

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF M/S. RUNGTA MINES LIMITED FOR EXPANSION OF FERRO ALLOYS PLANT CAPACITY FROM 0.055 MTPA TO 0.293 MTPA ALONG WITH 150 MW CPP AT VILLAGE TULASIDIHA, CHARADAGADIA AND KANGELAPAL UNDER ODAPADA TAHSIL OF DHENKANAL DISTRICT WAS HELD ON 31.08.2023 AT 11.00 AM IN NAYABHAGIRATHIPUR (EAST) RI OFFICE, DHENKANAL OF ODAPADA TAHASIL IN THE DISTRICT OF DHENKANAL.

Sri Lalit Mohan Behera, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate, Dhenkanal presided over the meeting along with Er. Ramesh Kumar Ekka, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul, Odisha.

At the outset, Regional Officer welcomed the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing conducted as per the provisions of EIA Notification No. S.O. 1533(E) of Dt.14th September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change (MOEF & CC), Government of India. He also informed that the date, time and venue for conducting the public hearing meeting for M/s. Rungta Mines Limited for expansion of Ferro Alloys Plant capacity from 0.055 MTPA to 0.293 MTPA along with 150 MW CPP at village Tulasidiha, Charadagadia and Kangelapal under Odapada Tahsil of Dhenkanal District was scheduled to be held on 31.08.2023 at 11.00 AM in Nayabhagirathipur (East) RI Office, Dhenkanal of Odapada Tahasil in the District of Dhenkanal which was duly advertised in Odia daily "*The Dharitri*", dtd. 28.07.2023 and English daily "*The Times of India*" dtd. 28.07.2023 (Paper clipping are enclosed as Annexure-I).

The Addl. District Magistrate has also briefed about the proposed mines project and requested the public who were present during the public hearing meeting to express their opinion and views on the proposed project. He also requested the representative of the project to highlight about their proposed project before the public.

On behalf of the project proponent, Sri Jayant Kumar Panda, Unit- Head (FAD Plant), representative of the industry addressed the public during the public hearing meeting. He briefly explained about the project expansion that is production capacity from 0.55 MTPA to 0.293 MTPA along with 150 MW CPP which would be the second largest plant in Odisha. For which M/s Rungta Mines Limited has applied before the

concern authority for approval of environmental clearance. In this context, Mr. Panda requested the public to participate more & deliberate their opinion and for grand success of the clearance.

The Regional Officer invited the public to keep their views on environmental related issues for the proposed project.

About 400-500 participants have attended the public hearing meeting and out of them 284 participants have put their signature in the attendance sheet whose list is annexed as **Annexure-II**. During meeting, 37 persons have registered their names and delivered their views. List is annexed as **Annexure-III**.

Regional Officer invited the public to register their names at the counter one by one and present their views, any complain and valuable suggestions about the proposed project.

Statements of the public participated in the deliberation during public hearing meeting is as follows;

Sl. No.	Name of the participants and their deliberation on the proposed project.
1.	<p><u>Sri Kumuda Chandra Rout, Charadagadia:</u> Hesupported the expansion of Ferro Alloys Plant and demanded the following before the company authority;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Developmental work of the local area. b. Pollution related issues and its control c. Employment opportunity as per the educational qualification. d. Establishment of First Aid Centre, Educational Development, Skill Development, road communication etc. e. To provide an actual compensation for land looser. f. To create more employment opportunity in the proposed project in order to get engagement of the local villagers and utilisation of CSR funds.
2.	<p><u>Sri Khirod Chandra Behera, Kochilamada:</u> He informed that; the importance of Industrialization is necessary for development of Country. He supported the proposed project with a condition to give importance to the local issues like unemployment, village development etc. The people of other States like Bihar, Karnataka and West Bengal are employed here whereas our local people are not. We never oppose the expansion of plant. I request to give priority to hospital, road issues, pollution, veterinary hospital, drinking water, proper land</p>

	<p>compensation and Adarsha School. I have Full support to FAD plant and its expansion.</p> <p>He raised concern over employment of local people, Plantation of trees, First Aid Centre, communication and Village Development. He strongly raised the issues of actual compensation for the land. He has requested the District Administrative to build "Adarsha School" in villages and supply of drinking water.</p>
3.	<p><u>Sri Kapil Charan Samal, Kochilamada:</u></p> <p>He expressed his support for the expansion project in order to get more people engagement in the plant. In addition to this, he requested the company authorities to take important steps towards development of local village, periphery development, communication and educational development.</p>
4.	<p><u>Sri Dhobei Charan Samal, Kochilamada:</u></p> <p>He supported the expansion of the company. He emphasized on education, health, land compensation, local transport which should be provided by the company. He also requested before the district administration to look into the matter. Finally, he stated that if the company authority shall undertake the above, then he has no objection for the proposed expansion of the plant.</p>
5.	<p><u>Sri Bulu Kumar Sahoo, Motanga:</u></p> <p>He expressed his dissatisfaction and stated that Lingara river is getting polluted due to direct discharge of water from Ferro Alloys plant drains. He also stated that local people are getting affected by the dust pollution in the roads due to transportation. He expressed that, they have no objection regarding acquisition of land. Policy should be made for the management of rehabilitation of affected people for land losers. He requested before the district administration regarding engagement of teachers in schools and Doctors in the hospital, plantation drive should be carried out in the local area.</p>
6.	<p><u>Sri Bapuni Samal, Kochilamada:</u></p> <p>He informed that in the year 2006, compensation cost against the land acquired by company were very nominal. He agreed for the expansion but demanded best compensation policy and high compensation value against the land to be acquired by Rungta company.</p>
7.	<p><u>Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Kochilamada:</u></p> <p>He stated that, the local villages are ready to provide land to the company officials subject to following demands:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Proper rehabilitation and settlement policy. 2) Permanent employment as per educational qualification. 3) Contractual Work. 4) Health issues of the public. 5) Veterinary Hospital.

