PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 10.01.2024 AT 10.00 AM AT RANDIA HIGH SCHOOL, VILLAGE RANDIA, DIST. BHADRAK FOR ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT OF M/S FERRO ALLOYS CORPORATION LIMITED FOR EXPANSION OF FERRO ALLOYS PLANT FOR HIGH CARBON FERRO CHROME PRODUCTION FROM 1,45,000 TPA (1 X 45 MVA, 1 x 33 MVA) TO 4,45,000 TPA (1 X 45 MVA, 1 x 33 MVA & 2 x 75 MVA) & 11,800 TPA FROM METAL RECOVERY PLANT ALONG WITH NEW INSTALLATION OF RAW MATERIAL HANDLING FACILITY AND 7,00,000 TPA PALLET AND SINTER PLANT AT VILLAGE RANDIA IN THE DISTRICT OF BHADRAK

The public hearing in respect of the proposed expansion project by M/s Ferro Alloys Corporation Ltd. was held on dated 10.01.2024 as per scheduled time and venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S.O. 1533 (E), dt.14.09.2006. The public hearing with regards to date, venue and time was published in Daily Newspaper on dated 08.12.2023 and was also announced through Public Address System in the surrounding village panchayats of the proposed project site on dated 0801.2024 and 09.01.2024. The process followed for the public hearing was adequate.

The panel consisted of the following members.

- 1. Sri Santanu Kumar Mohanty, Additional District Magistrate, Bhadrak
- 2. Sri Manmohan Murmu, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Balasore

Sri Santanu Kumar Mohanty, Additional District Magistrate, Bhadrak, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and was assisted by Sri Manmohan Murmu, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Balasore, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the public participated in the meeting Sri Murmu, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Balasore gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of the projects proposed by M/s Ferro Alloys Corporation Ltd.

Welcoming the public, Sri Santanu Kumar Mohanty, Additional District Magistrate, Bhadrak explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the

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public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public.

On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Sanat Mishra, Project Head addressed the Panel Members and assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Sri Mohanty, ADM, Bhadrak, requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. Mr. Jagannath Mallick, Gelpur GP

Sri Mallick greeted the panel members and the public and said that no developmental work has been carried out by FACOR for Gelpur Gram Panchayat till date even after expansion of earlier project. Since no Road, Light and other developmental activities are taken up, he requested that Gelpur GP should be declared as Industrial Hub. Finally, he expressed his inability to support the public hearing for the expansion project.

2. Mr. Jagannath Swain, Randia

Mr. Swain welcomed the Panel members, Police Perosnnels, Electronics & Printing Media and to the public. He was very much pleased to inform about today's public hearing being conducted for expansion of proposed project of Vedanta FACOR. He raised a demand before District Administration and the Project Proponent to engage the local unemployed youth in Vedanta Pay Roll instead of taking under Contractor. He also informed that Vedanta FACOR has well executed some peripheral development works in the locality and hope for more after their new expansion project is done. Finally, he extended his full support to the proposed project.

3. Mr. Santosh Das, Adv. Randia

Sri Das greeted the panel members and welcomed the local gathered there as well as public hearing being conducted for expansion of the proposed project. He expressed his pleasure that Vedanta FACOR has been doing well peripheral and other developmental work after taking over FACOR. He also added that if the proposed project of Vedanta FACOR is expanded, they will get all types of benefits from the company like employment to the unemployed youth and other facilities. He requested the Panel and the project proponent

to revise the salary structure and increase the wages of the workers with continuation of developmental activities in nearby villages. He supported the public hearing.

4. Mr. Sujat Mohapatra, Koranta, Randia

Sri Mohapatra welcomed the Public Hearing being conducted for expansion of project of FACOR. He greeted the Panel and the public gathered there. He extended his full support to the public hearing and the expansion project but requested to look into the matter of increasing the salary of the existing workers / employees.

5. Mr. Alekha Nayak, Chengagadia

Sri Nayak greeted the Panel Members, all Sarpanches, Samiti Sabhya, FACOR officials and the present gathering. He thanked Vedanta FACOR for their peripheral activities being carried out. He pointed out that village Chengagadia is adjacent to the plant. But no light, communication road, water sprinklers on the kaccha road is provided to them and even no financial support is given extended by FACOR for their Annual Sport. He requested ADM and FACOR to look into the matter and do some developmental work for their Gram Panchayat. He also requested to construct a mini-Play Ground in their Chengagadia village. He concluded his speech extending his support for the proposed expansion project of Vedanta FACOR.

6. Mr. Saroj Kumar Dash, Ex. Sarpanch, Geltua

Mr. Dash greeted the Panel members and to the public attended from 6 Gram Panchayats, Police and Media. He expressed that in the earlier public hearing held in 2022, he had requested for employment of their GP youth, but it is not yet considered and is given to other nearby Panchayats. He added that some CSR activities like light, medicines and some other peripheral works are being done by Vedanta. Finally, he supported the Public Hearing for the proposed project of Vedanta FACOR.

