

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING IN RESPECT OF EXPANSION OF COMMON BIOMEDICAL WASTE TREATMENT FACILITIES CAPACITY FROM 3.2 TPD TO 11.2 TPD OF M/S SANI CLEAN PRIVATE LIMITED FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE AT G.P OFFICE, TANGIAPADA, KHORDHA TEHSIL ON DTD 30.01.2026-REG

Public hearing in respect of environmental assessment for expansion of Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facilities of M/s Sani Clean Pvt Ltd located at Plot No. 654/960, KhataNo 273/13 at Mouza-Tangiapada under Khordha Sadar Tehsil. The public hearing was held on scheduled date and time at Tangiapada GP Office on 30.01.2026 in Khordha district with reference to:

1. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14-09-2006
2. TOR Issued to M/s Sani Clean Pvt Ltd by SEIAA vide TO24B3301OR5563607N on dated 11th November 2024 with reference to File No. 464156/17-INFRA2/03-2024

The panel consisted of following members:

Shri. Sankalp Swastik Sahoo, OAS, Sub-Collector, Khordha, supervised and presided over the meeting, assisted by Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar as well as representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, SPC Board, Bhubaneswar welcomed the panel member and the public, gave an introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notifications 2006 in respect of Environmental Assessment for the expansion of Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facilities of M/s Sani Clean Pvt Ltd located at Plot No. 654/960, KhataNo 273/13 at Mouza- Tangiapada under Khordha Sadar Tehsil. This proposal conforms to the item no. 7(da)- 'Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facilities' in the schedule of EIA Notification, 2006 as amended from time to time, and the infra-2 project falls under Category B1.

Sri Bhabani Prasad Nanda representative of M/s Global Tech Enviro Experts Pvt Ltd who has been Project Consultant for M/s Sani Clean Pvt Ltd addressed the committee members and assembled public and gave a brief description about the proposed project. He also briefed about the project facilities, description of the baselines environmental studies conducted by consultant at the area in relation to Air, Water and Noise, Land, Biological environment. Socio-economic environment. He also mentioned about the anticipated impacts of the proposed project and mitigation measures in relation to the environmental parameters.

Regarding public hearing of proposed project was publicized on dtd 27.12.2025 through widely circulated print media in English (The Times of India) & Odia (The Prameya).

Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Bhubaneswar as well as representative of State Pollution Control Board Odisha then invited the public to present their views about the proposed project on environmental consideration.

The views expressed by various speakers are as follows:

| | At the outset, she welcomed the district administration officials and villagers present for the public hearing. She stated that M/s Sani Clean Pvt Ltd had been commissioned many years. She stated that as per the enquiry by villagers earlier it has been observed that necessary air pollution control measures had been taken such as wet scrubber to suppress dust and wastewater is also treated properly. It has been observed that Sani Clean has been taking appropriate steps for environmental protection. She stated that Common Biomedical Treatment Facility has been taking steps for BMW treatment and said without such facility Biomedical waste would be disposed by hospitals in public places which is hazardous and pollute environment. |

| | He welcomed the district administration officials and villagers present for the public hearing. He stated that M/s Sani Clean Pvt Ltd had been established since 2003 but villagers had never faced any problems. With the establishment of this facility, Biomedical waste is being treated properly. The villagers would not face any issues after expansion of the unit. He welcomed the expansion project of M/s Sani Clean Pvt Ltd |
| 3 | Shri. Rajesh Kumar Sahoo |
| | He welcomed the district administration officials and villagers present for the public hearing. He stated that from the hospital there is lot of biomedical waste generated for which Sani Clean is the facility which provides the treatment. The facility has been operational since 2003 and had taken proper air pollution control measures. If there were expansion of this project, then there would be no objection. Therefore, M/s Sani Clean should be allowed for expansion of the project. |

| | He welcomed the district administration officials and villagers present for the public hearing. He stated that M/s Sani Clean Pvt Ltd had been operating the facility for the last 23 years and there has been no issues faced by the villagers. If M/s Sani Clean Pvt Ltd wants to expand the unit, then there would be no objection and all the villagers would be benefitted. |
| 5. | Shri. Pramod Kumar Sethi |
| | He welcomed the district administration officials and villagers present for the public hearing. M/s Saniclean Pvt Ltd had been operational since 2003. The Biomedical waste generated from the hospital are all treated in this facility which is good for environment. If there is expansion, then there would be no objection by villagers. |

| | She welcomed the district administration officials and villagers present for the public hearing. She stated that her decision is with the decision of the villagers. She stated that if the project proponent is doing something which is beneficial to the society and nation then she agrees to the proposal. |

After all the deliberation by the speaker, the Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar requested the project proponent to speak on the issues raised by the public in the meeting.