	<p>6) ITI and Diploma colleges. 7) Agricultural development. 8) Agricultural equipment. 9) Drinking water. 10) Village road and transport facility. 11) Vocational education for Ladies.</p>
8.	<p><u>Smt Kalabati Naik, Charadgadai:</u> She welcomed and supported the proposed project and stated that more employment and development work will take place once the proposed project gets implemented. She also requested before the district administration to provide reservation to SC/ ST communities in the field of health and education.</p>
9.	<p><u>Sri Rananjaya Sahoo, Meramundali:</u> He deliberated regarding the importance of environment and its awareness and pollution related issues. He asked the company authorities to provide the assessment data of local water and air pollution loads. Now-a-days pollution related issues are aggravating, no plantation work is being done, elephants are entering into nearby villages and he requested the company authorities for solar fencing should be made all in and around the village areas. Awareness programme related to environment, pollution and clean environment should be carried out in local villages to educate people regarding importance of the environment. He raised the concerned regarding kidney related disease are aggravating in the local area. He demanded that, the company should give more attention towards vocational training, education, health, environment etc. for the benefit of the local people.</p>
10.	<p><u>Sri Sarbeswar Biswal, Chintapokhari:</u> He requested to Additional District Magistrate, Dhenkanal that development of hospital facility at village level and engagement of more doctors in Meramandali hospital. He questioned about lack vocational knowledge among the students as many private schools, colleges and engineering institutions are opened. He requested the company authorities to implement CSR activities at Panachayat level and he also emphasized that land losers should get employment. He also agreed for the expansion of the company but demand to fulfil the assurance of local people.</p>
11.	<p><u>Sri Malaya Samal, Kochilamada:</u> Rungta is a big and good company. This company is doing all peripheral activities for the villagers. He requested the company authorities and District Administration to provide drinking water, school, road construction and medical facility at village. We all are happy with Rungta Company. Every time Rungta Company is helping us. We will give our consent to Rungta Company not any other company.</p>

12.	<p><u>Sri Dushmanta Gadnayak, Chardagadia:</u> He informed that, during 2004 Rungta Company had purchased land and also given his land to the company. Rungta had encroached 18 decimals malafidely. He demanded the establishment of medical, appointment of teachers in the school, supply of drinking water to local villagers.</p>
13.	<p><u>Smt Binodini Behera, Kangelpal:</u> She demanded before the Company authority for qualification-based employment to the SHG groups, women and land losers, proper compensation to the land losers and appointment of staff nurse in Meramandali hospital.</p>
14.	<p><u>Sri. Chagala Behera, Kochilamada:</u> He requested the District Administration to facilitate school, medical and peripheral development and drinking water also. He demanded the employment and rehabilitation for land losers but he also supports the expansion project.</p>
15.	<p><u>Sri Jatakrushna Nayak, Charadgadia:</u> He stated that in the first phase of the company he has given 10 Acers of land to the company and demanded for actual compensation from the company. He also expressed that after getting compensation for first phase of land, he will give next land to the Rungta company.</p>
16.	<p><u>Sri Gyanendra Sahoo, Motanga:</u> He welcomed the expansion of the company. He informed that, Rungta Company has been executing so many CSR work like peripheral developmental work in villages. Also the people of nearby villages are supporting the developmental activities of the company. He also requested the company authority to provide compensation, education and health facility to land losers.</p>
17.	<p><u>Sri Malaya Pradhan, Motanga:</u> He introduced himself as a land loser of Rungta Mines Company in Tulasidiha. He has dedicated myself when the company was started. Not only in past, but we will support the company also in present and future. Today, it is a small plant, when there will be extension it would be a big plant and provide facility of employment, development and involvement in other CSR activities. Let the expansion be approved. We will support the same.</p>
18.	<p><u>Sri Chandra Sekhar Samal,Charadagadia:</u> Rungta Company is going to establish 150 MW Power Plant for which we are welcoming the project. So the company will facilitate our people employment, financial assistance etc. The company should provide in the field of Employment, health, and supply of pure drinking water. We are welcoming the expansion of the plant.</p>