7. Mr. Ganesh Panda, Saramunda, Randia

Mr. Panda greeted the panel and the public at the outset. He expressed that they have lost their land while Facor Power was established but as per assurance given by the company, nothing has been done for employment of his unemployed son. Though the matter was brought to the notice of the FACOR management many times with written submissions and also to the District Administration, no response is received from them. He once again reiterated and requested the District Administration and Vedanta Management

to look into the matter. He concluded his speech remaining neutral for the proposed project of FACOR.

8. Mr. Rash Bihari Biswal, Geltua

Mr. Biswar expressed that most of the public of Geltua Gram Panchayat belongs to SC & ST category and they are deprived of job, employment and assistance. He requested to consider for employment of their Geltua GP people as is given to other GPs for which they will be benefited economically and socially. With the above request he finally extended his support to the public hearing for the proposed expansion project of FACOR.

9. Mr. Shanti Swarup Mishra, Randia

Mr Mishra greeted the Panel and the public present in the Public hearing. He deliberated about the assistance and other peripheral developmental works being carried out by Vedanta for the people of all 6 Gram Panchayats, after taking over FACOR. He expressed his full support to the proposed Project.

10. Mrs. Debi Dutta Mohanty, Ex. Sarpanch, Randia

Mrs. Mohanty expressed her gratitude to the Chair (ADM) and greeted the gathering. Initially, she reiterated about the earlier public hearing held in 2022, wherein it was assured by the ADM and Management of Vedanta FACOR to provide necessary employment to the unemployed mass of 6 Gram Panchayats. But she expressed with deep regret that no feelings from either side is known to her. Since Vedanta is a Multi National Company, they can create a good atmosphere for the development of the local people. She also urged that equal opportunities should be given to all the people of 6 nearby Gram Panchayats and requested to install Multi Technology equipment in the plant for the Proposed Project. She extended her support to the Public hearing of the Project.

11. Mr. Ramakanta Jena, Ramkrushnapur GP

Mr. Jena greeted the Chair Person, Sub-Collector, panel members, gathering & media. In the earlier public hearing held in 2022, he had submitted a written demand to the ADM for employment opportunities to the local youth, as per their educational qualification. As the same has not yet been considered, he requested to fulfil their demand by engaging the youth in the plant. On the other hand, he requested to take appropriate step to control the Ash pollution happening in the arrea and provide necessary street lights to the <u>villages</u>. However, he extended his support to the public hearing of the proposed project.

12. Mr. Pitabas Shaw, Randia

Mr. Shaw greeted the Panel members, all Sarpanches of 6 GPs, Media, Police, Sr. Citizens and the general public. He alleged that most of the youths are employed in Vedanta FACOR with the help of Randia Sarpanch Representative Mr. Amit Mohapatra and Mr. Pintu Mishra from their Gram Panchayat. In this regard, he requested the District Administration to look into the matter and give employment opportunities to the youths (Land losers) of other GPs in the Vedanta Roll who have lost their land for the sake of the company. However, he extended his support to the public hearing.

13. Mrs. Swapnarani Routray, Sarpanch, Randia

Mrs. Routray expressed her gratitude to the Panel and public present from 6 Gram Panchayats. Initially, she elaborated about the developmental work being carried out by Vedanta FACOR in Panchayats. Since she is elected as Sarpanch in Randia GP, she has tried her best to give employment opportunities to the unemployed youth in Vedanta FACOR and the same has been successfully done. As regards to employment opportunities for other Gram Panchayats, she requested the Vedanta Management to make benefits and opportunity available equally. She extended her full support to the public hearing for the proposed project.

14. Mr. Prafulla Samal, Randia

Mrs. Samal greeted the panel, Sr. Citizens and gathering. He informed that in the earlier PH they had demanded some issues through ADM, but is yet to be addressed. He added that Vedanta has done some more developmental work than earlier FACOR Management. He requested to give employment opportunities to the nearby as well as district unemployed youth. He demanded the opportunity and the work done for Randia GP to be extended to other GPs also. He also requested to provide one Ambulance Service for the interest of the public, tube wells of 50 to 70 nos. for getting water in the periphery, He supported to the public hearing of the proposed project.

15. Mr. Barun Kumar Chand, Sarpanch, Baudpur

Mr. Chand greeted the Panel and the public. He expressed his deep regret that Vedanta FACOR has only provided Solar Lights and generic medicines to the residents of their Baudpur GP whereas original medicines are being supplied to Randia Panchayat. He pointed out that till date no road development has been done by Vedanta. He expressed that all the facilities for their Gram Panchayat are being provided by the MLA. He requested to look into the matter for peripheral development of their Panchayat.

