No. 18565—ENV-I-38/2018-F&E.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 54 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 (14 of 1981), the State Government after consultation with the State Pollution Control Board do hereby make the following rules further to amend the Odisha Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules, 1983, namely:-

- 1. (1) These Rules may be called the Odisha Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) (Amendment) Rules, 2018.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their Publication in the Odisha Gazette.
- 2. In the Odisha Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules, 1983, herein after referred to as the said rules), in Schedule under heading "1. Fees for Consent to Establish" after item B, the following item shall be added, namely:-

KIND ATTENTION : ALL HEALTH CARE ESTABLISHMENTS (HCEs) OF THE <u>STATE OF ODISHA</u>
State Pollution Control Board, Odisha vide a Public Notice No.5330/Ind-IV-PCP-BMW-40 dtd.31.05.2019 published in Odia daily 'Dharitri' dtd.03.06.2019 and in English daily 'Times of India' dtd.02.06.2019 had asked all the bedded Health Care Establishments to apply to the State Pollution Control Board for grant of consent to operate u/s 25/26 of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act,1974. Meanwhile, the Board in it's 119 th Board Meeting held on 29.06.2019 have decided that all the HCEs having less than 30 beds are to be categorized as "White Category" and hence are exempted from obtaining consent to operate from the Board. They will be regulated only under authorization administration under Bio Medical Waste Rules. HCEs having waste water generation <100 Kilo liters per day (KLD) and having ≥, 30 beds are categorized as "orange category" and required to obtain consent to operate from the Board as stipulated and in the manner specified in the public notice of the Board dt. 31.05.2019 referred above.
