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**PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING FOR BAITARANI SAND BED, TUKUNA OF SRI RAMESH CHANDRA SAHOO OVER AN AREA OF 7.155 HA. AT VILLAGE TUKUNA UNDER ANANDPUR TAHASIL OF KEONJHAR DISTRICT HELD ON 02.05.2023 AT 11.00 AM AT VILLAGE TUKUNA KHATA NO. 108, PLOT NO. 430 & 431, KISSAM- GRAMYA JUNGLE, PROPOSED AREA- AC.1.06 IN THE KEONJHAR DISTRICT.**

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 02.05.2023 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in nearby villages of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate

Er P Kar, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Smt. Susama Bilung, OAS(S), Additional District Magistrate, Keonjhar presided over and supervised the public hearing. She briefed about the importance and objectives of such hearing and invited the project proponent to highlight on proposed project.

Sri Pabitra Kumar Swain (Consultant), Representative of the Project Proponent explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the Project.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Keonjhar.

**1. Sri Balaram Jena, Tukuna**

Sri Jena supported the public hearing and said that he has no objection for commencement of proposed Sand Extraction in their area. He stated that everybody of their village will be benefited by extraction of sand at their own area and they can purchase sand at a cheaper rate. Moreover, the PM Awas beneficiaries will be able to get sand in reasonable price for construction of their houses.

**2. Sri Nirakar Behera, Hatibandha**

Sri Behera while supporting the public hearing stated that they will be benefitted by the extraction of sand at their area, be it construction of house or other developmental jobs. Presently, they are facing acute shortage of sand. So, he requested the administration to give permission to stop sand extraction in their area.

**3. Sri Jay Prakash Dash, Tukuna**

Sri Dash wholeheartedly supported the proposed Sand Bed mining. He said that once the proposed sand bed mining starts the poor people can get sand in cheap rate for construction of their house under PM Awas Yojana. Presently they are procuring sand from outside at considerably very high rate. So he requested to grant permission for smooth operation of the sand bed.

**4. Sri Narayan Das, Tukuna**

Sri Das stated that during last 50 years no extraction of sand was done in their area. He said as they are poor people the villagers do all sorts of their last rites, rituals and other social day to day activities in the proposed sand bed mining area. He demanded if mining will be carried out it should be done far away from the area which they are using and the lessee have to pay

Rs.50,000/- and shall provide one toilet for each house, then only the lessee can do mining in the proposed area.

**5. Sri Jayanta Jena, Guhalia**

Sri Jena wholeheartedly supported the proposed Sand Bed Mining. He said that once the proposed sand bed mining starts the poor people can get sand in cheap rate for construction of their house under PM Awas Yojana. Presently they are procuring sand from outside at considerably very high rate.

**6. Sri Chandramani Naik, Tukuna**

Sri Naik while supporting the public hearing requested to look after their issues as they are facing difficulties in getting sand at their village.

**7. Sri Premananda Mallick, Tukuna**

Sri Mallick while supporting the public hearing requested to extract sand a little away from the Ghat of the proposed sand bed mining area as the villagers are carrying out all sorts of day to day activities on the river bed. He also stressed to commence the proposed sand extraction as in absence of the local sand bed mining, they are compelled to purchase sand from outside in high price.

**8. Sri Sadananda Jena, Bailo GP, Ward Member, Ward No.17**

Sri Jena while supporting the public hearing expressed that by opening of this sand bed mining some poor people will be benefited for purchasing sand in reasonable price so that they can do construction of their house under PM Awas Yojana.

**9. Sri Akshaya Das, Tukuna**

Sri Das stated that lots of turmoil, police case etc took place for this sand bed mining and still some unscrupulous persons with vested interest instigated them to stop the sand bed auction process for with he has requested administration to commence the sand bed extraction job at the earliest at all costs.

**10. Sri Santosh Kumar Jena, Guhalia**

Sri Jena expressed his consent to start the sand bed mining so that they can get sand in cheap rate. Due to absence of local sand extraction job they became compelled to purchase sand in very high rate. At the same time, he told that they will raise object in case any other person extract sand mix with soil and requested the Tahasildar to take appropriate action against the culprit.

**11. Sri Bijay Kumar Jena, Khadbil, Bailo G.P**

Sri Bijay said that he has no objection for extraction of sand from the proposed sand bed mining through which many poor people will be benefitted. They can get sand at a cheaper rate for construction of their house.

