PROCEEDINGS OF PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 04.10.2023 (11.00 AM), AT-DANAGADI BHAWAN, DANAGADI OF JAJPUR DISTRICT FOR GREEN FIELD PROJECT FOR PRODUCTION OF 0.5 MTPA ROLLED PRODUCT PROPOSED BY M/S BEEKAY UTKAL STEEL PVT. LTD. OVER AN AREA OF 26.248 Ha., AT KALINIGANAGAR INDUSTRIAL ESTATE IN MOUZA JAKHAPURA AND DASMANIA UNDER DANAGADI TAHASIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT.

The public hearing in respect of the project proposed by M/S Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. for Greenfield project for production of 0.5 MTPA rolled products over an area of 26.248 ha. was held on scheduled date & time At- Danagadi Bhawan, Tahasil-Danagadi in the district of Jajpur with reference to:

- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006
- II. Interim Operational Guidelines till 13th September 2007 in respect of applications made under EIA-1994

The Panel consisted of the following members:

- 1. Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, Jajpur
- Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board,
 Odisha, Kalinganagar.

The public hearing process was supervised & presided by Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, Jajpur and assisted by Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar welcomed the members participated in the meeting and gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by M/S Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd.

Welcoming the public, Sri S.K. Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about

the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public.

On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Manas Kara, representative of Visiontek Consultancy Services Pvt. Ltd. addressed the committee members and assembled public and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme, environmental management and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. Mr. Basant Kumar Rout (Jakhapura G.P)

He greeted the panel member and gathering. He requested ADM, Kalinganagar for local employment, engagement of local contractors during the plant civil construction phase. He also urged for the detail CSR activities to be implemented in affected villages of the kalinganagar should be addressed in the gathering. He suggested to do plantations in order to maintain the balance between air, water & environment. Again he requested the representative of the M/S Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. to look into the concerns over the local employment, transportation & engagement of local contractors during the plant civil construction phase. Lastly he expressed his support to the project.

2. Mr. Dilip Kumar Nayak (Jakhapura G.P)

He greeted the panel member and welcomed the gathering. He expressed his concern over the five nos. of villages to be affected due to the establishment of the project, so he requested to give importance on locals interest towards employment and other issues. By mentioning road dust issues, he indicated that the industry should focus on the above issue to reduce pollution-related problems.

3. Mr. Ajay Kumar Mohanty (Jakhapura G.P)

He addressed the panel member. He wanted to know about the amenities that people will receive in exchange for the lost land they had, as the project has

taken over the ownership. He requested to clarify the plantation details and its implementation procedures to be followed for the proposed proposal. He highlighted that five nos. of affected villages are willing to assist in all plant activities, but in exchange, he was seeking for commitment of employment, contractor work, and if any benefits for farmers. He requested everyone to support the government.

4. Mr. Somarendra Ghadai (Manatira G.P)

He greeted the panel members. He urged that local villagers should be given the priority to engage in service. Lastly he concluded that the growth of industry reflects the prosperity of nation.

5. Mr. Sudam Charan Nayak (Golagaon G.P)

He greeted the panel member and gathering. He supported the government project by singing poetry to the gathering. He expressed his concern over the status of village chandia where 70% of population are remaining poor even if they have welcomed many industries through public hearing. So, he requested for equal share in contractor work, employment & social development with five nos. of villages.

6. Mr. Kaylash Chandra Jena (Jakhapura G.P)

He expressed his support towards M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. He made a request for the former speaker's demands to be fulfilled.

7. Mr. Trilochan Dhal (Jakhapura G.P)

He greeted the panel member and welcomed the gathering. He expressed his support towards M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. and asked for generating local jobs and involvement of five nos. of villagers in the development activities.

8. Mr. Kalandi Chandra Sethi (Jakhapura G.P)

He greeted the panel member and gathering. He requested everyone to support the M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. project as growth of industry reflects the prosperity of the Nation. In return the industry should look into the employment concerns in the four villages. He demanded that pollution measures should be well addressed as this place as the Kalinganagar area became an industrial cluster. Lastly he urged that this type of industries should give the locals amenities through providing drinking water.

9. Mr. Tanuj Ghadai (Mantira G.P)

He greeted the panel member and gathering. He supported the M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. project. He demanded for his villagers to get ample opportunity of employment.

10. Mr. Deepak Mohanty (Jakhapura G.P)

He greeted the everyone. He requested plant authority to clarify the numbers of permanent employees to be posted and contractual employment for the proposed project. He also wanted to know the percentage of permanent employment fulfilled from the local employment i.e particularly from Jakhapura panchayat. He urged for emphasizing of the environment, hiring locals for permanent positions and engaging local contractors in the plant's civil phase construction. Finally, he supported the proposed project.

11. Mrs. Puspalata Ghadai (Mantira G.P)

She greeted everyone. She demanded that local employment in her village of Patharagadia should be considered and asked for hiring of people with the appropriate educational backgrounds.

