit written representations. The proceeding along with video recording of the meeting will be forwarded for further decision making process for grant of Environmental Clearance. He requested the Regional Officer, SPCB, Odisha, Rourkela to carry out further proceeding of the meeting.

The Regional Officer, SPCB, Odisha, Rourkela requested the representative of Project Proponent of proposed expansion project of Patabeda Iron & Manganese Mines of M/s. M.G. Mohanty to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the details of Environmental Impact Assessment report of the proposed project in a simple summarized manner for better understanding of the Public.

On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Bijay Kumar Behera, Environmental Engineer, M/s. M.G. Mohanty welcomed the official members, public and all other participants and gave a brief description about Patabeda Iron & Manganese Mines. He presented the salient features of the proposed enhancement in production of Iron ore which are given as follows:

- Patabeda Iron & Manganese Mines of M/s. M.G. Mohanty is spread over an area of 19.425 Ha in Patabeda village under Koira Tehsil of Sundargarh district, Odisha.
- The lease area is bounded between 21° 55' 45.15980 N" to 21° 56' 01.68076" N Latitude and 85° 22' 21.57196" to 85° 22' 35.98813" E Longitude.
- The Environmental Clearance for production level of 1,80,000 TPA of iron ore has been obtained from MoEF vide letter no J-11015/41/2006-IA.II(M), dtd.09.01.2007.
- The modified mining plan for enhancement of production capacity from 1,80,000 TPA to 5,72,305 TPA was approved by IBM Regional Office, Bhubaneswar vide letter no. MRMP/A/37-ORI/BHU/2021-22, dtd.16.03.2022.
- SEIAA of Odisha has issued ToR letter vide File no. SIA/OR/MIN/77960/2022, dtd.03.11.2022.
- Various programs for environmental management and development will be adopted if the proposed mine becomes operational. Water will be sprinkled by mobile water tanks on Haul Road. Plantation and grass seeding will be done for proper management of the dump. Extensive planting of trees around mine lease area will minimize sound wave penetration. To minimize dust generation, drilling with water flushing system, sprinkling of water before and after drilling in dry seasons will be adopted. Vehicles having Pollution under Control (PUC) Certificate will be engaged in the mines. Blasting will be done during day time and at a particular time. To control water pollution, additional retaining walls will be built around the dumps. Garland drains will also be maintained accordingly.
- Air quality in this area is within acceptable limits and even if there is a slight increase after enhancement of mining activities, it will be kept within the permissible limits by proper management by the company, M/s M.G Mohanty.
- In this project, the local people will be given jobs directly and indirectly based on their qualifications and experience. Provision will be made for free healthcare, ambulance and medicines etc. For the improvement of education, construction of school building & toilets, etc., improvement of rural roads, development of

sports infrastructure and various programs will be introduced for the development of livelihood and animal resources. Programs will be made for social development along with education, health and livelihood.

Then Regional Officer, SPCB, Rourkela thereafter invited the public to register their names to put forth their views, suggestion, comments and objections on matters relating to the environmental aspects of the project. Then the public deliberated on various issues one by one which are given as follows:

1.Sri Dibakar Nayak, Ex. Sarpanch, Malda:

Sri Nayak greeted & welcomed the panel members, gathered public and all other participants to the meeting. He welcomed and extended 100% support for the proposed enhancement in iron ore production of Patabeda Iron & Manganese Mines of M/s.M G Mohanty. He agreed that the company had deployed sufficient local people, providing financial help for local cultural program and doing so many development works for the society and he believes that the company should increase the local employment and development after enhancement of the proposed production.He also suggested maintaining the avenue plantation from Sunaposi to Gonua village.

2. Sri Ashok Nayak, Member, Zilla Parishad, Koira

Sri Nayak greeted & welcomed themembers, gathered public, electronics media and all other participants in the meeting. He welcomed and extended full support for the proposed enhancement in iron ore production of Patabeda Iron & Manganese mines of M/s. M G Mohanty. He was quite happy with the mines management and the mine owner. He requested the mine management to give priority to the local people during engagement of people and mining equipments after enhancement of production. He also suggested to construct a wheel wash system in the mines in order to control air pollution in the locality.

3.Sri KulamaniPatra, Gonua Village

Sri Patra extended support to the project and urged the gathered public of the affected area to do the same.He agreed that the company provided 04 nos. of toilets for Boys & Girls at Mondajoda School and they are doing extensive social

development works in and around the nearby Villages. He requested to provide one Cow Shed in suitable place.

4. Sri Anand Barik, Teherai Village

Sri Barik greeted & welcomed the members, gathered public, electronics media and all other participants in the meeting. He welcomed and extended full support for the proposed enhancement in iron ore production of Patabeda Iron & Manganese mines of M/s. M G Mohanty. He told that the company should enhance its production capacity as population of that area is increasing day by day. As per New Industrial policy, many iron ore mines of that area were closed due to expiry of lease period granted by the Government. Hence people are facing challenges for their livelihood. He demanded to give employment preferably to educated unemployed youth of the surrounding villages after enhancing its production capacity. M/s. M G Mohanty is one of the oldest companies of this area. The company had been doing mining in cooperation with the local people. He informed the gathered public that the company had already running one Dispensary with full time qualified Doctor & Pharmacist where general people of 10 nos. villages getting treatment with free medicine. He requested the company to organise different environmental awareness programmes and distribute orchard saplings to each of the families of nearby areas and avenue plantation from village Sunaposi to Gonua. He also requested the company to provide financial assistance to organise different cultural programmes in the locality and look after the development of the SHG groups of the locality.

5. Sri Ashutosh Sinha, Malda Village

At the outset, Sri Sinha gives his full support the proposal of enhancement of the production. He told that company is doing so many development works at the surrounding villages and requested the company to develop the existing Durga Mandap and playground at Malda Village.






