NOTICE

Kind Attention: All Thermal Power Plants of Odisha

As per Gazette Notification of the Ministry of Environment & Forest (MoEF), Govt. of India on Fly Ash (S.O. 2804 (E), dtd. 3rd November, 2009) it has been stipulated that the existing Thermal Power Plants shall achieve 100% utilization of fly ash generated by them within 5 years from the date of the said notification i.e. by 03.11.2014. Further, the new thermal power plants/expansion units have to achieve 100 % utilization of fly ash within 4 years from the date of their commissioning.

It has been observed by the Board that the progress on utilization of fly ash by most of the thermal power plants of Odisha is not in compliance with the stipulated target.

All the existing thermal power plants of Odisha State are therefore, directed through this notice to take expeditious steps to achieve 100% utilization of fly ash within the stipulated period in compliance to the said notification. Please note that incase of failure to achieve 100% utilization of fly ash by the dateline, appropriate action shall be taken against the defaulting thermal power plants in accordance with the provisions of law.
