

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF MAHADEIPUR/ BUGUDA & BADADEULA SAND BED CLUSTER FOR EXPLOITATION OF RIVER SAND PRODUCTION OF 13000 CUM/ YEAR OVER AN AREA OF 17.179 HA IN VILLAGE MAHADEIPUR/ BUGUDA & BADADEULA UNDER PARALAKHEMUNDI TEHSIL IN THE DISTRICT OF GAJAPATI HELD ON 16.09.2023 AT 11.00 A.M. IN GRAM PANCHAYAT OFFICE, MADHUSUDANPUR VILLAGE OF GAJAPATI DISTRICT

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on **16.09.2023** as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in village Mahadeipur/ Buguda & Badadeula under Paralakhemundi Tehsil area of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Sri Ashok Kumar Bhoi, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Rayagada welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Sri Birendra Kumar Das, OAS (SAG), Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Gajapati highlighted on importance of such hearing & presided over the public hearing.

Sri Sameer Kumar Sahu, Env Consultant on behalf of Mahadeipur/ Buguda & Badadeula Sand Bed Cluster has explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the Project.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rayagada.

1. Sri P Trinath Rao, Routhpur

Sri Rao highlighted on issues on proposed impact of sand mining related to river depth, widening of river bank, effect on water table due to lift irrigation, deterioration of agricultural land, agricultural problem, problems faced by farmers, illegal sand transportation through tractors to Andhra in night hour, issues related to sound pollution and air pollution due to transportation of sand, etc. He urged for following the due procedure while river sand mining. He also requested the authority to plan for stone pitching work along the both side of river bank to prevent the deterioration of nearby agricultural land with the river due to sand mining and in case of flood situation. He also demanded for maintenance of approach road to Mahadeipur which is the main transportation route of sand shifting. He gave a representation to the panel.

2. Sri L Basudev, Battisiripur

Sri Basudev reflect about the issue pertaining today night illegal sand lifting and shifting from the river to outside state. He gave a representation to the panel.

3. Sri P Jotiswar, TS Pur

Sri Jotiswar supported in favour of the sand mining project of G Venkata Ramana.

4. Sri P Russi, Battisiripur

Sri Russi supported in favour of the sand mining project of G Venkata Ramana.

5. Sri Pandit Jena, Badadeula

Sri Jena supported in favour of the sand mining project of G Venkata Ramana.

6. Sri Laxmikanta Sabar, Mahadeipur

11. Sri P Satya Narayan, Battisiripur


Sri Narayan highlighted on different issues on sand mining related to air pollution, water pollution, road problem, non-following due procedure in sand mining as per Govt guideline, scarcity of sand for use in Indira Awas Yozana & local house construction, illegal sand transportation to outside state, adverse effect on widening of river bank due to sand mining, non-utilization of sand mining revenue in the affected village, etc. He requested the authority to give priority on river bank plantation in Battisiripur village to protect the bank of river from deterioration.



01	Effect on Water table due to sand mining subsequently create problem in lift irrigation	Project Proponent committed to carry out Sand mining from the river bed as per the Sustainable Sand Mining Management Guideline of the Govt.
02	River Bank erosion problem due to sand mining	Project Proponent committed to maintain safe distance from the river bank to carry out sand mining in the allotted lease area. Further, Planation will be done as per the scheme of mining plan along the river bank to protect from soil erosion.
03	Damaging of road due to sand transportation	Project Proponent committed to maintain the sand transportation road in good condition on priority basis.
04	Issue pertaining to air pollution	Project Proponent committed to carry out dust suppression along the sand transportation route by deploying mobile water tanker. Further, tractors engaged in sand transportation will be ensured for complete tarpaulin covering and overloading will be avoided to prevent from the spillage of sand on the road.
05	Issue pertaining to noise pollution	Project Proponent committed to comply the provisions of Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules while sand mining.
06	Issue pertaining to water pollution	Sand mining will be carried out as per the Govt Guideline so that no water will be polluted.
07	Peripheral local development	Peripheral development will be done as per Government Guideline.
08	Protection of Green Vegetation	Planation will be done as per the scheme of mining plan for further protection of green vegetation.

NOTICE

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It is brought to the notice of all concerned that Sri. G. Venkata Ramana has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for Mahadeipur/Buguda & Badadeula Sand Bed cluster (Submitted under cluster approach with total area of 17.179 ha, consisting of 2 nos. of Sand Quarries) over an area of 17.179 ha. in village Mahadeipur/Buguda & Badadeula under Parakakhemundi tehsil of Gajapati district to obtain Environmental Clearance from State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha. The proponent has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for a Public Hearing.

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India Notification No. S.O. 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006, the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site/sites of displacement/sites likely to be affected. For the above purpose, a person will only mean:

- A. Any person who is likely to be affected by the grant of Environmental Clearance.
- B. Any person who owns his control over the project with respect to which an application has been submitted for environmental clearance.
- C. Any association of persons whether incorporated or likely to be affected by the project and /or functioning in the field of environment.
- D. Any local authority within any part of whose local limits is within the neighborhood wherein the project is proposed to be located.

Persons as above who desire to submit their views, comments, objections etc. relevant to the project, may do so in writing within 30 days from the date of publication of this notice addressing the same to the Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha through Registered Post. Besides this, persons interested to submit their views relevant to the proposed mining project in writing or orally may also do so during the public hearing to be conducted on 16.09.2023 at 11.00 AM in the Gram Panchayat Office of Madhusudanpur, under Parakakhemundi tehsil of Gajapati district.
