

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELDON 11.02.2026 (11.00 A.M.) AT VILLAGE BYREE IN NAYAKSAHI KHELA PADIA SITUATED OVER KHATA NO.1301, PLOT NO.4222/4751, AC 5.00 UNDER DARPAN TAHASIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE PROPOSED BY M/S A-3 MINERALS & METAL EXPORTS PVT. LTD. FOR EXPANSION OF CHROME ORE BENEFICIATION PLANT FROM 18,500 TPA TO 1,60,000 TPA AT VILLAGE BYREE UNDER DARPAN TAHASIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT, ODISHA.

The public hearing in respect of proposed by M/S A-3 Minerals & Metal Exports Pvt. Ltd. for expansion of Chrome Ore Beneficiation plant from 18,500 TPA to 1,60,000 TPA at village Byree under Darpan tahasil of Jajpur with reference to

- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006
- II. Interim Operational Guidelines till 13th September 2007 in respect of applications made under EIA-1994

The Panel consisted of the following members:

1. Shri Sibananda Swain, OAS(S), Additional District Magistrate (ADM), Jajpur.
2. Er. Madan Mohan Sahoo, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Kalinganagar, Jajpur.

Sri Sibananda Swain, OAS(S), ADM, Jajpur presided over the public hearing meeting and assisted by Er. Madan Mohan Sahoo, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar as representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

The entire proceedings of the public hearing has been video recorded.

At the outset, Er. Madan Mohan Sahoo, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar welcomed all the local villagers and other stakeholders who participated in the meeting and presented a brief introduction about the purpose and guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by M/S A-3 Minerals & Metal Exports Pvt. Ltd.

Thereafter, Sri Sibananda Swain, OAS(S) ADM, Jajpur addressed the gathering and briefly explained about the purpose of the public hearing and informed the gathering that their views, suggestions, objections and opinions are essential for the environmental clearance of the project. He then asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the

public including the social welfare measures and peripheral development plans proposed to be undertaken under corporate social responsibility.

Sri Akshya Kumar Samal, Director of M/S A-3 Minerals & Metal Exports Pvt.Ltd. addressed the public and committee members. He made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project as well as existing plant, water management, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed project. On behalf of M/s.A-3 Minerals & Metal Exports Pvt. Ltd. Further, Sri Akshya Kumar Samal, Director, Representative of Kalyani Laboratories Pvt. Ltd. requested Mr. Mrutyunjay Das to explain about the technical aspects of the project.

Thereafter, Sri Sibananda Swain, OAS(S) ADM, Jajpur invited views, suggestions, objections and opinions from the public on the proposed project.

The objections, suggestions, opinions as received (written/oral) during public hearing are noted below.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. Smt.Laxmipriya Das (Sarapanch Byree G.P.)

She greeted everyone and expressed that all activities shall be proceed as per Govt. guideline. She welcomed the expansion project of M/S A-3 Minerals & Metal Exports Pvt. Ltd. also requested the industry for construction of a crematorium at Byree village, supply of electricity to the village and construct community hall for village.

2. Smt. Bilasini Khuntia (P.S. Member, Badachana Block, Byree G.P.)

She greeted everyone present in the meeting and opined that villagers of Byree G.P. supported all industry operated in this region and will support the expansion project of M/S A-3 Minerals & Metal Exports Pvt.Ltd.as well. She requested the Chairperson to look after the issues faced by Byree Gram Panchayat. She highlighted the issues such as, unemployment issues in this region, Hence she requested priority should be given for local employment of educated, skilled, unskilled people of this locality within the industries activities. She requested the



wages shall be paid as per Govt. wages norm. As the regional land type is majorly stoney in nature, Byree G.P. is facing water scarcity, during summer season. It is difficult to survive for human, domestic animals, wild animals as shortage of drinking water. Hence, she demanded that all industries present should supply drinking water during summer season. The generated waste must be kept within the industry premises and demanded that industries must take necessary action for safe keeping of wildlife habitat, forest, mountain ecosystems near to them also help for development of Byree G.P. by utilising CSR fund and at last she supported the public hearing meeting.