12. Mr. Abhisek Samal (Jakhapura G.P)

He greeted everyone. He welcomed the project and claimed that the commitment assured by the project proponent was not being implemented. He requested for providing permanent employment for locals and look into the local environment.

13. Mrs. Jayanti Mallick (P.S Member, Mantira G.P)

She greeted everyone. She requested for providing employment.

14. Mr. Subrat Kumar Singh (Mantira G.P)

He greeted everyone. He requested for taking care for the environment and also demanded for providing local employment.

15. Mr. Ashis Kumar Sundarray (Pankapal G.P)

He was concerned for the unemployment, environment degradation & plantation in his village area and seeks proper solution to mitigate the above issue.

16. Mr. Chandan Patra (Dasamania G.P)

He greeted everyone & expressed his support to the project. He was concerned that the nearby villages should be recruited as local workers for plant activities.

17. Mrs. Renubala Pradhan (Telibahali G.P)

She greeted the panel member and gathering. She shared her experience mentioning that she was aware of the public hearing commitments made by the industries in the past. However the employment in her neighborhood villages has not benefited. She asked that local employment possibilities and peripheral development projects should be given priority. Lastly she welcomed the project.

18. Mr. Krushna Chandra Pal (Mantira G.P)

He greeted everyone & expressed his support to the project. He urged that local employment prospects should be followed based on their educational backgrounds and expressed his concern about pollution control measures and asked the plant authority to follow the Rules and Regulations of the Pollution Control Board.

19. Mr. Deepesh Kumar Ghadai (Sarpanch, Mantira G.P)

He expressed his support to M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. Project. He told the plant authority to focus on two things: employment and taking adequate precautions to mitigate environmental pollutions.

20. Mr. Pandu Singh Khuntia (Sarpanch, Chandia G.P)

He greeted everyone & expressed his full support to M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. project. He requested that the agreements made in the memorandum between the company and the state government should be carried out. Additionally, he requested that the district administration should focus the five nos. of villages on top priority basis when hiring contractors and providing employment. He also highlighted that activities for peripheral development must be equally shared between chandia panchayat and other panchayats.

21. Mr. Budhiram Jarika (Samiti Sabhya, Chandia G.P)

He greeted everyone & expressed his support to the project. He demanded the plant authority to provide jobs or other works in development projects.

22. Mr. Pradeep Kumar Behera (Chandia G.P)

He greeted everyone & expressed his support to the project.

23. Mr. Pratap Kumar Natia (Golagaon G.P)

He greeted everyone & welcomed M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. project. He requested for local employment and contractor work during construction phase.

He opposed the M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. project because there are no facilities available for water supply to the affected villagers, even though already established of plant clusters have not fulfilled the same.

26. Mr. Umesh Chandra Khilar (Manitra G.P)

He greeted the panel member and gathering. He asked for fulfilling the commitments of providing employment, contract work for locals & peripheral development of nearby villages.

27. Mr. Avisanta Ray (Pankapal G.P)

He greeted everyone & supported M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. project. He asked for the appropriate action to be taken in the direction of pollution control measures, local opportunities, and contract work for locals.

28. Mr. Biswajit Nayak (Jakhapura G.P)

He asked M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. to provide information regarding CSR fund expenditure for development work from the project cost and suggested to give importance to the local employment.

29. Mr. Bhaskar Satapathy (Pankapal G.P)

He greeted everyone & expressed his support towards M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. project. He asked M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. authority to provide local opportunities equally to the five villages and to prioritize environmental concerns.

30. Mr. Manmath Satpathy (Pankapal G.P)

He greeted everyone & expressed his full supported towards M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. project. He asked M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. authority to provide local opportunities & contract work for locals equally to the five villages.

31. Mr. Dillip Kumar Samal (Pankapal G.P)

He greeted everyone & expressed his full supported towards M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. project. By expressing his fear, he mentioned that as the number of plants increased in Kalinganagar area, so there would be significant increase in pollution load. The responsible authority must regulate how the pollution potential for this specific plant shall be controlled. He believed that there could be significant problems with the discharge of plant waste water due to the plant's proposed location being near to a natural runoff and passed by the villages of Chasia, Manitira, Jakhapura, and Umira Panchayat. Therefore, the plant wastewater discharged must be restricted to natural runoff contamination as this natural flow is utilized in various ways by the five panchayats. Finally he suggested that afforestation to be done with regard to the land acquired by the industry.

32. Mr. Priyabarta Lenka (Pankapal G.P)

He greeted everyone & expressed his full support towards M/s Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. Project.

The Panel has received 01 no. of written representation during the hearing which is enclosed herewith in original those have been annexed. Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar asked the project proponent to present their comments to the people with respect to the demands raised by the public in the public hearing meeting. Mr. Surath Satpathy, representative of M/S Beekay Utkal Steel Pvt. Ltd. made the commitment on issued raised by the public. 
