

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING FOR KHANJAMAHAL STONE QUARRIES UNDER CLUSTER (61 QUARRIES) PROPOSED BY TAHASILDAR, SORO OVER AN AREA OF 98.94 Ha (BEARING KHATA NO.144 AND PLOT NO.161,165,164,318,168,167,166, 287, 264, 265 &263) IN VILLAGE KHANJAMAHAL AND MAHUMUHAN UNDER SORO TAHASIL OF BALASORE DISTRICT HELD ON 11.12.2023 AT 11.00 AM IN THE PREMISES OF GP OFFICE OF MAHUMUHAN UNDER SORO TEHSIL, DISTRICT BALASORE

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 11.12.2023 as per scheduled time and venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regards to date, place and time was published in Daily News Paper on dated 09.11.2023 and was also announced through Public Address System in surrounding villages of proposed project site on dated 09.12.2023. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

The panel consisted the following members:

Smt. Priyadarshinee Mallick, Addl. District Magistrate, Balasore supervised and presided over the Public Hearing process and was assisted by Er. Manmohan Murmu, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Balasore the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members and the public participated in public hearing, Er. Manmohan Murmu, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Balasore gave brief introduction about the objectives, process & procedures followed for the public hearing in light of EIA Notification, 2006 and amendment thereof in respect of Khanjamahal Stone Quarry at Khanjamahal & Mahumuhan village under Soro Tahasil in Balasore district.

Welcoming the public, Smt. Mallick, Addl. District Magistrate, Balasore welcomed the public and explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. She asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public.

Sri Ashwani Kumar Naik, Tahasildar, Soro briefed about the proposed project and importance for protection of local environment and Sri Binay Kumar Swain, Consultant for Kahanjamahal Stone Quarries explained detail about the proposed stone quarries and briefed about the pollution control measures to be adopted in the project.

Smt. Mallick, Addl. District Magistrate, Balasore requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project. The views expressed by the speakers on the proposed project are as follows.

1. Sri Akhilaram Jena, President, Jiban Jibika Samitee, Khanjamahal, Soro, Balasore

Sri Jena intruding himself brought the knowledge of the district administration that many poor people are living in that area. Odisha Government has not established any industry in the area for which people have no alternative livelihood except stone quarry related activity in Khanjamahal Quarry. He highlighted that people of the area not only excavate stone from the quarry but also have role in development in coastal area also. He informed that when tender will be floated anybody from Odisha can participate for the auction and people of the area will not be benefitted. Hence, he insisted to keep 40% of the quarry reserved for the local people. He suggested the loading of the trucks/dumper to be restricted to 18-20 MT keeping carrying capacity of the Khanjamahal Bagudi RD Road and Bagudi to Soro PWD road. He said that covering of vehicle with tarpaulin and speed limit of 20 kmph as decided earlier in a meeting at Soro Police Station shall be strictly followed. He suggested the Soro-Bagudi road to expanded to 2 lane road. All the officials present at the public hearing must have realised the bad condition of the Soro-Bagudi road. He requested the State Government through Addl. District Magistrate sought of issue on priority basis and complete the Soro-Bagudi road with 2 lanes expeditiously. He expressed that money collected under DMF has not been utilized in their area fully and remarkable development has not been done in the area. He requested for adequate plantation and sapling distribution for protection of environment of the area. He requested the administration to keep vigil keeping public interest as due to some vested interest people all the vehicles' owners are blamed. He urged the Khanjamahal Quarry to be operated till industry are established in the area and livelihood of poor people is not protected. At last, he thanked the chair and gathering and concluded his speech.

2. Sri Smruti Ranjan Mahanty, President, Soro Truck Association, Soro

Sri Mahanty put following demand before the District Administration for consideration.

1. Local employment should not be affected
2. The demanded the owners of stone quarries to plant trees and develop vegetation to prevent flying of the dust during operation of quarry, excavation and plying of vehicles
3. He instructed the Association to be careful while loading as per load carrying capacity of the road and requested the District Administration to be alert in the matter
4. He suggested 30% proposed quarry to be given to local people because if big industries take control of the quarry, then local people will be affected and there will be threat to livelihood of the people as the area is Adivasi dominant area and they depend their livelihood upon manual stone breaking. He also suggested 30% quarry operation should be carried out manually instead of mechanical method for protection of bread and butter of the local poor people
5. Mining activity should be undertaken keeping peripheral development such as Hospital, Educational Institute & Communication in the area. He also suggested

the district administration to give importance to Health and Drinking Water facility in the area as it belong to stone quarry area. He also demanded establishment of upgraded health care facility for the projected affected people and requested DMF utilisation should be done in project affected area. He further insisted the administration to focus on environment protection and prevention of associated problems of stone quarrying

3. Sri Chakradhara Giri, Mahumuhan, Soro, Balasore

Sri Giri welcoming the chair placed following demand during his speech

1. 1/3rd of the proposed and operating quarry should be reserved for local people and affected people should be given opportunity for participating in auction
2. There shall not be disturbance of local employment
3. Fugitive dust emitted during quarry activity and plying of vehicle on the road should be mitigated
4. Vehicle movement should be regulated as per load carrying capacity of the road
5. Care should be taken to prevent damage of local infrastructure due to operation of stone quarries
6. The drilling and blasting should be carried out in controlled manner.
7. At least one quarry should be operated following manual mining method for earning of the local workers and nurturing their family
8. There shall be peripheral development in health, education, drinking water and communication
9. DMF should be utilised in project affected area
10. He demanded dedication towards fulfilment of the above demand

4. Sri Bidyadhara Sahu, Mahumuhan, Soro, Balasore

Sri Sahu informed that 5 nos. of Advasi villages exist at the foothill of Khanjamahal-Mahumuhan Hill at the distance of 300 meter and other 3 nos. of village in the nearby area. He highlighted the damages caused due to blasting in the quarry. He also informed that the local people are facing health issues due emission generated from plastic and there is also causality for this blasting. He enquired where about of DMF utilisation. He informed that there is scarcity of doctor in the area and he expressed his anguishes where people will for treatment in case of injury due to quarry activity. He demanded health and wellness of the local people.