Shri Mahesh Agarwal, Managing Director of M/s Sani Clean Pvt Ltd addressed the audience.

He at first welcomed the villagers and Officials from the District administration present at the public hearing. He stated that in the year 2002, construction of the project was started and the plant was commissioned in the year 2003 at Tangiapada Mouza in Khordha District. He stated that he had initially installed smaller capacities Biomedical Treatment facilities which would cater to Khordha District. Now, the Govt of Odisha stated the company to cater the biomedical waste from two more districts. Now, they are proposing to expand by adding two more incinerators to the existing facilities. He stated that more plantation activities would be done within the plant and outside premises. He also stated that no untreated wastewater would be discharged to outside premises. He also added that air pollution would be within the prescribed limits of the Board. He said that SPCB as statutory body had been monitoring stack and treated wastewater quality periodically. He added that they have now installed online continuous stack monitoring at the stack connected to the incinerators by which data of air quality parameters are being transmitted to SPCB and CPCB servers. He also stated that if there are any grievances, he requested villagers to approach the company for which quick steps would be taken.

Regional Officer, SPC Board, Bhubaneswar then requested Sub-Collector, Khordha to address the public regarding the public hearing and to conclude it. Sub-Collector, Khordha summarized the public hearing and stated about video recording of the public hearing which would be provided too SEIAA for the grant of Environmental Clearance.

The Sub-Collector, Khordha welcomed all the villagers who were present at the public Hearing. He stated that the Project proponent M/s Sani Clean Pvt Ltd which is a common Biomedical Treatment Facility has been expanding their capacity from 3.2 TPD to 11.2 TPD. He summarized by stating that since 2003 the plant has been operating and now they have requested capacity enhancement. He stated that the reason behind expansion is currently because now the CHC, PHC, DHH & Clinic of 7 districts nearby Khordha has been mapped to M/s Sani Clean Pvt Ltd from which the Biomedical waste would be collected through their own vehicles and transported to this facility at Tangiapada. In this facility Biomedical Waste would be stored, treated, shredded and then incinerated as per the CPCB Guidelines and Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016. He also stated that the company had taken necessary steps for air, water pollution. He summarized by stating that total six Nos of speakers deliberated in the public hearing. And one representation had been received. He finally concluded by stating that he expects Sani Clean Pvt Ltd would work for welfare of the public without any hinderances.

Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar & representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, prepared the summary of the public hearing proceedings accurately reflecting the views and concerns expressed by the speakers with the inclusion of comments of the applicant read over to the audience at the end of the meeting explaining the contents in the Odia language and the agreed minutes of public hearing meeting was prepared.



NOTICE

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that M/s Sani Clean Pvt. Ltd. has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for proposed expansion of Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility capacity from 3.2 TPD to 13.2 TPD at Plot No. 654/900, Khata No. 273/13, Mouza - Tanglapada under Bhubaneswar tehsil of Khordha district to obtain Environmental Clearance from State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha, MoEF&CC, Govt. of India. The proponent has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for a Public Hearing.

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India Notification No. S.O. 1533(E), Dtd: 14.09.2006, the Board has been authorized to conduct public hearing for Environmental Clearance and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site / sites of displacement / sites likely to be affected.

For the above purpose, a person means:

- A. Any person who is likely to be affected on grant of Environmental Clearance.
- B. Any person who owns his control over the project with respect to which an application has been submitted for environmental clearance.
- C. Any association of persons whether incorporated or likely to be affected by the project and/or functioning in the field of environment.
- D. Any local authority within any part of whose local limits is within the neighborhood wherein the project is proposed to be located.

Persons as above who desire to submit their views, comments, objections etc. relevant to the project, may do so in writing within 30 days from the date of publication of this notice addressing the same to the Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha through Registered Post. Besides this, persons interested to submit their views relevant to the proposed project in writing or orally may also do so during the public hearing to be conducted on Dt. 30.01.2026 at 11:00 AM at the Tanglapada Gram Panchayat Office premises, Mouza - Tanglapada of Khordha District.