3. Sri Jatindra Prasad Nayak (Zilla Parishad Member, Zilla Parishad Jajpur, Zone-16)

He greeted everyone and said that he is representing ZP Zone No.16, which belongs to industrial zone as declared by Hon'ble Chief Minister Odisha. Big industries like Cement factory of My Home industries, New Laxmi Sponge Iron, Adish COB plant etc. are located. Hence, local people will get advantages in employment, CSR fund should be utilised for development of Gram Panchayats & he requested to take necessary steps to reduce environment pollution as per Govt. of Odisha industry policy. He explained the expansion project of COB plant of production from 18,000 TPA to 1,60,000 TPA which is about 10 times than existing facility will boost local economy, so necessary steps must be done by providing lighting facility, local employment etc. He expressed that majorly tribal people are residing in this area, hence few villages may be adopted by industry for providing equality for all, special care should be taken for dropout school children to merge them into mainstream. At the end he requested to follow all the environmental guidelines for better climate and shall overcome global warming and climate change issues which is faced in regular days. Also, he supported the expansion project of M/s A-3 minerals & Metal Exports Pvt. Ltd. and requested the industry officials for proper environmental management.

4. Sri Benudhar Biswal (Sarapanch Paria G.P.)

He greeted everyone and expressed that this industry is operating for many years ago in this region, yet he informed that he never heard any complaint against the industry. He supported the prior deliberators who were expressed their views about

this expansion project and requested for better management of earth, water & air for better environment. He told that major industry like Dalmia Cement, Laxmi Sponge Iron etc. also running at this region and he raised his concern over the pollution caused by New Laxmi Sponge Iron. He requested proper measures may be taken by authority to monitor pollution caused by industry. He requested to take necessary steps for development of Byree G.P. as well as nearest Gram Panchayats. At last he supported the project.

5. Smt. Kanakalata Swain (Byree Village)

She greeted everyone and talked about illegal encroachment of private land, pending court case on plot no. 4151 before hon'ble High Court since 2019. She said that she doesn't have any issues with this industry.

6. Sri Nilamani Rout (Ex-Sarapanch, Solar G.P.)

He greeted everyone and held her view that the purpose of this public hearing meeting to fulfil all demand of local people, development of local area, priority towards local employment, steps to reduce environmental pollution, vehicular pollution. He requested ADM sir to monitor CSR activity as the nearby industries don't performing any CSR activity. Lastly, he told that if the A-3 minerals industry operating by following Govt. guidelines then he supports the public hearing.

7. Sri Atulya Das (Byree Village)

He supported the Public Hearing.

8. Sri Himansu Nayak (Byree Village)

He supported the Public Hearing.

9. Sri Rama Chandra Nayak (Byree Village)

He supported the Public Hearing.

10. Sri Mahendra Mohanty (Byree Village)

He supported the Public Hearing.

11. Sri Ashok Kumar Swain (President of All Odisha Thika Majdoor Mahasangha, Executive Member of All India Cement Federation, Amiyajhari village)



He greeted everyone & informed that public hearing meeting is not new for them as they have already attended 3 nos. of public hearings for different industry yet all are false commitments as not fulfilling requirement for development of affected area. He told that last week they heard about the news that Cuttack district has been announced as second most polluted area and increases sound pollution, water pollution, air pollution etc.. He expressed his concerned over not providing local employment. Beside the village road is extensively utilized by heavy vehicles for transportation of materials of different industries hence the condition of the road near Byree railway station road is very miserable. Outside transporters & contractors are given priority than local people in different activities of industries. He said that industries some time generate air pollution, when they complaint about the matter neither industry personnel nor Govt. officials take immediate necessary action. Hence, they are forced to protest In front of that industry to stop air pollution. Govt. should make proper guideline regarding use of ground water by the industries; all rules and regulations must be followed to operate different industry. Workers must be paid as per government wage slab; local people should be offered with permanent posts rather than temporary posts. He told that the project is a small COB plant so he requested the owner to provide minimum wages to all worker, plant trees to maintain oxygen level in the environment. He said more than 5000 people directly or indirectly depending on these industries for their livelihood so government officials must inspect at least 3-4 times in a year within regular intervals. Lastly, he supported all industry those are running at this area & said that conducting public hearing meeting is not adequate to maintain environmental issues rather than all industries must obey environmental guidelines strictly.