16. Mr. Bhagabat Rout, Korant, Randia

Mr. Rout greeted the Panel, Media. He said that they had submitted their grievance in the earlier PH held in 2022 for improvement of health, education, peripheral activities and increment of workers salary, but no developmental activities have been done so far. He once again requested to do the above development activities, health and education facility for the public. However, he extended his support to the public hearing.

17. Mr. Sridhar Nayak, Samiti Sabhya, Randia GP

Mr. Nayak greeted the Panel members, officials of Vedanta and the public attended in the public hearing. He requested Vedanta to give opportunity to the youth in the plant as Apprentice and thereafter regularize them in Vedanta Pay Roll as permanent employees. He also requested the management to disburse the unrest salary to the affected employees during strike period. However, he supported the public hearing.

18. Mr. Akshaya Mohanty, Sarpanch, Olanga GP

Mr. Mohanty extended his best wishes for a happy New Year and greeted all, present in the PH. He requested the District Administration and Vedanta Management to look into the matter of local employment on priority basis. Since Dhamra port area youths are getting employment benefits by engaging themselves in Vedanta, their unemployed youths are not getting this scope in the Dhamara Port. Hence, they should be considered fully for employment in Vedanta with proper justice. He also added that periphery development in the locality should be done properly at all the time. He also gave importance and requested for employment of three educated youths including Mr. Ganesh Panda's son in Vedanta. He requested to run the upcoming furnace with Eco and solar system to avoid pollution. Finally, he informed that their residents of Olanga Panchayat have been supporting Vedanta FACOR all the time and shall also support in future with request to fulfil their legitimate demand and solve their problems on long term basis. He supported the public hearing of the proposed project.

19. Mr. Rama Chandra Panda, Randia

Mr. Panda greeted the Panel and public present in the hearing. He emphasized that the pollution control measures are required to be taken up to avoid different kinds diseases. Hence, for cleaning of road, he suggested to use Vacuum Cleaner system to protect from dust and keep the people as "NIROG". He also requested to give promotion and increase the salary of existing employees from local areas.

20. Mr. Manoranjan Puhan, Ex. Sarpanch, Randia

Mr. Puhan requested to focus on the demands raised by the affected people of nearby villages. He supported to the public hearing.

21. Mr. Laxman Panda, Olanga GP

Mr. Panda informed that discharge of water from agricultural land is not being done, as was done by the then FACOR Management. Since brick manufacturing unit is established there, water is not properly discharging to the nalah. Hence, he requested to open the water Nalah, for which most of the farmers will be benefitted.

22. Mr. Bapuji Panigrahi, Randia

Mr. Panigrahi greeted the Panel members, officials of FACOR and the public. He deliberately told that the peripheral and all other developmental activities for the locality are being carried out properly. He requested the company management to look after the PF of the old and retired laborers. He extended his support to the public hearing.

In the Public Hearing meeting 24 persons registered their name to deliver their speech. However, 22 people have delivered their speech in the public hearing meeting. The Panel also received 618 nos. of written representations during the hearing.

Sri Santanu Kumar Mohanty, ADM, Bhadrak asked the project proponent to present their comments to the public with respect to the demand raised by the public in the public hearing meeting. Sri Kruti Sundar Mohapatra, Chief HSE Officer of M/s FACOR Ltd. made comments and commitment on the demand and issues raised by the public. The statement of the issues and concern of the public with comments of the applicant are prepared in Engilish and Odia languages and annexed separately. The public hearing meeting was concluded with thanks to the Chair.

COMMITMENT OF THE PROJECT PROPONENT

Mr. Krutisunder Mohapatra, Chief HSE Officer of M/s Ferro Alloys Corporation Limited, made commitment to certain issues raised by the public during Public Hearing are as follows:

- Latest technology will be adopted to have minimum impact on the environment.
- Various pollution control measures have been taken towards protection of environment to achieve the company's philosophy on Zero Harm, Zero Waste and Zero Discharge. In this regard we have installed Surface Run-off Treatment Plant (SRTP), Sewage Treatment Plant (STP), Rainwater harvesting and will help in water conservation measures. The process water is recycled in the system with minimal effluent generation, which will be treated in the ETP and reused. Also, we have installed Gas Cleaning Plant (GCP) & Dust Extraction System (DES) at transfer points for air pollution control and gas cleaning residues are being utilized in pallets & briquettes.
- Peripheral development work is being carried out and the same will be continued.
- Company has initiated Project Arambh under which 225 health camps and 90 Swasthya Sivira have been organized for the health care benefit of the local people. Project Livelihood launched by the company to train local youth to manufacture Agarvati, Paper Plate etc. 140 numbers of female given tailoring training for maintaining their livelihood. Held 50 numbers of Swoyam Shahayak Group for their skill development. Company has taken care and given emphasis for periphery development by providing solar lights,

- children park, 21 Anganbadi Kendras, High Mast light system and stood with local people during the time of natural calamities.