19.	<p><u>Sri Purna Chandra Nayak, Charadagadia:</u> In 2006 from SC category people about 16 to 17 Acres of land has been taken but there is no employment and rehabilitation to the land losers till date. By the help of hooligans they are suppressing our grievance. They will not provide land once again to company.</p>
20.	<p><u>Smt Chekei Samal, Kochilamada:</u> She expressed that the company should provide every facilities to physically handicapped people, widows and uneducated people, so that they can provide land to the company.</p>
21.	<p><u>Sri Ratnakar Gadanaik, Charadagadia:</u> He deliberated that, whatever facilities extended by Rungta Company; the same has not been extended by Bhusan and Nava Bharat company etc. Employment and drinking water are being provided in Charadagadia and Kochilamada village. 90% of the land has been taken by the company for the power plant. People are ready to provide rest 5% of land to company. The company has developed not only for the people but also construction and repairs the institutions like temple in Charadagadia and Kochilamada village.</p>
22.	<p><u>Sri Tapas Kumar Pradhan, Motanga:</u> He informed that his residence is nearby to Rungta Company at Motanga. He is positive towards the activities done by Rungta company such supply of drinking water. He has further, requested to provide an employment to all irrespective of land losers and also vocational training should be given to local villagers.</p>
23.	<p><u>Smt Puspalata Behera, Sarapanch, Motanga GP:</u> She expressed her support for expansion project and requested to provide supply drinking water to all.</p>
24.	<p><u>Smt Banita Samal, Kochilamada:</u> She expressed her complete support to the company and its expansion.</p>
25.	<p><u>Smt Biral Samal, Kochilamada:</u> She supported the project and also requested before the company authority to support women and SHG groups.</p>
26.	<p><u>Smt Susila Samal, Kochilamada:</u> She informed that, since last three years developmental work is going on, therefore permission should be given for power plant by which Government will be benefited. The company should provide facilities like employment and health facilities for the local people.</p>
27.	<p><u>Sri Subash Chandra Behera, Motanga:</u> He informed that, the company is providing everything in his Panchayat and also provided school rooms, boundary and water facility. He has requested for some peripheral development, road construction and light facilities before the company authority.</p>


28.	<u>Sri Sibadutta Das, Motanga:</u> He supported the expansion of the Company. He has demanded to provide qualification based employment to the local people, utilization of CSR funds, establishment medical, playground and open gym in the village.
29.	<u>Smt Runu Rani Sahoo, Motanga:</u> She stated that, If the company expands, it will increase the source of income and chance for engagement of unemployed youth will increase. She expected that if the company will expand, our area will be improved. She said that, the company should be given the permission to expand.
30.	<u>Smt Priyatama Sahoo, Motanga:</u> She has agreed and supported the expansion of the company and showed her willing to give land to the company authority.
31.	<u>Sri Tuna Swain, Suravi:</u> He expressed his dissatisfaction and stated that there is a shortage of teacher in village school, no doctors in medical and also no water supply facility in the village. He informed that the companies are not listening to their problems. Hence, he has requested before the Rungta Company to facilitate medical, school, water supply facility for the local people.
32.	<u>Smt Supriya Sahoo, Nagari:</u> She expressed her views and said that company should go for expansion proposal.
33.	<u>Sri Manas Mahakud, Sarapanch, Sibapur GP:</u> He requested the company authority for expansion and should focus on providing an employment of local youth in the proposed project and imparting tailoring training for SSG groups.
34.	<u>Smt. Sushama Sahoo, Meramandali:</u> She expressed her complete support for expansion of the proposed project.
35.	<u>Sri Bijay Kumar Rout, Charadagadia:</u> He mainly raised concern over the local employment issues, medical facility, appointment of teachers in village school. Finally, he expressed his complete support for expansion of the proposed project.
36.	<u>Sri Prahalad Mahakud, Charadagadia:</u> He expressed his complete support for expansion of the proposed project and has demanded for construction of road, appointment of teachers in school and supply of drinking water in the village.
37.	<u>Sri Ranjit Sahoo, Motanga:</u> He raised various issues like road, communication, water, employment before the company authority and finally informed that if the company authority gets approval for expansion, then the local people will get more employment opportunity in the proposed expansion project.

Summary of the points raised by the participants in the public hearing are being read out by Regional Officer and same in English and Odia (vernacular language) is enclosed as **Annexure-IV (A & B)**.

On behalf of the project proponent, Sri Jayanta Kumar Panda, (Plant - Head), representative of the industry has responded on the issues raised by the participants during public hearing and the same in English and Odia (vernacular language) are also given in **Annexure-V (A&B)**. The video recording of the entire proceeding of the public hearing is enclosed as Compact Disc (CD). During public hearing, 25 nos. of written applications were received which are enclosed as **Annexure-VI**.