5. Sri Rajesh Mohapatra, Manatri, Soro, Balasore

Sri Mohapatra introducing himself greeted the chair and the gathering. He expressed recalling his childhood memory that how stone from the area is utilised in the development work not only in neighbouring 3 district but also in whole state of Odisha. He informed that from the worker/labourer to vehicle owner all depends upon stone quarry for their livelihood. He urged the people to be careful about pollution or any other harm happening in the area. He requested the

government to operate the stone quarry to safeguard their earning and livelihood and development of the road.

6. **Sri Achyuta Nanda Jena, Representative of Sarpanch, Bagudi, Soro, Balasore**

Sri Jena read out the demand of local people during his speech which is reproduced as follows. He highlighted 30% population of the area's poor people are working since last 70 years in the stone quarry for their livelihood and maintenance of their families which and this activity is being practiced from generation to generation. In this juncture he enquired feasibility of giving lease to wealthy people.

1. He placed demand of the inhabitant of the area that 40% lessee should be preferably given to local people.
2. 2 to 3 out of the total quarries to be kept under supervision of Tahasildar instead of including in Mining Act. Arrangement should be made so that the Tahasildar can lease out these 2 to 3 quarries to the manual stone breaker.
3. He demanded to protect environment and control pollution through road side plantation and greenbelt development in the forest and barren land through social forestry.
4. He requested development of school, hospital, community centre and drinking water facility and to give importance of health service through Social Responsibility apprehending arise of disease and accident like health issues due to large quarry active area.

He concluded his speech with hope from the concerned department towards fulfilment of the above valid demand.

7. **Sri Basant Kumar Nayak, Manatri, Soro, Balasore**

Sri Nayak welcomed the chair and the public. He informed that some quarries were in operation earlier but due to some issues there is difficulty in lease out of the quarries for which 61 quarries could not have been leased out. He said that Mahumuhan Panchayat is Adivasi area and poor people of the area are depending on stone quarry since long. He requested the administration to facilitate operation of the stone quarry so that people will get job. He demanded engagement of local people in the quarry. He requested to administration to take action towards mitigation of fugitive dust generation due to mining activity and plying of vehicles. He also hi-lighted the need of plying vehicle on road as per load carrying capacity. He expressed demand of the local people about manual mining in the quarries to create employment opportunity. He also requested for peripheral development and utilisation of DMF in the area in welfare activity. He emphasised the environment protection for wellness.

8. **Sri Anadi Samal, Sarpanch, Singa Khunta, Soro, Balasore**

Sri Samal greeted the public and the explained his childhood situation in that area and compared his panchayat area with the Mahumuhan area. He expressed that, other three Panchayat follow the development of Mahumuhan panchayat

and informed that, adivasi people were breaking stone in the hill during his childhood period getting livelihood. He further informed that, development of Mahamuhan panchayat has not been happened at par with other areas of Odisha. He again informed that due to use of machine in stone quarry for more production, earning of the retailer of 03 GP has increased and truck owners are also benefitted. He further expressed that Govt. has also done something for the poor people and explained about the benefit in his Panchayat area such as ambulance facility. So, he is not in favour of stop the operation of stone quarry as stone quarrying is the only income source of the people of the area. He lastly requested to Sub-Collector for generation of income for poor people and their betterment in life.

9. **Sri Debendra Kumar Pradhan, Gopalpur, Mahumuhan, Soro, Balasore**

Sri Pradhan welcoming the chair told the importance of air, water and soil. He explained how environment get polluted giving example of Delhi air pollution and urged the prevention of pollution in the area. He explained about the environment and pollution. He also expressed the dispersion of stone dust of quarry to nearby agriculture land and Khanjamahal should not be pollution like Delhi environment. He informed that, blasting creating artificial earthquake and creating crack in the wall and collapsed the hard earned built house. He suggested for use of DMF in the local area, so that local people will be get benefitted. He also suggested for review of the rules framed for stone quarry, so that deviation can be assessed. He further suggested for think for the poor adivasi who are in search of livelihood and establishment of residential school for the children of such people. He also expressed that, his agriculture land is infertile due to deposition of stone during blasting and requested to take good steps for welfare of this area. He explained circular economy by giving example of flow of water in water cycle. He requested to inform the public at least two times in a year by reviewing the situation in the area.


10. **Sri KamalaKanta Sahoo, Mahumuhan, Soro, Balasore**

Sri Sahoo did not delivered his views or opinion.



The panel has also received 05 nos. of written representations during the hearing. Smt. Mallick, ADM, Balasore asked the project proponent to present their comments to the public with respect to the demand, issues and concerns raised by the public in the public hearing meeting. Sri Kunal Motiram Chavan, Sub Collector, Balasore explained the local issues with respect to communication and local employment. He also addressed to resolve the problems by co-operation of the local people. Sri Ashwani Kumar Naik, Tahasildar, Soro pointed out important issues raised by the public in the hearing and responded to resolve the issues raised for stone quarries in consultation with district administration.

The statement of issues, demand and concerns of the public with comments of the applicant are prepared in English and Odia languages and annexed herewith separately.

The Regional Officer, SPCB, Balasore conveyed vote of thanks to the participants present in the hearing for offering their views, suggestions and objections. The public hearing meeting ended with declaration by the Chair.
