CORRIGENDUM

No. 16458—FE-ENV3-ENV-0014/2017-FE&CC.—In partial modification to this Office Notification No.7485, dated the 12th April 2021, regarding the Fuel Policy of the State of Odisha the following is amended:

In (o) Furnace Oil, the following is substituted:

I. Industries using furnace oil shall install scrubbing system having more than 90% recovery of SO2 emission & provide stack height as specified in the Notification within a period of two (2) years from the date of Notification, i.e. the 12th April 2021 instead of six (6) months.

In (n) Pet Coke, the following is inserted:

II. In case of grinding sizing and briquetting of pet coke, the industries will be allowed to operate without causing environment pollution to be monitored by State Pollution Control Board, Odisha on case to case basis. The industries permitted shall not supply the processed the raw pet coke to the other industries which is not covered in the policy notified in the State Fuel Policy. The record shall be maintained by the industry which is to be verified by the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha.
