A Glimpse of International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies-2025

State Pollution Control Board, Odisha observed the 6th International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies on 7th September, 2025 with a theme “Racing for Air” in collaboration with the many stakeholders in seven non-attainment cities viz. Angul, Balasore, Bhubaneswar, Cuttack, Kalinga Nagar, Rourkela, and Talcher.

A total of 16 events were conducted including a bi-cycle rally, walkathon, plantation, technical presentation, quiz, painting, hackathon, and research poster making competition across the seven non-attainment cities of Odisha.

More than 3000 participants were presented in this programme and around 2000 nos. of plants were planted in different locations. As per the mission LiFE mandate, all the participants have taken the mission LiFE pledge.



Introduction

Clean air is important for the health and day-to-day lives of people, while air pollution is the single greatest environmental risk to human health and one of the main avoidable causes of death and disease globally. According to the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), air pollution is the world's biggest environmental killer. Data from the World Health Organization (WHO) indicates that air pollution is responsible for around seven million premature deaths each year through diseases such as lung cancer, acute respiratory infections and heart disease. In addition, air pollution disproportionately affects women, children and older persons. Air pollution doesn't only affect human health, it also negatively impacts the climate, economic growth and natural environment. Air pollution decreases the oxygen supply in our oceans, making it harder for plants to grow and as such, contributes to climate change.

In order to raise awareness and mobilise efforts against air pollution, the Second Committee of the 74th session of the United Nations (UN) General Assembly adopted a resolution on November 26, 2019, designating 7th September as the "International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies". The resolution stresses the importance of global awareness of air pollution and the need for robust actions to improve air quality. The day also highlights the negative impact of air pollution on human health, socio-economy, and work productivity.

Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), New Delhi and Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) have decided to observe the International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies in all the 130 non-attainment cities in India. Accordingly, the Forest, Environment and Climate Change Department (FE&CC), Govt. of Odisha and Odisha State Pollution Control Board (OSPCB) are organizing events in seven non-attainment cities of Odisha to raise the awareness of all stakeholders and general public to combat air pollution at large.



Yearly Theme and Purpose

Celebration at SPCB, Bhubaneswar
