

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF THE PROJECT PROPOSED BY DEPARTMENT OF FISHERIES, GOVERNMENT OF ODISHA FOR CONSTRUCTION OF STAGE-II DEVELOPMENT OF FISHING HARBOUR AT VILLAGE NUAGARH, ASTARANGA UNDER ASTHARANGA TAHASIL IN THE DISTRICT OF PURI

The Public Hearing meeting in respect of environmental impact assessment proposed by the Department of Fisheries, Government of Odisha for construction of Stage – II Development of Fishing Harbour at village Nuagarh, Astaranga under Astarangh tahasil in the district of Puri over an area about 40.39 Ac. (16.34 Ha.) was held on dtd. 15.03.2023 at 11.00AM in the Ground Floor of Marine Police Station Building at Nuagarh, Astaranga in Puri district with reference to:

1. EIA Notification S. O. 1533(E) dated 14.09.2006.
2. Interim Operational Guidelines.

The Panel consists of the following members:

1. Sri Bhabataran Sahu, OAS (SB), Sub-Collector, Puri
2. Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar

At the outset, Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar Regional Office on behalf of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha welcomed the guests, dignitaries, public and other members present in the meeting. The meeting was presided over by Sri Bhabataran Sahu, OAS (SB), Sub-Collector, Puri on behalf the District Administration, Puri.

Dr. Sohan Giri, being the Representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing as has been cited in the EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date and the modalities to be followed for conducting the public hearing meeting in respect of the project proposed by the Department of Fisheries, Government of Odisha for construction of Stage – II Development of Fishing Harbour at village Nuagarh, Astaranga under Astarangh tahasil in the district of Puri over an area about 40.39 Acres (16.34 Hectare).

Welcoming the public, the Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar, highlighted about the aim and objective of the public hearing and invited the views, comments/opinions from the local public w.r.t the environmental clearance of the project. Then he requested Sri Bhabataran Sahu, OAS (SB), Sub-Collector, Puri to preside over the public hearing meeting.

The Regional Officer invited the project proponent to put forth the details of the proposed project i.e. areas to be mined out, mining procedure to be followed, environment impact, restoration, peripheral development to be taken up for the benefit of local public. Then with the permission of Chair, Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar) invited the project proponent Sri Alok Ranjan Patra, Executive Engineer, Dept. of Fishery of Astaranga Division to highlight about the proposed project (phase-II Fishing harbor which going to be started at Astaranga (Nuagarh) w.r.t Environment Management plan to be carried out during running of the project.

The project proponent put forth/highlighted the gathering about the possible environmental impact over the said area. In this reply Executive Engineer had highlighted about the proposed Fishing Harbor project in brief as follows:-

- a) The total cost of the project is about Rs. 82.86 Crore.
- b) About 40.39 Ac (16.34 Hectare) of land will be required for the proposed project.
- c) The facilities to be provided at the harbor like Fish landing station, location for storage of Ice blocks and breaking, location for boat repairing center, dock yard for fishing boat, fishing nets mending, etc..
- d) On Environment issue of the proposed project spoke about the provisions to be made during construction phase like:
 1. Water sprinklers will be provided at the proposed side to suppress the dust during transportation.
 2. Green belt will be developed.
 3. No ground water will be used during the project work.
 4. Solid waste management will be done at per Board's guideline.
 5. Ambient noise will be maintained properly as per CPCB guideline.
 6. Total Rs.170 lakhs will be spent regarding Environment Management.

He explained about the various aspects to be covered up during of the operation of proposed project i.e. benefits to be provided to the local fisherman, peripheral development activities to be taken up etc. He had also invited the opinion and objection of the public present in the public hearing and had sought their co-operation for smooth implementation of the project.

After the completion of deliberation, Dr. Sohan Giri requested the public present at the meeting of the area to put forth their views, comments, objections and opinions etc. about their suggestion for protection/restoration of environment of the area and its impact during construction of the said project.

The following speakers gave their views on the above said project, which is given as follows :

1) **Sri Gadadhara Biswal, Ex-Zilla Parisada Member of Astaranga**

Sri Biswal had highlighted the issues on siltation of Devi river mouth, problem of Olive Reddy turtle during hatching of their egg. Hence first of all the Devi river mouth dredging work to be done, the entire Astaranga sea coast to be declared as a center of Eco- Tourism and provision and facilities should be made for laying of eggs by Olive Reddy turtle.