12. Sri Mahesh Mahaprasad (Byree Village)

He greeted everyone and asked the industry owner to provide details of development work done by then within last 10-15 years, a list should be shown that listed all development work to be done by the industry. As this is a chrome ore washing plant will consume more water, whereas this region is already facing water scarcity, by which most of the drinking water project is not running till date. Hence, he suggested the industry shall make necessary arrangement for supply of drinking water to the villagers. He also suggested that industries shall discuss with local people & provide support to the community organisation, village events, religious

functions etc. which will create a friendly atmosphere. He also requested to provide local employment. He requested the authority not to do activity like Mahashakti Industry which is not responding towards any commitment made during its public hearings. He requested to take necessary steps for development of nearby villages in every respect and lastly opposed the public hearing.

13. Sri Padmanav Samal (Byree Village)

He greeted everyone and told that the company is operating since 1985 in the name of RC Metals but till date they haven't spent a single rupee for peripheral village development and he requested to utilize at least 2% of revenue for local area development, provide solar light, drinking water supply during summer season as ground water level decreasing drastically in this area. He suggested each industry present shall provide two (2) nos. of drinking water tankers during summer season to meet water scarcity in this region, local people must be given priority for employment, he also made request to open an ITI College for higher education of students. He made concerned that wastewater generated from industry spreading over agriculture land creates health hazard to farmers, reduce soil fertility. He strongly raised issues against company authority for dismiss workers at any point of time as they don't have proper joining order. There is no proper facility for farmers as per the speech of Sri Jawaharlal Nehru "Jay jawan jai kisan" farmers must be given top priority but now-a-days they are facing lots of issues. He requested government officials, industry authority to look after the issues like lighting facilities, drinking water, road condition, health issues, degraded road condition near Byree railway station, education etc. lastly he informed that if all the demands fulfilled by industries then they don't have any objection for functioning of many industries, otherwise mass strike will take place.

14. Sri Biranchi Narayan Swain (Ex-Sarapanch, Byree G.P.)

He supported the public hearing, greeted everyone and told that they have already participated more than five (5) nos. of public hearings in which many committed to dig five (5) nos. of borewell but constructed more than fifty (50) nos. of borewell. As per his point of view this plant leads to soil quality deterioration, waste ash pond should be constructed for better management & this must be monitored by officials of State Pollution Control Board. Industry authority at least take steps for supply of



drinking water during morning & evening time. As it is a small industry so major issues should be addressed by using Panchayat fund but small development work like support for village cultural activity, temple area beautification, Bhagavat pitha development work, financial assistance should be provided by this industry for Ganesh Puja, Saraswati Puja, Cricket tournament etc. He requested and informed ADM sir that they don't know the members of peripheral development committee so a new peripheral development committee may be formed by constituting local people, review meeting which shall conduct once in two (2) months interval to address the requirements of local people to take decision that what can be fulfilled by industry or not. Proper pollution control measures to be taken followed by regular monitoring as present condition is not satisfactory such as green leaves are covered by dust generated from industry. He said that they have high expectation towards large industry like cement factory etc. as it is a small COB plant so he doesn't have much expectations but some common facility should be provided to local people, lastly he supported the public hearing.

15. Sri Bijay Kumar Nayak (Byree Village)

He greeted everyone and said that he has already attended Public Hearing meetings in the year 2008 for OCL industry, 2012 for OCL industry, 5th Aug 2023 for Maha Shakti Cement, another one industry in recent years this is the 5th time he has attended public hearing meeting, yet no one complete their commitment made during the meeting. He expressed a court case in between OCL & Maha Shakti Ltd. related to land dispute which raised issues for not providing the common road, water supply etc. to nearby Maha Shakti industry, digging more than twenty (20) nos. of borewell illegally which leads to shortage of water nearby ponds. He told that as per NOC issued to OCL, it shouldn't use ground water for industrial use, so he requested this industry authority not to use ground water rather use outside supply water for industrial purpose as this area facing lots of water scarcity. Local people should be given priority for employment as per their qualifications & he supported the meeting, requested to form a committee by constituting Sub-Collector, representative of local people & industry authority. The committee meeting to be conducted at regular intervals to monitor all development activity done by different industries, beside all common people should be benefited in all respect overall development should be done.



