

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF M/S. BIO-TECH SOLUTIONS FOR SETTING UP A COMMON BIO-MEDICAL WASTE TREATMENT FACILITY (CBMWTF) OVER PLOT NO. 155/1020 AND 15/1025 AT VILLAGE JAMPALI UNDER BINKA TEHSIL OF SUBARNAPUR DISTRICT HELD ON 28.06.2023 AT 10.00 A.M, AT JAMPALI, DIST: SUBARNAPUR**

Sri Surya Narayan Dash, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Subarnapur presided over the meeting in presence of Er. Babita Singh, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Balangir.

At the start while welcoming the public present in the meeting, Er. Babita Singh, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Balangir also briefed them about the objective of the public hearing being conducted under provisions of EIA Notification No. S.O. 1533(E) of Dt.14<sup>th</sup> September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change (MOEF & CC), Government of India. She further informed that the date, time and venue for conducting the Public Hearing Meeting of M/s. Bio-Tech Solutions (the Project Proponent) was duly advertised in Odia daily "**PRAMEYA**" dtd.25.05.2023 and in English daily "**THE NEW INDIAN EXPRESS**" dtd.25.05.2023 (Paper clippings are enclosed as **Annexure-I**). The venue, date and timing of the Public hearing meeting were also extensively propagated through loudspeaker announcement in the area. Executive summary of the proposed project both in Odia & English were displayed at the meeting venue for ready reference of public and were also distributed among the persons present during the meeting. The executive summary was also made available in the website of State pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar ([www.ospcboard.org](http://www.ospcboard.org)).

The Additional District Magistrate has also briefed about the proposed project and requested the public present in the public hearing meeting to express their opinions and views on the proposed project. He also requested the representative of the proposed project to highlight about their proposed project before the public.

On behalf of M/s. Bio-Tech Solutions, Sri Rajendra Kumar Sahu, Proprietor, addressed the public during the public hearing meeting. Sri Pradeep Nanda, representative of M/s. Bio-Tech Solutions briefly explained about the proposed project as described below:

1. M/s. Bio-Tech Solutions has proposed to setup a Common Biomedical Waste Treatment & Disposal Facility (CBWTF) at Mouza: Jampali, Tahasil: Binika in the district of Subarnapur for treatment of 7MT of biomedical wastes and has acquired 2.0 Acre land for the facility. All wastes

from hospitals and health care units of Subarnapur district and nearby districts may use this facility. This will be set up as per the provisions of Bio-Medical Waste (BMW) Management Rules, 2016 and guidelines of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) made thereunder.

2. He explained different aspects of the proposed project and pollution control measures to be adopted.
  - Air Pollution: The gases after being burnt at 1050<sup>0</sup>C shall be run into multi cyclone and a ventury scrubber followed by a floated scrubber with quenching arrangement. The scrubber shall be an alkaline scrubber to neutralize the gases and ensure trapping of any pollutants escaping into the environment. They will also use quencher and two cyclonic droplet separators as pollution control devices.
  - Sprinklers will be provided to suppress dust inside the premises.
  - Water Pollution: Total requirement of water in proposed project will be 9 KLD out of which 6 KLD will be fresh water which will be sourced from bore well. Total waste water will be generated from the proposed project is 6 KLD. An ETP of size 6 KLD has been proposed for treatment of effluent generated from the unit. Treated effluent will be recycled into the process.
  - Solid Waste: Wastes will be generated in the form of ash and other residues. Approx. 50-100 Kg per day of ash will be generated from the Plant. Solid waste generated from other source is about 10 to 20 Kg per day. It will be collected in containers/bags and shall be stored at temporary ash storage shed and shall be disposed into the secured landfill. All other Hazardous Wastes shall be disposed as per Hazardous & Other Waste (Management & Trans boundary Movement) Rule, 2016.
  - The unit has committed to examine/measure the air, water, noise quality in the plant premises and will take adequate measures to remain within the prescribed standard.
  - Plantation will be taken up at least 33% of the vacant land as per Govt. Rule.

Thereafter, the Addl. District Magistrate invited the public to offer their views on environment related issues on the establishment of the proposed project. About 30-40 people from surrounding local villages have attended the public hearing meeting; out of which 29 have signed the attendance sheet (annexed as **Annexure-II**). Only 7 persons have registered their name to deliver views during the public hearing (**Annexure-III**).

**Statements of the public as stated/deliberated& recorded during Public Hearing Meeting are placed below**

Sl. No.	Participant Name and Statement/deliberation as recorded on the proposed project.
1.	<b>Sri Madan Sundar Mahakur, Jampali:</b> He welcomed the proposed project. He stressed for local employment.
2.	<b>Sri Narayan Deheri, Jampali:</b> He expressed his views that the local rice mill existing in the locality is not taking any measures to control pollution. If the proposed company will take all measures to control pollution then they have no objection for establishment of the unit.
3.	<b>Sri SauravGanda, Jampali:</b> He expressed views employment to be provided as per the technical skills & qualifications. He welcomed the project.
4.	<b>Sri AkshyaPujhari, Binka:</b> He welcomed the proposed project. Due to establishment of the unit the biomedical wastes will be properly disposed and for which the locality will be free from pollution.
5.	<b>Sri Khira Sagar Bibhar, Bhawanipali:</b> He expressed his support for the proposed project. He suggested that the project proponent shall give emphasis for local employment. He also expressed his views to stop firing of agricultural wastes.
6.	<b>Sri Sitaram Palika, Jampali:</b> He expressed views that the rice mill existing in the locality is not taking any measures to control pollution and discharging their effluent without any treatment. So if the company will take all measures to control pollution then they have no objection for establishment of the unit.
7.	<b>Sri Bhuuban Gadua, Jampali:</b> He also expressed his views about the pollution of rice mill. If the company will


take all measures to control pollution then they have no objection for establishment of the unit.

After the deliberation process, Er. Babita Singh, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Balangir summed up all concerns/issues/points raised by the participants during the public hearing and read out before the public. 





The public raised the following issues and apprehensions for redressal by the project proponent.


1. The Project Proponent shall provide opportunities for employment to the local people in the proposed project as per their educational qualifications
2. Proper pollution control measures should be taken in the project so that people should not be affected due to the Project.



It is brought to the notice of all concerned that M/s Bio-Tech Solutions has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF) at Plot No. 155/1020 and 15/1025 in Village Jamapali under Binika tehsil of Subarnapur district to obtain Environmental Clearance from State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha. The proponent has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for a Public Hearing.

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India Notification No. S.O. 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006, the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site / sites of displacement / sites likely to be affected.

For the above purpose, a person will only mean:

- A. Any person who is likely to be affected by the grant of Environmental Clearance.
- B. Any person who owns his control over the project with respect to which an application has been submitted for environmental clearance.
- C. Any association of persons whether incorporated or likely to be affected by the project and/or functioning in the field of environment.
- D. Any local authority within any part of whose local limits is within the neighborhood, wherein the project is proposed to be located.