2) **Sri Prasanna Kumar Behera, President Fishing Worker's Union, Astaranga**

Sri Behera welcomed the dais and the public and highlighted that :

- (i) Emphasis should be given for creating more some cyclone shelters and to be developed where around up to 5000 fishing boats can take their shelter during heavy cyclone.
- (ii) Dredging of sea mouth i.e Devi river mouth which is day-by-day becoming silted.
- (iii) Entire river embankment should be stacked with boulder.
- (iv) Dredging of Nuagarh sea mouth for easy movement of fish vessel & fishing landing.
- (v) The steps to be taken for restoration of the local environment.
- (vi) Steps to be initiated as soon as possible for setting up the fish Harbour.

3) **Adhikari Behera, Astaranga**

At the outset Sri Behera thanked the Government for providing such type of proposal for establishment fishing harbor. However, he said that the fisherman's conditions to be improved and more facilities have to be provided to them. There are around 16,400 numbers of fisherman in an around there area and about 960 nos. capa provision to be provided.

4) **Sri Rama Chandra Nayak (Nuagarh)**

Sri Nayak welcomed all the participants present in the public hearing including the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Odisha and their local M.L.A. He had raised some issues like:

- (i) Govt. should take care of the social and financial condition of the fisherman and development of their life status.

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- (ii) Efforts to be made for restoration of mangrove forest from the discharge of chemical mixed water.
- (iii) Local employment and green belt development.

5) Sri Jitendra Swain, Sarapanch, Nuagarh Gram Panchayat

Mr. Swain has highlighted on following the aspects:

- (i) He welcomed the proposal for development of the 2nd phase establishment of the fish landing port.
- (ii) He asked the Dept. Officials that whether the Government had acquired the land from local public and their claimed has been settled.
- (iii) A godown to be established by the government.
- (iv) Local employment facilities to be provided within a time limit.
- (v) Protection of Olive Reedley turtle at Devi mouth and greenbelt development.

6) Mr. Durjay Kumar Mishra, Vice-Chairman, Astharanga

After welcoming all the officials of District Administration and other public present in the meeting, Sri Mishra had highlighted on following issues:


- (i) Lives and livelihood of the local people should be prior attention of the Government during project work.
- (ii) Before startup the fishing harbor project work, sand should be lifted from Devi river bed.
- (iii) Capa facilities should be provided for fisherman and Trawlers.

7) Sri Debakar Chhatoi, Ex-Sarapanch, Astharanga

At the outset, Sri Chhatoi conveyed thank to the Honble Chief Minister of Odisha. He also viewed that development work should be there along with environment protection.

8) Sri Manoj Kumar Barik, Jhadinga

Sri Barik in his proposal highlighted that the proposed project work should be completed in war footing time period. The local environment should be protected and local people be provided employment.



9) **Sri Budheswar Barik, Nuagarh**

Sri Barik had highlighted that all the expenditure should be as per the interest of local people.

10) **Sri Raghunath Swain, Olanga Village**

Sri Swain had focused in his deliberation that, payment of farmers claim shall be made and then the project work should be started.

11) **Sri Samant Chandra Mohanty, President of Nuagarh Boat owner's Association**

Sri Mohanty focused about the fisherman's inconvenience with respect to road infrastructure, drinking water supply and no fuel facility for boat and trawlers. He thanked for the proposed project.


12) **Sri Sabara Behera, Secretary Jagannath Society, Nuagada**

Sri Behera had highlighted about the provision for Capa and facilities for their families or they all will go far strike.

After all the deliberation of speakers the Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar with the permission of chair had invited Sri Alok Ranjan Patra, the Executive Engineer of Fishery Extension Officer of Astharanga to address the Public and clarify the point raised during the meeting. He highlighted about the issues of the project as follows:

- (i) The Central Department, Pune has prepared the details of the project.
- (ii) Water Resource Department, Govt. of Odisha will take up the dredging work and the same will be carried out.
- (iii) For Cyclone shelters the proposal will be given to the State Government.
- (iv) For Air, Water pollution control measures and green belt development will be carried out as per the direction and advises of the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha.
- (v) Model role will be framed by taking the help and advice of all stack holders.
- (vi) There will be godown facilities.
- (vii) Project area will be demarked from government land. No private land will be taken.