16. Sri Uma Shankar Khuntia (Byree Village)

He supported the Public Hearing.

17. Sri Saroj Kumar Nayak (Byree Village)

He opposed the Public Hearing, as this industry is surrounded by residential area so water scarcity might be observed due to industrial activity for that reason he opposed the Public Hearing.

Total 82 numbers of participant registered in the attendance sheet, and 17 numbers of participants delivered their speech through mic, and the panel has received 27 numbers of written representations during the hearing. Sri Sibananda Swain, OAS(S), Additional District Magistrate, Jajpur asked the project proponent to convey their commitment to the people with respect to the issues and demands raised by the public in the public hearing meeting. The Director of M/s A-3 Minerals & Metal Exports Pvt. Ltd. and Representative from Kalyani Laboratories Pvt. Ltd. made commitments on the issues raised by the public and assured to take care of the issues & objections raised in the public hearing. The statements of issues and concern of the public with comments of the applicant prepared in English & Odia language are annexed separately.

The meeting ended with thanks to the Chair and all participants.

STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND DEMANDS RAISED BY THE PUBLIC AND COMMITMENT OF THE PROJECT PROPONENT DURING THE PUBLIC HEARING METTING HELD ON 11.02.2026 (11.00 A.M.) AT-VILLAGE BYREE, VENUE-NAYAKSAHI KHELA PADIA SITUATED OVER KHATA NO.1301, PLOT NO.4222/4751, AC 5.00 UNDER DARPAN TAHASIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE PROPOSED BY M/S A-3 MINERALS & METAL EXPORTS PVT. <p>The issues raised at the public hearing meeting are as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Social infrastructure 2. Local Employment 3. Corporate social responsibility (CSR) 4. Plantation 	<p>On behalf of M/s A-3 Minerals & Metal Exports Pvt. Ltd. Mr. Mrutyunjay Das, Representative from M/S Kalyani Laboratories Pvt. Ltd. made following commitments to certain issues raised by the public:</p> <p>Mr. Mrutyunjay Das said that this Expansion project will generate direct employment for thirty-five (35) Nos. of people (unskilled /skilled) & indirect employment for twenty-seven (27) Nos of persons. This Expansion project will also help in improving living & social standards as well as economic status of villagers present nearby. Villagers of Byree will be given priority during employment.</p> <p>He further said that skill development & training program will be conducted four (4) times in a year for which a budget provision of sum of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Only) will be provisioned for this purpose. He added that that for drinking water supply will be provided to Byree village & other nearby villages as per actual requirement. A total sum of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) will be spent towards this purpose.</p> <p>It was also assured that that the Project Proponent will organise health camp in local area twice in a year and a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) will be spent towards this purpose.</p>




It was also assured that for safeguarding & maintaining of the village road of Byree funds to the tune of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) will be provisioned and for other miscellaneous expenditures such as; scholarship will be provided in schools present in the village, for this purpose a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Only)will be spent twice by arranging different events within a year.

Further, Sri Akshya Kumar Samal, Director of M/s.A-3 Minerals & Metal Exports Pvt. Ltd. added his commitments to the raised issues by public. Mr. Samal clarified that they have taken permission for extraction of ground water of 20 KL/Day from Central Ground Water Authority. It was informed by Mr. Samal that the the Company has constructed a concrete Rainwater Harvesting pit having 788 Sq. meter within industry premises. An Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) is constructed with concrete pond having 404.60 Sq. meter to treat the water.

Besides, the above-mentioned issues, they welcomed all the proposals & suggestion by the villagers. He said necessary steps will be taken in consultation with local people & Gram Panchayat for environmental development and for this purpose all the expenditure incurred will borne by industry authority. Lastly, he assured that appropriate steps will be taken for reduction of environmental pollution in consultation with environmental consultants.