**12. Sri Hiranya Das, Tukuna, Bailo G.P**

Sri Das stated that he was trapped by some unscrupulous people from outside village in turmoil. As a result, police case was filed against him and he was jailed for 6-7 days without doing any nuisance. His son and his brother was also taken to jail custody. So, now he wants that as he was

jailed forcefully for no reason, likewise the proposed sand bed should extract sand powerfully be there any law or without any law.

**13. Sri Tapan Kumar Das, Ward Member, Bailo G.P**

Sri Das welcomed the proposed sand bed mining because in past they faced lots of difficulties for purchasing sand in abnormally high rate. As a result, it has become very difficult for them to construct a house as they are very poor. So he requested the villagers to give support for smooth operation of the sand bed.

**14. Sri Narayan Jena, Bailo GP, Ward Member, Ward No.6**

Sri Jena while supporting the public hearing stated that once this proposed sand bed mining starts the poor people will be benefitted for purchasing sand in cheap price and construct their houses under PM Awas Yoyona. They are facing difficulties for purchasing sand in very high rate and even sometimes they are not getting sand for which the poor people are unable to construct their houses.

**15. Sri Pradeep Kumar Sahoo, Ward Member, Bailo GP, Ward No.6**

Sri Pradeep while supporting the public hearing requested to provide sand at a cheaper rate for the local people of Bailo & Tukuna.

**16. Sri Harihar Barik, Hatibandha**

Sri Barik welcomed the proposed sand bed mining and said that people are facing lots of difficulties for purchasing sand in abnormally high rate for construction of their houses under "Biju Pucca Ghara". As a result, it has become very difficult for them to construct a house as they are very poor. So if the sand bed operates then the poor people will be benefitted by this proposed sand bed mining.

**17. Sri Deepak Kumar Mallik, Tukuna**

Sri Mallik while supporting the public hearing stated that he has no objection for operation of proposed sand bed mining. He demanded that their road should be maintained on a regular basis to avoid formation of potholes and dust to be controlled by sprinkling water on the road. Due to bad road condition particularly school going children & pregnant women will face lots of difficulties.

**18. Smt. Anjali Naik, Tukuna**

Smt. Naik while supporting the public hearing stated that she has no objection for extraction of sand from the sand bed but demanded to provide all sorts of facilities to them. They lessee should look after all the issues of the villagers and shall take risk for any miss happenings that may occur due to sand mining.

**19. Smt. Pramila Naik, Tukuna**

Smt. Naik while supporting the public hearing and proposed sand bed mining, told that the lessee should provide all sorts of facilities to the villagers and no sand transportation should be allowed in their village road.

**20. Smt. Kuni Naik, Tukuna**

Smt. Kuni told that they won't let any sand loaded vehicle to ply from their village road as there is threat to the life of their children. She also said that sand mining may take place but they won't

let them extract sand from their Ghat used by the villagers and no sand transportations will be carried in the village road.

**21. Smt. Rasmita Naik, Tukuna**

Smt. Rasmita said that they won't let any sand loaded vehicle to ply from their village road. She warned for dire consequences if any vehicle will ply in their village road. She also demanded if the sand bed operates safety of school going children should be taken care of.

**22. Sri Pradeep Jena, Tukuna**

Sri Jena supported the public hearing and demanded to ensure the road should be in good condition always and requested to let the villagers know the safety zone distance of sand mining from their road.


**23. Sri Purushottam Mishra, Tukuna**

Sri Mishra while supporting the public hearing demanded for extraction of sand by maintaining a safety distance from the road and the ghat. At the same he requested to give attention for better road condition that should be safe for school going children and pregnant women. At last he said that sand bed shall operate by adopting environment protection measures.

The Regional Officer, SPCB, Keonjhar read over the issues raised by the public in the hearing. Sri Pabitra Kumar Swain (Consultant), Representative of the Project Proponent responded to the issues raised. Smt. Susama Bilung, OAS(S), Additional District Magistrate, Keonjhar gave concluding remarks of the Hearing.

The issues raised by the public and corresponding comments of the applicant were prepared in Odia and English and it is annexed with the proceedings as Annexure I & II respectively, list of the oral deliberators and participants in the hearing is annexed as Annexure III & IV respectively. The videography of proceedings are recorded and submitted as DVD (I).