At last the Regional Officer, SPCB, requested the chair to put forth the final comments and remarks about the public hearing before concluding the programme. The Sub-Collector, Puri as well as the Presiding Officer of the public hearing meeting welcomed the public and government officials finally gave the concluding remarks. He



highlighted/briefed about the proposed project and informed the gathering that the EIA & EMP have been done as per the direction and guideline of Ministry of Forest, Environment and Climate Change Department, Govt. of India. Accordingly all the guideline will be followed and the proceedings of public hearing meeting have been recorded and will be sent to the government for taking final decision. He highlighted about the project and also gave assurance to the public over some issues like:

- (i) The proposal put-forth by the speakers are justified as maximum persons are depending upon fishing for their livelihood.
- (ii) The Devi muhan dredging proposal is justified and will be taken up.
- (iii) He directed the concerned Tahasildar, Astaranga and the Fisheries Department for land demarcation and assured that no private land will be acquired.
- (iv) Financial compensation to farmers will be given if their land is acquired and they will be compensated adequately.
- (v) For traditional fisher man cyclone shelter provision will be made.
- (vi) To meet the power failure situation there will be solar panel system arrangement.
- (vii) The micro-composting system should be developed along with waste water treatment system.
- (viii) Attention will be given for restoration of Olive Ridley turtle resting place.
- (ix) During construction of spur, the boat movement will be fixed.
- (x) Priority will be given to the local people/young mans for employment.
- (xi) Immediate decision may be taken for green belt development, all work should be started speedily and the project should get Government clearance.

Finally the public hearing programme was conducted successfully with thanks to the Chair and the whole programme has been video recorded completely without any pause.



<p>The issues raised by the public hearing meeting are as follows relating to peripheral development, local employment and environmental related issues:</p> <p>a) For establishment of residential building i.e. cyclone resting shed.</p> <p>b) Good road condition i.e. repairing of road from village up to proposed harbor construction site.</p> <p>c) Green belt development along the approach road site and on the river bank at the project site.</p> <p>d) Controlled Ambient Noise Pollution during construction of harbor.</p> <p>e) Restoration of Ground water nearby to the project area.</p> <p>f) Protection of Olive Ridley resting area & protection of their egg till hatching.</p> <p>g) Establishment of 03 to 04 nos. of fish storage godown with Ice manufacturing unit.</p> <p>h) Financial compensation to the people those will lose their land during construction of harbour.</p> <p>i) Restoration of mangrove forest area on Ecological point of view nearby to the harbour.</p> <p>j) Opening of repairing centre for lunch & boat when they will show any mechanical problem.</p> <p>k) Dredging of Devi river mouth.</p> <p>l) River embankment nearby to the project area should be stacked with Boulder so as to protect from soil erosion during high flood.</p> <p>m) Financial help to the local fisherman for development of their socio-economic status.</p>	<p>In reply to the raised issued by the public the Executive Engineer, Fishery Department, Astaranga, Puri, Govt. Of Odisha had replied that:</p> <p>(a) All the cited issues have already been incorporated in the DPR & for that budgetary provision of Rs. 170 lakhs will be spent towards environmental management cost.</p> <p>(b) Wastage of water will be checked during construction phage and ground water will not be use during the project work.</p> <p>(c) High quality machineries will be used to maintain the noise level below the prescribe limit of CPCB also there will be no movement of heavy vehicle during night time so as to check the loud noise.</p> <p>(d) During the project work proper green will be develop at the project site and forest area will not be affected.</p>

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| <p>n) Proper development of vehicle parking area for loading and unloading of fishes.</p> <p>o) Regular water sprinkling by mobile water tanker till the completion of the project work so as to suppress the fugitive dust emission during movement of vehicle.</p> <p>p) Pucca road (black topped) to be provided from village area up to the project site.</p> <p>q) Employment to the local people should be provided on priority basis for running of the fishery harbor.</p> <p>r) On the whole a co-ordination committee to be constituted by taking the official of dist.
