PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF NUAGAON IRON ORE MINES OF M/S. JSW STEEL LTD FOR PRODUCTION OF 20 MTPA (ROM) OF IRON ORE WITH TOTAL EXCAVATION OF 22.013 MTPA WITH SCREENING, CRUSHING, 4500 TPH CENTRAL PROCESSING UNIT (CPU) AND 30 MTPA GRINDING AND DESLIMING/BENEFICIATION PLANT ALONG WITH 30 MTPA SLURRY TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM OVER ML AREA OF 776.969 (AS PER DGPS)/767.284 HA (AS PER ROR) IN VILLAGES NUAGAON, BARAPADA, GANDHALPADA, GUALI, KATASAHI, PAREDIPOSI, KOHLARUDUKELA, PANDULIPOSHI, TOPADIHI UNDER BARBIL TEHSIL HELD ON 15.11.2022 AT 11.0 AM AT MOUZA GANDHALPADA, KHATA NO. 48, PLOT NO. 194, KISSAM- TALIA-I ABADA JOGYA ANABADI (AJA) PROPOSED AREA AC.1.150 HA IN THE KEONJHAR DISTRICT.

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 15.11.2022 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in nearby villages of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Er P Kar, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Smt. Susama Bilung, OAS(S), Additional District Magistrate, Keonjhar presided over and supervised the public hearing. She briefed about the importance and objectives of such hearing and invited the project proponent to highlight on proposed project.

Sri Prashant Biswal, General Manager(CSR) of the mine explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the mine.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Keonjhar.

1. Smt. Parbati Munda, SHG President, Gandhalpada

Smt. Parbati while speaking in favour of the public hearing of M/s.JSW, demanded to make necessary arrangements for medical check-up of pregnant women, construction of road, supply of drinking water and solar street light. Further, she demanded for employment to every family, income-oriented skill development training to SHG for income generation, drinking water facility and dust free environment of Guali Panchayat.

2. Smt. Basmati Munda, SHG President, Gandhalpada

Smt. Basmati supported for expansion of the mines. She demanded for providing employment to ladies, gents and widows of Gandhalpada village, school teachers, necessary security arrangement at NH to avoid road accidents, attention need to be given for income generation of SHG group&door to door supply of drinking water through pipeline.

3. Smt.Umarani Das, SHG President, Ward No:7, Guali

Smt. Umarani while supporting the public hearing demanded for employment to the youths as well as to Mission Shakti members and to provide a house for mushroom cultivation.

4. Smt. Gita Patra, Ward No:7, Guali

Smt. Patra while supporting the public hearing expressed that M/s.JSW has provided them all facilities like supplying of drinking water, Medical and Ambulance. She only demanded employment for every family as per the qualifications.

5. Smt. Nandini Patra, Ward No 7, Guali:

Smt. Patra while speaking in favour of the public hearing demanded a club room for Patra Sa aaj, provision of employment, roads & drainage system, drinking water facility, toilet to every house, Medical, Ambulance, Street Light, Construction of Maa Laxmi Temple, Provision of school bus and playground.

6. Sri Juria Munda, Gandalpada

Sri Munda while speaking in favour of public hearing stated that M/s. JSW came to this area two years back for their mining operation activities. During this two years of time period, the company has taken some developmental jobs like providing support to Maa Tarini SHG Group for leaf plate selling, constructed toilet rooms in Gandhalpada schools, provided paly materials and food items to the Anganbadi Kendra, arranged drinking water through solar system and helped Maa Tarini SHG group etc. He expressed his happiness by stating that he has never seen such development in 50 years. He hoped that the company will maintain this type of developmental jobs in future also. He demanded for providing schoolteachers, necessary pollution control measures like dust and parking facility at entry points at NH to avoid accident.

7. Ms. Suman Munda, Ward Member, Ward No-6, Guali

Ms. Suman while supporting the public hearing expressed that since last one and half years she worked with JSW company and she has observed that the company has provided school bus and drinking water. Further, she requested for employment to the less educated youth. She also said that during her tenure in JSW company she has observed that the company has fulfilled all the needs of the villagers.

8. Ms. Renuka Patra, Nuagaon

Ms. Patra while supporting the public hearing expressed that JSW Company has come to this area since last two years for operation of mining activities. Since then, the company has taken up many developmental jobs like supply of drinking water, providing ambulance, school bus, streetlight etc. He demanded for employment to unemployed youth according to their qualifications.

9. Smt. Laxmi Karua, Ward No. 6, Guali

Smt. Karua while speaking in favour of the public hearing stated that Company should take proper measure for reducing dust, providing employment according to their qualifications and necessary help to SHG group for their development.

10. Smt.Reena Rani Lohar, Guali

Smt. Reena Rani while speaking in favour of the public hearing stated that many developmental jobs in some area have been taken up by M/s. JSW Company like bore well, Ambulance facility, Bus for school children and provided dust bin in various places.

11. Sri Prashant Ku Patra, Guali

While speaking in favour of the Public Hearing, He stated that three things are essential to develop any area which is Education, Work/Employment and Medical facilities. He thanked JSW Company for providing bus for the school and college students to improve education system. With regard to employment, he stated that about 60% people have got employment and rest 40% people have not got any employment. Hence, he requested the Company to give attention for 100% employment. With regard to Medical, he stated that Company has already provided free medical treatment, free medicine and ambulance facilities.

12. Sri Padan Patra, Ex-Member, Guali

Sri Patra spoke in favour of the public hearing. He stated that he will not repeat the points already raised by the previous speakers. He stated that during the last two years operation by M/s.JSW it has transported left out ore of M/s. KJS Ahluwalia, but during that time no employment was given to the villagers. He also stated when Thriveni Earth Mover's winded up its operation, few persons were given employment as per the list provided by them to M/s.JSW and rest persons have not been provided any employment. Therefore, he requested the JSW management to provide employment to the left-out employees and simultaneously shall also provide employment to the fresh candidate. He requested for interaction and cooperation with the local people. Further he told that due to mining operation, trees will be cut and as per Govt's guidelines, ratio of 1:10 should be planted. Hence, he requested the Company for massive tree plantation.

13. Smt. Parbati Patra, Ward No. 7, Guali

Smt. Patra while speaking in favour of the public hearing stated that M/s. JSW has already provided them the drinking water, Street light, medical facility, ambulance and school bus in Guali. She demanded only for employment so that they can manage their livelihood.

14. Smt. Gitanjali Das, Guali

Smt. Das while speaking in favour of the public hearing stated that all the developmental jobs have been taken up by the Company.

15. Smt.Susmita Patra, SHG Secretary, Ward No.5, Guali

Smt. Susmita while speaking in favour of the public hearing said that school bus for Sishu Mandir school children has been provided by the Company. She only demanded for employment to everybody either educated or uneducated persons as per their eligibility.

16. Sri Kalandi Charan Naik, Panduliposhi

Sri Naik while supporting the public hearing expressed that five persons from each village shall be taken By M/s. JSW. Company should work here in the project with the local people not with Politicians.

17. Smt. Rashmi Priya Patra, SHG President, Guali Panchayat

Smt. Patra while supporting the public hearing requested for employment to the unemployed youth.

18. Smt. Mani Munda, Kendudihi

Smt. Munda supported the public hearing and submitted the written memorandum of their demands.

19. Smt.Lilabati Bankula, Ward No.5, Guali Basti

Smt. Bankula supported the public hearing. She stated that few people of their area have been working here and after expansion of the Mining Operation, more people will get employment. M/s. JSW company has done many development jobs like, providing School bus, Anganbadi Kendra &also providing table, chairs, streetlight, supplying drinking water etc. Hence, she called for massive support for JSW for their overall development.

Sri Barik while supporting the public hearing stated that the company has started its operation since last two years and their issues are being solved slowly. After expansion of the project, company should take more developmental jobs and requested for appointment of additional teachers to their local schools.

25. Sri Manglu Munda, Gandhalpada

Sri Munda supported the public hearing.

26. Ms. Lipi Nag, Ward No.2, Kendudihi

Ms. Nag supported the public hearing. She said school bus has been provided by M/s. JSW for which the school going children are able to attend their school conveniently. Further, she stated that in the M.E. School, there is a shortage of teachers for which study is adversely affected. Therefore, she demanded for providing school teachers. Approach road in front of the school and Anganbadi is in very bad condition for which school going children as well as pregnant women are facing difficulties. This road should be repaired. With regard to health care, Ambulance and first aid facilities have already been provided by M/s.JSW for which she thanked the company. In addition to the above, dust bins have been provided by JSW Foundation for maintaining cleanliness and hygiene. She further demanded that employment should be provided to both unemployed male and female as per their qualification. At the end, she demanded employment for the people who were engaged in the previous owners and for the unemployed.

Sri Jaiswal while supporting the public hearing hoped that Company would implement all the commitment made in the public hearing.

33. Sri Harihar Bankula, Guali

Sri Bankula while supporting the public hearing expressed that M/s.JSW has done lot for education and requested to do some more in the field of education. He requested to provide employment to persons who are left out. Ambulance and School bus has already been provided but more need to be done.

34. Sri Somra Munda, Gandhalpada

Sri Munda supported the public hearing and requested for repairing of roads, providing drinking water and employment.

35. Smt. Kanakalata Barik, Ward No.6, Guali

Smt. Barik while supporting the public hearing requested for employment to the villagers and construction of a Radha-Krushna Temple.

Stopping of mining operation is not a solution rather it has to be carried out keeping the environment safe. He said that the company has mentioned in its EIA about adopting Dry Fog

technology and KMZ process which is a good step that will reduce the dust pollution level. Now a days, science and technologies are improving. He suggested for dust sucker machine for reduction of considerable amount of dust level. Further, he said that it not the only duty of the Govt. or the company to look after the pollution control issues, rather public are also equally responsible and shall work for it. He requested M/s. JSW to form a committee comprising of Private, Government and Environmentalist to resolve the environment issues. He further stated that he is in this area since 1976 and comparatively dust pollution has decreased from the earlier days due to use of new technologies. He requested for undergoing massive plantation in the open space of village area by having a discussion with Panchayat committee so that oxygen level will develop. Further, he extended helping hand to the company from the NGOs as and when required for safeguarding the environment.

39. Sri Jamadar Munda, Katasahi

Sri Mundawhile supporting the public hearing told that his previous speakers have raised various issues, hence he requested the company to ensure implementation of the issues raised by the speakers. In addition, he requested for regular water sprinkling on the roads to reduce dust generation in front of Katasahi gate.
